OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics move into first place in the American League West with the win...were in second place the past three days after spending 25 consecutive days with at least a share of first from April 7 to May 1...are 2-1 on this six-game homestand against Texas (2-1) and Tampa Bay (three games).
- Trevor Cahill** is 4-1 with a 2.05 ERA (7 er in 30.2 ip) in five career starts against the Rangers.
- Andrew Bailey** has a career-high 20.2-inning scoreless streak dating back to last year and has not allowed a run in 33 of his last 34 appearances...has converted his last 26 save opportunities, which is the second-longest streak in Oakland history.
- Rajai Davis** (1 for 3) has a 12-game hitting streak against the Rangers and is batting .354 (17 for 48) over that span...is batting .348 (8 for 23) over the last eight games after hitting .143 (8 for 56) over his previous 15 games.
- Kevin Kouzmanoff** (1 for 3) committed his fourth error of the season...had only three in 139 games at third base with San Diego last year...has hit safely in 10 of his last 11 games (.370, 17 for 46) after batting .210 over his first 16 contests.
- Ryan Sweeney** (0 for 4) had his 37-game streak of reaching base safely in home games snapped...it was tied for the second-longest such streak in Oakland history (Carney Lansford, May 22-Aug. 19, 1987).

TEXAS NOTES

- The Texas Rangers went 4-2 on this six-game road trip through Seattle (3-0) and Oakland (1-2)...begin a seven-game homestand against Kansas City (four games) and Oakland (three games) tomorrow.
- Colby Lewis** had six strikeouts and now leads the American League with 44 strikeouts this season...is 2-1 with a 3.60 ERA (12 er in 30 ip) in seven career games (five starts) against the A's...is 2-2 with a 3.35 ERA (15 er in 40.1 ip) in 18 games (four starts) at the Coliseum.
- Rangers starting pitchers have gone at least six innings in 11 straight games, their longest such streak since going 13 straight from July 18-31, 2001.
- Elvis Andrus** (2 for 4) is on a six-game hitting streak and is batting .423 (11 for 26) over that span.
