### FOUR OR MORE

Seattle lost 2-1 yesterday in Tampa Bay...are now 3-18 when scoring 3 runs or less, compared to 11-5 with 4 or more runs.

**Casey Kotchman** has played 217 consecutive games without committing an error at first base...he is just the 2nd first baseman in Major League history to surpass 200 straight games without an error, trailing only Kevin Youkilis' MLB record 238-game streak from 2006-08...Kotchman's streak dates back to June 21, 2008 and includes 1,903 consecutive errorless chances:

### HOMER HAPPY

After hitting only 10 home runs in the first 30 games, the Mariners have connected for 10 homers over the last 7 games...the Mariners have hit a home run in 3 of their last 4 games.

### BELIEVE BIG

### TONIGHT'S TILT...

...the Mariners continue their third road trip of the season with game #1 of a 2-game series at the Oakland Athletics...today is game #7 of an 8-game, 3-city road trip against the Orioles (1-2), Tampa Bay Rays (1-2) and Oakland A's (2 games)...the Mariners return home Wednesday to begin a 7-game home stand versus Toronto (2 games), San Diego (3 games) and Detroit (2 games)...tonight's game will be televised in HD by FSN NW and broadcast on 710 ESPN Seattle and the Mariners Radio Network.

### ODDS AND ENDS...

...have dropped 2 straight and 4 of last 7 games...have lost 11 of last 15, incl. an 8-game losing streak...12-17 in last 29...held a lead in 26 of 37 games...trailed at some point in 6 of 14 wins...are 8-10 at home and 6-13 on the road.

- **Ichiro** leads ML with 20 multi-hit games...is batting .390 (46x118) over his last 28 G...also leads the Majors with 13 infield hits.
- Mariners batted around 3 times (last: 4/21 vs. BAL)...sent 9 men to the plate 2 times (last: 5/9 vs. LAA).
- 21 of 37 G decided by 1 or 2 runs...led MLB with 86 G decided by 2-or-fewer runs last year.
- **Ken Griffey Jr.** is T6th all-time in extra base hits (1,192) and T14th in RBI (1,835).
- **Chone Figgins** is T4th in the AL with 25 walks, including at least one in 21 of last 26 games.
- **Ryan Langerhans** has reached base safely in 14 of 30 plate appearances for a .467 OBP (9 BB, 5 H)...has more walks (9) than games started (7) since being recalled on May 5.
- **David Aardsma** has converted 19 of last 21 save opportunities...tied for 7th in AL with 9 saves.
- 48 of the Mariners 114 RBI (42%) this season have come with 2 outs.

### SEATTLE VS. ATHLETICS...

...tonight is the 8th (3-4) of 19 games between the Mariners and A's in 2010...Seattle opened the season dropping 3 of 4 in Oakland, but won 2 of 3 vs. A's in Seattle (4/12-14)...the Mariners and A's will play 9 games in the Coliseum (also May 17-18 and Sept. 6-8) and 10 games at Safeco Field (April 12-14, Aug. 9-11 and Sept. 30-Oct. 3)...the Mariners were 14-5 vs. the A's last season (6-4 on the road, 8-1 at home); Seattle is 40-24 vs. the A's since 2007...the Mariners trail the all-time series 204-274, and trail the series in Oakland 87-154 (.361)...since moving into Safeco Field in July 1999, Seattle leads the series in home games 53-44.

### TOUGH LOSS FOR LEE...Cliff Lee

was saddled with the loss yesterday despite striking out 10 batters in a complete game...became the first pitcher this season to strike out at least 10 batters in a CG loss...Cleveland's Justin Masterson was the only pitcher to do that last season (Sept. 30)...only the 20th time in club history this has happened, and first since Freddy Garcia in 1999 (8/7/99, 1-0 loss to NYY).

### QUALITY STARTS, MIXED RESULTS...

...the Mariners are tie-3rd in the American League in quality starts with 22...however, among the top-5 AL teams in quality starts, the Mariners are last in games won with 11...here's a look: Tampa Bay 27 QS (23-4 record); TOR 23 QS (16-7); MIN 22 QS (18-4); SEA 22 QS (11-11); OAK 21 QS (13-8).

### QUICK TO 100...

Don Wakamatsu has 99 career wins as Mariners manager, in 199 games...Bob Melvin was the quickest Mariners manager to 100 wins, accomplishing the feat in 182 games...Wak has a chance to be second-fastest...**Fewest Games to 100 Career Wins (Mariners Managers):** Bob Melvin, 182; Lou Piniella, 203; Rene Lachemann, 215; Dick Williams, 216; Jim Lefebvre, 218.

### WALK IT OFF...

Seattle lost 2-1 yesterday on a B8th sac fly; the Mariners are now 3-11 in games decided in the last at-bat, and have lost 9 consecutive last-at-bat games in the last three weeks (since 4/23: 21 games played, 9 last at-bat losses)...among the Mariners 11 final-at-bat defeats (4/6 & 4/7 @Oak; 4/23, 4/24 & 4/25 @CWS; 4/30 & 5/2 vs. TEX; 5/8 vs. LAA; 5/13 @BAL; 5/15 & 5/16 @TB) are five walk-off losses (4/6, 4/7 @Oak; 4/23, 4/24 @CWS; 5/15 @TB), including three walk-off home runs (4/23, 4/24 @CWS; 5/15 @TB).

### MISP-ING IN ACTION...

...the Mariners were 1-for-4 with Men In Scoring Position yesterday, part of an alarming trend: Seattle hitters were 2-for-21 (.095) with MISP during their 3-game series at Tampa Bay...the club is 7-for-44 (.159) on the first six games of this trip to Baltimore (1-2) and Tampa Bay (1-2).

### ON THE ROAD AGAIN...

**Ichiro** ranks 3rd in the American League with a .370 (30x81) average on the road...he's hit in 9 of his last 10 games on the road with 8 multi-hit games...since April 25, Ichiro is batting .455 (20x44) with 5 runs scored, 4 doubles, 1 home run, 3 RBI and 3 stolen bases on the road...his 8 consecutive multi-hit games (4/26-5/15) on the road is a franchise record.

### THE BIG K...

over his last 8 appearances, **Kanekoa Texeira** has allowed only 5 hits and 1 run in 10.0 innings for a 0.90 ERA and a .147 OPP AVG (5x34)...has struck out 14 and walked 6 during this stretch (8.6 K/9.0 IP)...since April 28, Texeira has lowered his season ERA from 7.71 to 3.07...currently ranks 9th among rookie relievers in the Majors (min 10.0 IP), incl. 2nd in AL in ERA.

### FISTER & VARGAS...

**Doug Fister** (3-1, 1.72) and **Jason Vargas** (3-2, 2.93) have combined to make a fearsome combo at the back end of the Mariners rotation...the duo has combined to go 6-3 with a 2.56 ERA (24 ER, 93.0 IP) with 12 quality starts (out of 14 possible starts)...taking away their season debuts, Fister is 3-0 with a 1.47 ERA and Vargas is 3-1 with a 2.21 ERA.

### AS YOU KNOW...

...each of the Mariners past four games has been decided by one run, but **DID YOU KNOW?**...that the last time the Mariners played four consecutive one-run games was May 1-4, 2009 vs. Oakland (3 games) & Texas (1 game)?...went 2-2 in those games...have not played 5 consecutive 1-run affairs since July 28-Aug. 1, 2004 (went 1-4 against Oakland and Anaheim).

**ABOUT ROWLAND-SMITH...**

- 27-year-old left-hander makes his 8th start of the season today vs. the Athletics...made his second career Opening Day roster (also '09).
- Made 16 starts last season, going 5-4 with a 3.74 ERA (40 ER, 96.1 IP).
- Has made 61 of 95 career ML appearances as a reliever, but 34 of last 37 appearances have been starts.
- Made Major League debut June 22, 2007 vs. Cincinnati in relief...Ken Griffey Jr. was first ML strikeout.
- Spent entire career with Seattle...selected by Twins 2004 Rule 5 Draft, returned to Seattle during spring training.
- Born in Sydney, Australia...resides during the off-season in Newcastle, Australia & Seattle...signed as non-drafted free agent Nov. 19, 2000 by Mariners scout Barry Holland.
- On provisional roster for Australia for 2009 World Baseball Classic, but declined to play in order to compete for spot in Seattle starting rotation...also on the provisional roster in 2006.
- Pitched for Australia in the 2004 Summer Olympics and won a silver medal in Sydney games...went 2-0 with a 1.23 ERA in 4 games.
- Only player ML history with a hyphenated last name.
- Can be followed on Twitter (@hyphen18).
- Is 3-4 with 1 save and a 3.05 ERA (32 ER, 94.1 IP) in 29 games/11 starts in his career vs. the AL West.
- Is making his 3rd career start in the month of May...is 0-2, 4.44 w/1 save in 16 games (2 GS) in May...has no wins in either April/May in career.
- Is 2-4-2, 4.53 ERA (48 ER, 95.1 IP) in 47 games/10 GS Pre-ASG, compared to 9-6, 3.70 ERA (80 ER, 194.1 IP) in 48 games/24 GS Post-ASG.

**LAST START...**L#3 in last start May 12 at Baltimore...shortest start of his career, 2nd straight start of under 5.0 innings...allowed 2 runs on 2-run double by M. Tejada in 3rd inning...removed from game after allowing a leadoff HR in 4th on 2-1 pitch to Luke Scott.

**TOUGH STRETCH...**over last 4 starts, posted a 8.35 ERA (17 ER, 18.1 IP) and a .329 opponents batting average (26x79)...allowed 5 home runs during the 4-game stretch...the three game losing streak is the longest of his career...before streak had never lost multiple-games in a row.

**LOOKING FOR WARMER WEATHER...**during his career is 0-4 with a 4.57 ERA (33 ER, 65.0 IP) combined between the first two months of the season (April/May)...in the rest of the months (June/July/August/September/October) has combined to go 11-6 with a 3.81 ERA (95 ER, 224.2 IP).

**PITCH AROUND...**opponents #3 & #4 hitters are batting a combined .375 (12x32) with 3 home runs and 10 RBI this season...the rest of the lineup is a combined .264 (29x110)...the first two batters in the lineup are .237 (9x38) with just 3 extra base hits.

**SEASON STARTERS...**recorded ND in first start of the '10 season at Oakland on April 7...allowed 4 runs (3 ER) on 8 hits in 5.0 innings, while walking 1 and striking out 1...allowed solo HR to R. Davis in 3rd inning...left game with a 5-4 lead.

**THE GOAL IS TO GO DEEP...**has tossed at least 6.0 innings in 21 of 34 starts, but only 2 of 7 this season and 13 of his last 21 overall...recorded career-high 6 consecutive quality starts July 29-Sept. 16, 2009...pitched at least 7.0 innings in 8 of 15 starts in 2009.

**DOWN UNDER...**is one of five native Australians to appear in a Major League game this season...joins Grant Balfour (TB), Peter Moylan (ATL), Brad Thomas (DET) and Luke Hughes (MIN)...according to Stats Inc, there have been 25 Major League players born in Australia, with Rowland-Smith's 93 career pitching appearances ranking 4th all-time (Graeme Lloyd, 568).

**NO CHANCE LEFTIES...**held left-handers to a .195 batting average (17x87) in 2009, with only 2 home runs allowed...prior to last season, lefties hit .302 (60x199) with 7 home runs...has been steady against right-handers in his career, limiting to a .247 batting average (192x778).

**SAFE AT HOME...**went 4-2 with a 2.70 ERA (17 ER, 56.2 IP) in 8 starts at Safeco Field last season...recorded a quality start in 7 of his 8 Safeco appearances, including 7 consecutive to end the season...overall is 7-7, 3.47 in 45 home appearances, including going 6-6, 3.46 (47 ER, 122.1 IP) in 19 starts...compares to 4-2, 4.50 in 49 road appearances, including 2-2, 4.99 in 14 starts.

24-year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his 9th start of the season tomorrow against the Athletics.....ND in last start May 13 at Baltimore... left with 4-1 lead (7.0,5,1,1,2,7)...had lost three straight starts after starting the season 2-0, 2.15...lost 3 consecutive starts for the first time since a 4-start stretch, April 27-May 13, 2008...over 3 starts (April 26-May 7) allowed 16 runs (14 ER), 5 home runs and 11 walks (8.59 ERA)...L#3 5/7 vs. LAA (3.1,5,8,7,4,3,3 HR)...had club record consecutive quality start streak of 18 snapped in L#2 vs. TEX...dating back to start of '09, Mariners are 29-12 in Felix starts...W#2 vs. BAL 4/21, tossing 8th career complete game, allowing just 1 unearned run...**2009** -- Finished 2nd in AL Cy Young race (Zack Greinke); received 2 first-place votes & 23 of 28 2nd-place votes...Won 2009 Seattle Sports Pro Star of the Year...Winner of the Luis Aparicio Award, voted as the best Venezuelan in the Majors...Set career-highs in wins (19), starts (34), strikeouts (217) and innings pitched (238.2)...Led the AL with a .792 winning percentage...also listed among AL leaders in wins (T1st), ERA (2nd), starts (T2nd), innings pitched (3rd), strikeouts (4th) and K/9.0 IP (7th)...Joined Roy Halladay as only AL pitchers to rank in the top 5 in each of the three pitching Triple Crown categories (W-ERA-K)...**vs. OAK** -- Making 15th career start against the Athletics, 2nd of 2010...no-decision Opening Day April 5, 2010 at Oakland (6.2,3,3,3,6,4)...overall is 8-4, 2.96 ERA (33 ER, 100.1 IP) with 91 strikeouts (8.2 K/9 IP) in 15 starts...in 2009 was 1-0, 4.97 ERA (7 ER, 12.2 IP) in 2 starts.
