OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have won four of their past six and have won 11 of their last 16 home games...are 11-6 in day games and 11-16 at night...are 8-2 in one-run games, which is the best such record in the Major Leagues...snapped a six-game losing streak in 1-0 games (last win: June 2, 2007 vs. MIN)...are 4-2 on this seven-game homestand against Seattle (2-0), Detroit (0-2) and San Francisco (2-0).
- Gio Gonzalez** pitched a career-high eight innings and retired 20 consecutive batters from the second inning on...has thrown at least six innings in six of his nine starts and has made five quality starts in his past six starts...A's starting pitchers are 12-7 with a 2.84 ERA (50 er in 158.1 ip) at home and 4-9 with a 5.77 ERA (62 er in 96.2ip) on the road.
- Andrew Bailey** has not allowed a run in his last 17 appearances (17.0 ip) in Oakland dating back to September 5 of last year...has not yielded a run in 15 of his 17 outings this year and in 37 of his last 40 appearances since July 31, 2009 (0.90 ERA, 4 er in 40.0 ip).
- Jack Cust** (0 for 2, bb) has reached base safely in each of eight games this season and is batting .304 (7 for 23) with five walks over that span.
- Rajai Davis** (1 for 2) stole his 15th base of the season, which is the most by an Athletic before the All-Star Break since Rickey Henderson had 37 in 1998.
- Cliff Pennington** (0 for 3) grounded into a double play in the seventh inning, his first in 156 at-bats this season.
- Adam Rosales** (1 for 2) has scored six runs in his last six games after going 15 consecutive games without scoring a run.
- Kurt Suzuki** (1 for 3) is a .318 career hitter (14 for 44) against the Giants...has a career .346 average (46 for 133) in interleague play.

SAN FRANCISCO NOTES

- The San Francisco Giants have dropped four straight, five of their past six and 10 of their past 15 games...are 6-16 when their opponents score first...are 6-10 in one-run games...are 1-5 on this seven-game road trip through San Diego (1-1), Arizona (0-2) and Oakland (0-2).
- Matt Cain** is 2-5 with a 2.44 ERA (14 er in 51.2 ip) in seven career games against the A's and has pitched three of his nine career complete games against Oakland...is 1-2 with a 2.41 ERA (9 er in 33.2 ip) in five starts on the road this season.
- Bengie Molina** (0 for 4) is hitless in his past 15 at-bats and is batting .129 (4 for 31) over his past nine games.
- Pablo Sandoval** (0 for 3) had his seven-game hitting streak snapped and is now batting .323 (10 for 31) over his past eight games but is hitting .190 (15 for 79) in 19 games in May overall.
