THE GIANTS...lost 6-1 last night to Oakland and have now dropped 3-straight, 4 of their last 5 and 9 of their last 14 games...

- with losses in each of their last 2 games, Giants have dropped into 3rd place in NL West standings...SF placed either 1st or 2nd in division for 45-straight days before dropping to 3rd following Thursday's game...
- have combined for 18-7 (.720) record against NL East, Central and Interleague opponents this season, however, have gone just 4-12 (.250) against NL West...7 of those 12 losses to NL West foes have come against Padres...
- are in midst of 13-game stretch in which they do not have an off day, club's longest such stretch this season...next day off is scheduled for this upcoming Monday, May 24...
- are currently 1-4 on this 7-game roadtrip to San Diego (1-1), Arizona (0-2) and Oakland (0-1)...Giants have posted 9-11 (.429) road record, losing 10 of their last 15 games away from AT&T Park...

TODAY'S TRANSACTIONS...prior to today's game Giants have reinstated **IF Edgar Renteria** from 15-day disabled list (right groin strain)...corresponding roster move will be announced prior to game...

- Renteria has batted .316 (24-for-76) with 1 HR and 10 RBI in 20 games for San Francisco this season, hitting safely in 12 of those contests...Giants have 12-8 record this year with Renteria as starting shortstop...

CAIN AND THE A'S...RHP **Matt Cain** is 2-4 with 2.89 ERA (14er, 43.2ip) and .173 (27-for-156) avg. against in 6 career games against Oakland, with 2 of his 8 career complete games coming against Bay Area rival...both of his victories have come in his games that he has gone distance...Cain tossed complete-game while allowing 1 run on 4 hits in his last start against A's last season on June 14...he has posted 1.88 ERA (5er, 24.0ip) over Oakland in his last 3 outings...

IN THE CLUTCH...Giants went hitless in 9 at-bats last night with runner in scoring position and are batting .169 (10-for-59) in those situations in their last 6 games...San Francisco enters today's games with .236 (90-for-381) avg. with RISP, which ranks as lowest clip among all NL teams...SF's .193 (32-for-166) clip with RISP/2 outs is also lowest mark in NL...**IF Juan Uribe** (.333, 13-for-39) and **OF Aaron Rowand** (.303, 10-for-33) are lone Giants hitting .300 or better with RISP this season...

QUALITY COUNTS...Giants starting pitchers have posted 1-3 record with 7.94 ERA (20er, 22.2ip) and .298 (25-for-84) avg. against over their last 4 outings, all of which have not been quality assignments, which is longest stretch this season without quality start...today's starter **Matt Cain** was last Giants hurler to toss quality outing, when he logged 6.0 innings and allowed 2 runs to open this 7-game roadtrip on Monday in San Diego...Giants have gone 19-7 this season when starting pitcher throws quality start, compared to 3-12 record when starter does not log quality game...San Francisco's 26 quality assignments overall are 3rd-most in National League...

HOME/ROAD RELIEF...San Francisco's bullpen has been touched for 14 runs in 15.1 innings (8.22 ERA) of work through 1st 5 games of this roadtrip, including 11 runs in their last 7.1 innings...Giants' relief corps has really struggled on road this season, posting 5.49 ERA (35er, 57.1ip) and .285 (63-for-221) opponents avg. against in 20 road games, compared to 1.99 ERA (12er, 54.1ip) and .234 (47-for-201) avg. against in 21 home contests...SF's bullpen had allowed at least 1 run in their last 11 road contests prior to tossing 1.1-scoreless innings here in Oakland last night...

- Giants relievers have combined to work 111.2 innings this season, 2nd-fewest in NL...

INTERLEAGUE...Giants lost 1st game of 2010 Bay Bridge Series to Oakland last night...SF has posted 35-40 record against A's, however, have won 7 of last 9 contests...last season Giants went 5-1 against Oakland, marking 1st season series victory over A's since 2001 (4-2)...

- Giants went 9-6 in Interleague last season and have gone 106-104 (.505) since Interleague began in 1997...SF is 1 of only 5 National League teams with .500 or better career winning pct. in Interleague games, joining Florida (.545, 120-100), St. Louis (.529, 101-90), Atlanta (.521, 110-101) and Houston (.502, 101-100)...

WITH THE BATS...**IF Pablo Sandoval** has hit safely in his last 7 games at .357 (10-for-28) with 2 2Bs and 3 RBI...beginning April 30, **IF Aubrey Huff** is hitting .352 (25-for-71) with 7 2Bs, 2 HRs and 12 RBI...Huff's .292 (42-for-144) avg. as 1st baseman this season is 5th-highest in NL, behind Albert Pujols (.316), Ryan Howard (.310), Joey Votto (.310) and James Loney (.295)...**OF Andres Torres** went 2-for-4 last night with pair of 2Bs...beginning April 23, Torres is hitting .329 (26-for-79) with 11 2Bs, 2 HRs and 12 RBI...14 of his 28 hits this season have been extra base hits...

IN THE TRAINERS ROOM...**IF Juan Uribe** left last night's game after just 2.0 innings with tight left hamstring and is listed as day-to-day...**OF Nate Schierholtz** has sat out last 2 games with bruised right shoulder...**IF/OF Mark DeRosa** (left wrist neuritis) is eligible to come off disabled list on Monday, but may get some at-bats in rehab assignment before coming off DL...**IF Emmanuel Burriss** (left foot fracture) was transferred to 60-day disabled list yesterday to make room for **RHP Santiago Casilla** on 40-man roster...

- on May 9th vs. Mets, Wilson became 1st pitcher in Giants history to notch save of 5 or more outs, while registering each out with strikeout...marked 1st time since Toronto's B.J. Ryan did it against Phillies July 1, 2006...
- has established himself as one of top closers in baseball since becoming full time closer in 2008...over last 2+ seasons, has converted 89-of-103 save chances, with his 89 rescues during that span as most in NL, ahead of Francisco Cordero (87)...
