- THE GIANTS...lost 1-0 decision yesterday to Oakland and have now dropped 4-straight, tying
- longest losing streak of season...Giants have lost 5 of their last 6 and 10 of their last 15 games... with losses in each of their last 3 games, Giants have dropped into 3rd place in NL West standings...SF placed either 1st or 2nd in division for 45-straight days before dropping to 3rd
- following Thursday's game...

 have combined for 18-8 (.692) record against NL East, Central and Interleague opponents this season, however, have gone just 4-12 (.250) against NL West...7 of those 12 losses to NL West foes have come against Padres...
- are in midst of 13-game stretch in which they do not have an off day, club's longest such stretch this season...next day off is scheduled for tomorrow...
- begin 9-game homestand on Tuesday against Washington (Tues.-Thurs.), Arizona (Fri.-Sun.) and Colorado (May 31-June 2)...
- TOUGH LUCK...RHP Matt Cain tossed his 9th career complete game yesterday (his 3rd against Oakland), however was charged with loss after allowing 1 unearned run in SF's 1-0 defeat...yesterday's contest marked 2nd-straight time that Cain has gone distance and has earned losing decision (also Aug. 3, 2009 at Houston)...yesterday was also just 11th game in SF-era history that starting pitcher tossed complete-game and did not allow an earned run, but wound up with losing decision...last time this happened came Aug. 27, 1995 at Montreal when Mark Leiter pitched 8.0 complete innings and allowed 1 unearned run in SF's 1-0 loss...
- QUALITY COUNTS...Giants starting pitchers have posted 1-4 record with 5.87 ERA (20er, 30.2ip) and .273 (30-for-110) avg. against over their last 5 outings, 4 of which have not been quality assignments...Giants have gone 19-8 this season when starting pitcher throws quality start, compared to 3-12 record when starter does not log quality game...San Francisco's 27 quality assignments overall are 3rd-most in National League...
- IN THE CLUTCH...Giants have gone hitless in 12 at-bats with runners in scoring position in 1st 2 games of this series and are batting .161 (10-for-62) in those situations in their last 7 games...San Francisco enters today's games with .234 (90-for-384) avg. with RISP, which ranks as lowest clip among all NL teams...SF's .190 (32-for-168) clip with RISP/2 outs is also lowest mark in NL...IF Juan Uribe (.333, 13-for-39) and OF Aaron Rowand (.303, 10-for-33) are lone Giants hitting .300 or better with RISP this season...
- ROAD WOES...Giants have gone 1-5 through 6 games of this 7-game road trip, going 1-1 in San Diego, 0-2 in Arizona and 0-2 so far here in Oakland...SF has gone 2-5-1 (won-loss-split) in 8 road series this season, having dropped 3 of their last 4...Giants have posted 9-12 (.429) road record, losing 11 of their last 16 games away from AT&T Park...SF is hitting .257 (190-for-738) on road while averaging 4.2 runs per game and pitching staff has posted 4.30 ERA (89er, 186.1ip)...
- HOME/ROAD RELIEF...San Francisco's bullpen has been touched for 14 runs in 15.1 innings (8.22 ERA) of work through 1st 6 games of this road trip, inlouding 11 runs in their last 7.1 innings...Giants' relief corps has really struggled on road this season, posting 5.49 ERA (35er, 57.1ip) and .285 (63-for-221) opponents avg. against in 21 road games, compared to 1.99 ERA (12er, 54.1ip) and .234 (47-for-201) avg. against in 21 home contests...SF's bullpen had allowed at least 1 run in their last 11 road contests prior to tossing 1.1-scoreless innings here in Oakland Friday night... Giants relievers have combined to work 111.2 innings this season, 2nd-fewest in NL...
- 2 IS FEW...Giants have scored 1 run-or-fewer in 4 of their last 6 games and have been held to 2 runsor-fewer in 16 of their 42 contests (38.0%) overall this season...only Houston (23), Baltimore (18), Pittsburgh (18) and Seattle (18) have played more games this season where they've been held to 2 runs-or-fewer...SF has posted 2-14 record when scoring less than 2 runs...
- NOTHING MINOR ABOUT IT...San Francisco's farm system is once again leading all other organizations with .614 (105-66) winning percentage this season...all 4 of SF's minor league affiliates are either in 1st or 2nd place in their respective divisions and all have posted .500 or better winning pct....triple-A Fresno has best winning pct. in SF's organization with .667 (28-14) mark...
- SUNDAY TRIBUTE...prior to today's game, A's and Giants will host Marin Catholic High School pitcher Gunnar Sandberg, his family and teammates for special pre-game ceremony...Sandberg, 16, was critically injured after being hit in head with line drive on March 11 during scrimmage game...he was recently discharged from San Francisco rehabilitation hospital and is undergoing outpatient therapy 5 days a week until his recovery is complete...
- GIANT GEMS...yesterday was 4th time this season that Giants have been shutout...C Bengie Molina is hitless in his last 17 at-bats since single in 4th inning of last Monday's game at San Diego...OF Aaron Rowand is hitless in his last 10 ABs and has just 2 hits in his last 19 atbats...IF Freddy Sanchez has hit safely in 3 of his 1st 4 games this season..
