A's vs. RED SOX

The A's and Red Sox meet for the first time in 2010 in Oakland's only trip to Fenway...Boston took a 1-0 lead in the season series with last night's series-opening win...the two clubs split the season series last year, 5-5...the A's won two of three in Oakland and went 3-4 in Boston...are 24-25 against the Red Sox since 2005...however, are 212-265 since moving to Oakland in 1968...that includes 124-111 in Oakland, 87-153 in Boston and 1-1 in Tokyo...all-time, the A's are 854-1046 against the Red Sox

TODAY'S TIDBITS

Andrew Bailey recorded the 37th save of his career Monday, tying him with Bill Caudill for ninth on the Oakland career saves list...had nine saves in May, which tied for the American League lead and tied for the fifth best singlemonth total in Oakland history...ranks fifth among American League relievers in ERA (1.29).

Brad Ziegler has not allowed a run in his last eight appearances (9.0 ip, 8 h, 2 bb, 2 so). He has a 1.00 career ERA in seven appearances vs. Boston (9.0 ip, 1 er).

Rajai Davis is batting .370 (20 for 54) with 11 runs scored and 11 stolen bases over his last 16 games...has a Major League leading 23 steals for the season and is just the second Athletic in the last 16 years to steal 20 bases before the break (Henderson, 37 in 1998).

THIS DATE IN A's HISTORY

In 1977, Mike Norris tosses a fourhit shutout as the A's defeat the Mariners in Seattle, 1-0. Jim Tyrone's double in the fourth inning drives in the only run of the game ...in 1982, Norris tosses another four-hit shutout as the A's defeat Boston 5-0.

ABOUT THE A's

ABOUT THE A'S: Entered this series having won three of four from Detroit after taking two of three from Baltimore to claim back-to-back road series for the first time this year...have held or shared first place in the American League West for the fourth consecutive day...this is the latest the A's have been in first place in the West since winning the division in 2006...it is the first time they have been in first at the end of May since 1990...with last night's loss, fell back into a first place tie with Texas, the first time the two teams have shared the lead since May 11...have spent 25 days alone in first this year, now seven days tied for first, 24 days in second, one day tied for second and one day in fourth...have won five of the last seven games and eight of the last 11 to move to three games over .500 (28-25)...that is two games shy of the season high of five (9-4 on April 17)...have spent 41 days over .500 this year after logging just one day over .500 last year (2-1, April 8)...this road trip starts a stretch of 20 games in 20 days for the A's, their longest stretch of games without a day off this year...are 5-3 over the first eight games of the stretch...it also begins a stretch where the A's will play 19 of 26 games on the road...the loss on Sunday snapped a season high tying four-game winning streak.

IN MAY: The A's finished the month of May with a 16-12 (.571) record, which was their best mark in May since going 15-11 (.577) in 2004...it marks just the second time in the last six seasons the A's finished May with a winning mark...the 16 wins were their most since going 18-9 in 2001...the A's .571 winning percentage tied for fourth best in the American League...ranked second in the AL in ERA (3.75) but the offense had the fewest runs scored (99) and home runs (15)...the runs were the A's fewest in May since 1979 (98).

HOME AND AWAY: The A's are 5-3 on this 10-game road trip against Baltimore (2-1), Detroit (3-1) and Boston (0-1, three games)...the trip matches the A's longest of the season (August 24-September 2)...have clinched a .500 road trip for the second time this year (3-3 vs. Los Angeles and Seattle, April 9-14) and have not had a winning road trip since September 8-16 of last year (6-2)...entered this trip having lost 12 of the previous 14 road games...are now 10-16 (.385) on the road compared to 18-9 (.667) at home...have the fourth worst road record in the American League but are tied for the second best home record...the pitching staff has a 5.10 ERA (128 er in 225.2 ip) on the road and a 2.79 ERA (76 er in 245.0 ip) at home...have the second highest road ERA in the AL and the lowest home ERA...have yielded 39 home runs in 26 games on the road and 13 in 27 contests at home...have the most home runs allowed on the road and the fewest at home...starting pitchers are 7-10 with a 4.91 ERA (78 er in 143.0 ip) on the road and 13-7 with a 2.74 ERA (50 er in 164.1 ip) at home...the A's offense is batting .243 (221 for 910) on the road compared to .268 (234 for 872) at home...have the fifth lowest road batting average in the AL and the sixth highest home average...the A's return home following the game Thursday for a seven-game homestand against Minnesota (three games) and Los Angeles (four games)...went 5-2 on the last homestand against Seattle (2-0), Detroit (0-2) and San Francisco (3-0) and have won 12 of their last 17 home games.

ONE-RUN GAMES AND OTHER CLOSE CALLS: The A's are 9-2 in one-run games, which is the best record in the majors...went 15-23 in one-run games last year, which was the second worst record in the American League...trailed 5-2 entering the eighth inning Thursday night in Baltimore and scored five times to win 7-5...it marked the first time this year the A's overcame a deficit of three or more runs and won...are 3-1 in extra inning games, matching the A's extra inning win total from last year...were 3-10 (.231) in extra innings last year, the worst mark in Oakland history...have four walk-off wins after tallying just five in all of 2009.

PITCHING: The A's allowed one run Monday at Detroit, the sixth time in the last 11 games they have allowed one run or fewer...that includes three shutouts...have a 2.81 ERA (30 er in 96.0 ip) over the last 11 contests—despite being tagged for nine runs (all earned) last night—and now have a 3.90 ERA for the season, which is fifth lowest in the American League...lead the AL in shutouts (7) and fewest hit batters (8) and have the fourth lowest opponents batting average (.248).

STARTING PITCHING: A's starting pitchers have allowed one run or fewer in seven of the last 11 games and are 5-1 with a 2.28 ERA (17 er in 67.0 ip) over that span...have a 3.01 ERA (51 er in 152.1 ip) in 25 games since May 5 and now have a 3.75 ERA for the season, which is fourth lowest in the American League...have the second lowest opponents batting average (.241)...are tied for fourth in complete games (2) but have the fifth fewest innings pitched (307.1).

OFFENSE: The A's have been held to two runs or fewer in 10 of the last 24 games and have scored 85 runs total over that span (3.54 per game)...have 209 runs for the season, which is fourth fewest in the American League...are tied for the AL lead in sacrifice flies (20), rank second in sacrifice hits (18), have the fourth lowest slugging percentage (.371), the fourth fewest extra base hits (135) and the fourth most strikeouts (378)...A's leadoff hitters are batting .246 (55 for 224) with 19 walks and they have the fourth lowest batting average in the AL and the second lowest on-base percentage (.302).

THE LONG BALL: The A's did not homer Monday at Detroit, snapping a season best streak of five consecutive games with a home run...that followed a seven-game streak without a home run, the A's longest drought in 27 years (9 games, September 14-24, 1983)...have hit just six home runs over the last 14 games and have 31 for the season, which is tied with Seattle for second fewest in the majors (Houston, 27)...the A's and Astros are the only ML teams that have not hit more than two home runs in a game this year...have homered two times or fewer in 59 consecutive games dating back to September 27 of last year, which is the A's longest such streak since April 24-July 15, 1994 when they had a 72-game streak.

THE DISABLED LIST: The A's used the disabled list for the 14th time when they added Coco Crisp (intercostal strain) last Wednesday...have now used the DL 78 times since the start of the 2007 season (17 in 2009, an Oakland record 25 in 2008 and 22 in 2007)...began the year with six players on the DL and it now stands at seven (Buck, Chavez, Crisp, Devine, Duchscherer, Meloan, Outman)...have had at least five players on the DL all year...have not had fewer than five players on the DL since April 28 of last year when they had four...have not had fewer than three players on the DL since the end of the 2006 season, when they had just one.

FOR STARTERS: Is scheduled to make his American League leading 12th start of the season...the A's are 5-6 (.455) in his starting assignments and his teams are 114-118 (.491) in his 232 career starts...has tossed at least six innings in eight of his 12 starts, allowed two runs or fewer five times and walked two batters or fewer four times.

NO DECISIONS: Has a 2.81 ERA (8 er in 25.2 ip) over his last four starts but does not have a decision...that marks the first time in his career he has four straight no decisions...the only other time he had more than two was from June 20 to July 1, 2003 when he had three.

SEVEN INNINGS: Tossed a season high 7.0 innings in his last start, snapping a career long streak of 13 consecutive starts of fewer than seven innings...it was his longest outing since tossing a complete game five-hit shutout September 6, 2008 against San Diego.

LAST FIVE STARTS: Is 1-0 with a 2.81 ERA (32.0 ip, 22 h, 10 r, 10 er, 13 bb, 35 so, 3 hr) and .195 (22 for 113) opponents batting average over his last five starts...that comes after a two-game stretch where he allowed eight runs on April 27 at Tampa Bay and nine on May 2 at Toronto to become the second pitcher in Oakland history to allow at least eight runs in back-to-back starts...Mark Mulder was the other (September 15-21, 2004) but Sheets was the first with at least eight earned runs...went 1-1 with a 2.74 ERA over his first four starts

RUN SUPPORT: Has received run support of one run or less in five of his 11 starts this year and his season run support of 3.18 (22 rs in 62.1 ip) is seventh lowest in the American League.

STRIKEOUTS: Has 35 strikeouts in 32.0 innings over his last five starts (9.8 per nine innings) after striking out 16 in 30.1 ip innings over his first six starts (4.7 per nine innings)...had back-to-back starts with eight strikeouts on May 8 and 13, the first time he fanned eight or more in consecutive starts since September 13-19, 2006.

AMONG THE LEADERS: Has allowed 31 extra base hits, which ranks second most in the American League...that includes an Oakland record eight on May 2 at Toronto...broke the previous mark of seven (eight times, last by Mike Oquist on May 4, 1999)...has the fourth highest opponents slugging percentage in the AL (.489), is tied for eighth in walks (29) and tied for 10th in home runs (9).

HOME AND AWAY: Is 2-1 with a 2.50 ERA (10 er in 36.0 ip) and .214 (27 for 126) opponents batting average in six starts at home compared to 0-2 with an 8.20 ERA (24 er in 26.1 ip) and .333 (37 for 111) opponents batting average in five starts on the road...has yielded seven of his nine home runs on the road.

OPPONENTS BATTING: Has yielded seven of his nine home runs to right-handed hitters but has issued 22 of his 290 walks to left-handers...opponents are 17 for 55 (.309) with 10 walks (.415 on-base percentage) when leading off an inning...the on-base percentage is 13th highest in the American League...has allowed a .324 (22 for 68) average with runners in scoring position.

INNING BY INNING: Has a 6.44 ERA (31 er in 43.1 ip) and .286 (48 for 168) opponents batting average over the first four innings of a game and a 1.42 ERA (3 er in 19.0 ip) and .232 (16 for 69) after that.

ALL STARTS: Has made 232 career appearances and all have been starts...those are the fourth most appearances in major league history among pitchers who have never made a relief appearance.

2010 HIGHLIGHTS: He had a no decision in the A's 5-3 loss to Seattle on Opening Night *April 5* in Oakland...it was his first start since September 27, 2008 against the Chicago Cubs...became the A's fifth different Opening Day starter in the last five years (Braden, Blanton, Haren, Zito)...it was his seventh career Opening Day start and he is 3-0 with a

2.59 ERA (12 er in 41.2 ip) in those seven starts...among active pitchers, only Buehrle (CWS), Halladay (PHI), Hernandez (WASH minors) and Oswalt (HOU), with eight each, have more...left trailing 3-0 but the A's scored once in the sixth and twice in the seventh to get him off the hook...had his second consecutive no decision in an A's loss, a 4-3 loss at Los Angeles April 10...left after six innings trailing 3-1 but the A's scored single runs in the seventh and eighth to get him off the hook...picked up his first win since September 6, 2008 in the A's 6-2 win over Baltimore *April 15*...tossed 6.0 shutout innings despite allowing five hits and walking three...stranded eight base runners and left runners in scoring position in four of his six innings...was the losing pitcher in the A's 3-1 loss to New York April 21 in Oakland...Hughes no-hit the A's over the first seven innings before Oakland scored its only run in the eighth...lost his third straight in the A's 9-3 loss at Toronto May 2...allowed a career high tying three home runs (sixth time, first since May 15, 2008 vs. Los Angeles-NL)...yielded nine runs, all earned, in 3.1 innings, his most runs in a game since August 15, 2005 at Colorado when he allowed 10 runs, all earned...snapped his three-game losing streak in the A's 4-2 win over Tampa Bay on **May 8**...struck out a season high eight batters in 6.1 innings...had a no decision in the A's 2-1, 12-inning loss in Texas **May 13**...retired each of the first eight batters he faced before Borbon walked, stole second and scored on an Andrus single...that was the only run he would allow in 6.0 innings, but Wilson limited the A's to one run in seven innings...had his second consecutive no decision in an extra-inning game, a 6-5 A's win in 10 innings over Seattle *May 18...*left trailing 4-3 before the A's came back to win...combined with Wuertz, Blevins, Ziegler and Bailey on a three-hit shutout in the A's 3-0 win over San Francisco May 23...however, ended up with a no decision as he tossed six innings but left with the score tied at 0-0...it was the 17th time in Oakland history a starting pitcher had a no decision in a shutout...matched his season high with eight strikeouts

LAST START: He had his fourth consecutive no decision in the A's 5-4 win at Detroit last Thursday...tossed a season high 7.0 innings...allowed a two-run home run to Cabrera in the bottom of the first but the A's took a 3-2 lead into the bottom of the fourth...he then allowed a solo home run to Cabrera and left after seven innings with the scored tied at 3-3...the A's scored twice in the ninth for the win.

SHEETS vs. BOSTON: The Red Sox are one of three teams he has never faced (Kansas City, Milwaukee).

TOMORROW'S PROBABLE STARTING PITCHER

LHP Brett Anderson (2-1, 1.88 ERA): Is scheduled to make his sixth start of the season, his second since he was reinstated from the disabled list May 29... has not allowed a run in three of his five starts this year and has allowed one run or fewer four times ... has a 1.88 ERA in 28.2 innings ...his ERA is the lowest among American League pitchers and third lowest in the majors among pitchers with five or more starts (Jimenez, COL 0.78 and Garcia, STL 1.32).... in his last start, combined with Ziegler and Breslow on a five-hit shutout in the A's 6-0 win at Detroit last Saturday ... is 2-1 with a 2.05 ERA (22.0 ip, 11 h, 5 r, 5 er, 8 bb, 22 so, 2 hr) in three career starts vs. Boston, all last year... tossed a complete game two-hit shutout in the A's 6-0 win at Boston on July 6... according to Elias, he was the first rookie to shutout Boston at Fenway since California's Jim Abbott on August 30, 1989... also won at Fenway July 29 in an 8-6 Oakland win.

The A's bullpen was 3-1 with a 2.42 ERA (7 er in 26.0 ip) and had converted all five of its save opportunities over its last 10 games doubt to Save/Save Opportunities: 12/17 (70.6%) May 21 until last night, when the A's pen coughed up six earned runs on seven hits and six walks in 3.0 innings ...is 12 for 17 (70.6%) in save chances for the season, which is the fifth best percentage in the American League...the 17 save opportunities are tied for fourth fewest in the AL...also rank second in innings pitched (163.1) and fourth in strikeouts (134) and wins (9)...has a 5.44 ERA (50 er in 82.2 ip) on the road compared to a 2.90 ERA (26 er in 80.2 ip) at home

- Has recorded the save in each of his last five outings, including Monday at Detroit when he logged the 37th save of his career...that ties him with Bill Caudill for ninth on the Oakland career list (Koch and Foulke are tied for seventh, 44).
- Finished the month of May with nine saves, which tied him with Feliz (TEX) and Soriano (TB) for the American League lead...the nine saves tied for the fifth highest single-month total in Oakland history and were the most by an A's pitcher in one month since Huston Street had 10 in June of 2006...had just two saves in April.
- Has allowed one run in three of his last nine outings (3 er in 9.1, 2.89 ERA) after allowing no runs over his first 12 games (11.2 ip)...has a 1.29 ERA for the season, which ranks fifth lowest among AL relievers.
- Converted each of his two save opportunities in three outings against Boston last year (4.0 ip, 5 h, 2 r, 2 er, 2 bb, 4 so).
- Cabrera's leadoff home run in the ninth Friday night in Detroit snapped a five-game (5.2 ip) scoreless string for him and was the first home run he allowed since September 5 of last year.
- Has not allowed a run in 13 games at home this year (13.0 ip) and has a 3.38 ERA (3 er in 8.0 ip) in eight outings on the road...has not allowed a run in his last 18 appearances (18.0 ip) in Oakland dating back to September 5 of last year.
- Made the jump from Double-A to the majors in 2009 and was named American League Rookie of the Year by the BBWAA...set an Oakland rookie record with 26 saves, which tied for the sixth highest save total by a rookie in AL history...ranked third among AL relievers in ERA (1.84).

- Has allowed five runs over his last seven games (4.1 ip, 12 h, 5, r, 5 er, 7 so, 10.39 ERA) after yielding just three runs over his previous 12 games and 11.0 innings (2.45 ERA).
- Has held left-handed hitters to a .212 (7 for 33) batting average and has a .378 (17 for 45) mark against right-handers...has also yielded both of his home runs and issued six of his seven walks to righties and has 13 of his 21 strikeouts against lefties.
- Has a 1.69 ERA (2 er in 10.2 ip) in 10 outings on two days rest or more and a 9.82 ERA (8 er in 7.2 ip) in 12 outings on one day of rest or less.
- Faced the Red Sox once last year on April 15 (0.2 ip, 2 h, 4 r, 4 er, 2 bb) and has a 27.04 ERA (2.1 ip, 8 h, 8 r, 7 er, 4 bb, 2 so, 2 hr) in four career outings against Boston.
- Tied his career high for strikeouts with four last Wednesday night in Baltimore...also fanned four against Texas in Oakland Sept. 24, 2009.
- Has surrendered two home runs, which matches his career high as he also allowed two in 2008 and 2009.
