OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have lost five of their last seven games...have lost nine of their past 11 games against the Angels...lost each of the last six games to Los Angeles in Oakland, which is their longest steak against the Angels since dropping seven straight from July 7, 1996-July 13, 1997...are 1-3 on this seven game homestand against Minnesota (1-2) and Los Angeles (0-1).
- Ben Sheets became the 38th active pitcher to reach 1,500 innings and has now pitched 1,502.1 innings in his career...has thrown at least six innings in 10 of his 14 starts...is 1-2 with a 3.48 ERA (17 er in 44.0 ip) over his last seven starts after going 0-2 with a 20.96 ERA (17 er in 7.1 ip) in his previous two starts...is 2-2 with a 2.79 ERA (13 er in 42.0 ip) at home and 0-3 with a 7.79 ERA (28 er in 32.1 ip) on the road.
- Rajai Davis (1 for 3) left the game in the seventh inning with tightness in his left hamstring.
- Kevin Kouzmanoff (1 for 4) singled in the eighth inning to give him 500 hits for his career...extended his hitting streak to eight games and is batting .379 (11 for 29) over that span...has now committed an error in the past two games after going 27 consecutive games without an error...has made six errors this year after making only three in 139 games at third base with San Diego last year.
- . Adam Rosales (1 for 4) committed his first error of the season in the seventh inning after starting the year with a 48-game errorless streak.
- Ryan Sweeney (3 for 4) has hit safely in each of his last nine games against the Angels dating back to last year (.385, 15 for 39) and is a career .355 hitter (44 for 124) against Los Angeles.
- Jim Skaalen was ejected by home plate umpire Eric Cooper in the sixth inning...it was his second ejection with the A's, the first coming May 25, 2009
 against Seattle.

LOS ANGELES NOTES

- The Los Angeles Angels have won a season-high six games in a row and have now won 17 of their past 24 games...are 7-1 on this 14-game road trip through Kansas City (3-1), Seattle (3-0), Oakland (1-0) and Los Angeles (three games).
- Scott Kazmir had his 19.0-inning scoreless streak at the Oakland-Alameda County Coliseum snapped when Jake Fox hit a solo home run to lead off the seventh...has won three of his past four starts (3.70 era, 10 er in 24.1 ip) after dropping three straight...is 9-3 with a 2.85 ERA (28 er in 88.1 ip) in 16 career starts against Oakland...Angels starters are 6-0 with a 1.95 ERA (8 er in 37.0 ip) over the past six games.
- Erick Aybar (1 for 3) is on a five-game hitting streak and is batting .450 (9 for 20) over that span...is now batting .298 (37 for 124) on the road compared to .208 (22 for 106) at home.
- Torii Hunter (0 for 4) had his seven-game hitting streak snapped and is now batting .364 (12 for 33) over his past eight games.
- Hideki Matsui (1 for 4) has hit safely in 13 of his past 16 games and is batting .356 (21 for 59) over that stretch.
