OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics are 11-7 over their last 18 games and are now 20-12 (.625) at home compared to 11-17 (.393) on the road...had a season-high 18 hits...have homered 17 times over the past 14 games to snap a seven-game homerless streak, which was their longest drought in 27 years...snapped their six-game losing streak to Los Angeles in Oakland, which was tied for their longest home losing steak against the Angels since dropping seven straight from July 7, 1996-July 13, 1997...are 2-3 on this seven game homestand against Minnesota (1-2) and Los Angeles (1-1).
- Vin Mazzaro is 2-0 with a 3.53 ERA (6 er in 15.1 ip) over his past four appearances (one start) after allowing four runs in three innings in his season debut...has now thrown six innings or less in each of his last 17 starts, which is the longest such streak by a starting pitcher in Oakland history...A's starting pitchers are 15-8 with a 2.91 ERA (63 er in 194.2 ip) at home this season compared to 7-11 with a 5.01 ERA (84 er in 151.0 ip) on the road.
- Craig Breslow now has a 1.69 ERA (3 er in 16.0 ip) over his last 15 games after compiling a 4.35 ERA over his first 12 appearances.
- Gabe Gross (2 for 5) is batting .340 (16 for 47) over his past 14 games after hitting .196 over his previous 21 contests...is a career .333 hitter (20 for 60) against the Angels.
- Kevin Kouzmanoff (2 for 5) extended his hitting streak to nine games (.368, 14 for 38)...had gone 2 for 23 (.087) over his previous six contests.
- Kurt Suzuki (4 for 5) matched his career-high with four hits...has hit safely in eight of his past nine games and is batting .375 (15 for 40) over that span.
- Ryan Sweeney (3 for 5) had his third straight multiple-hit game and is 8 for 13 (.615) over that span...has hit safely in each of his last 10 games against the Angels dating back to last year (.409, 18 for 44) and is a career .364 hitter (47 for 129) against Los Angeles

LOS ANGELES NOTES

- The Los Angeles Angels had their season-high six-game winning streak snapped...fall to 3-19 when scoring three runs or fewer...are 7-2 on this 14-game road trip through Kansas City (3-1), Seattle (3-0), Oakland (1-1) and Los Angeles (three games).
- Jered Weaver matched his career-high by allowing 12 hits (last: Aug. 1, 2007 at SEA)...had his 16.0-inning scoreless streak snapped in the first inning...had his 32.0-inning homerless streak snapped when Kurt Suzuki homered in the seventh...has thrown six or more innings in 17 of his last 20 regular season starts.
- Bobby Abreu (1 for 4) is batting .200 (7 for 35) this road trip but has reached base safely in 30 of his past 32 starts...is batting .375 (12 for 32) against Oakland this season.
- Erick Aybar (0 for 4) had his five-game hitting streak snapped and is now batting .375 (9 for 24) over his past six games.
- Kevin Frandsen (1 for 3) has hit safely in seven of his past eight games and is batting 333 (10 for 27) over that stretch.
