#### OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have lost six of their last nine games...have lost 11 of their past 13 games to Los Angeles in Oakland...are 2-4 on this seven-game homestand against Minnesota (1-2) and Los Angeles (1-2).
- Dallas Braden** matched his season-high by allowing 11 hits...is 0-4 with a 4.75 ERA (19 er in 36.0 ip) in six starts since pitching his perfect game on May 9...picked Kevin Frandsen off first base in the fourth inning...it was his fifth pickoff this year, which now leads the American League...has walked one batter or fewer in 11 of his 13 starts and has never walked more than one batter in 12 career appearances (eight starts) against the Angels...has now received one run of support or less seven times this season.
- Daric Barton** (3 for 4) tied a season-high with three hits...is batting .333 (19 for 57) with 11 walks over his past 16 games.
- Kevin Kouzmanoff** (2 for 4) extended his hitting streak to a career-high-tying 10 games and is batting .395 (15 for 38) over that span...had gone 2 for 23 (.087) over his previous six contests.
- Adam Rosales** (1 for 3) is batting .344 (21 for 61) over his last 18 games after hitting .243 over his first 32 contests.
- Ryan Sweeney** (0 for 4) had his 10-game hitting streak against the Angels dating back to last year snapped and is now batting .375 (18 for 48) against Los Angeles over his past 11 games.

#### LOS ANGELES NOTES

- The Los Angeles Angels are 18-8 since May 14, which is the best record in the American League over that span...have now won nine of their past 11 contests...are 8-2 on this 14-game road trip through Kansas City (3-1), Seattle (3-0), Oakland (2-1) and Los Angeles (three games)...it is the first time Los Angeles has won eight games in one road trip since June 22 to July 1, 1987, when it went 8-1 against Texas, Chicago and Cleveland.
- Joe Saunders** pitched his second complete game of the season...has allowed two runs in 15 innings (1.20 era) over his past two starts and has now allowed one run or less in five of his past seven starts...is 23-9 following an Angels loss over his career...is 11-4 with a 3.50 ERA (40 er in 103.0 ip) in 13 career starts against Oakland...the 11 wins are his most against any team.
- Erick Aybar** (4 for 5) tied his season-high with four hits...has hit safely in six of his past seven games and is batting .448 (13 for 29) over that span...is hitting .308 (41 for 133) on the road and .208 (22 for 106) at home.
- Kevin Frandsen** (1 for 4) has hit safely in eight of his past nine games and is batting .355 (11 for 31) over that stretch.
- Torii Hunter** (3 for 5) matched his season-high with three hits...is batting .351 (13 for 37) with 11 RBI in nine games this month ...has hit safely in eight of 10 games on the road trip.
