### **OAKLAND NOTES**

- The Oakland Athletics have won 12 of their past 20 games...have a 16-7 (.696) record during day games, which is the best record in the Major Leagues...are 27-0 when leading after seven innings and 26-0 when leading after eight...are 29-4 when scoring four or more runs...went 3-4 on this seven-game homestand against Minnesota (1-2) and Los Angeles (2-2), their first homestand with a losing record this season...begin a nine-game road trip on Friday through San Francisco (three games), Chicago (NL) (three games) and St. Louis (three games).
- Trevor Cahill pitched a career-high eight innings...has thrown at least six innings in six of his nine starts, allowed two runs or fewer six times and walked two or less five times...is 4-0 with a 1.91 ERA (7 er in 33.0 ip) over his last five starts...the winning streak matches his career high...has allowed three runs or less in each of his eight starts since allowing six runs in five innings in his season debut...is 2-1 with a 2.48 ERA (9 er in 31.2 ip) in five career stats against Los Angeles.
- Andrew Bailey now has a 0.60 ERA (1 er in 15.0 ip) in 15 appearances at home this season.
- Daric Barton (1 for 4) is batting .328 (20 for 61) with 12 walks over his past 17 games.
- Kevin Kouzmanoff (2 for 4) extended his hitting streak to a career-high 11 games and is batting .405 (17 for 42) over that span...had gone 2 for 23 (.087) over his previous six contests.
- Kurt Suzuki (2 for 4) is batting .364 (16 for 44) in 10 games in June.
- Ryan Sweeney (1 for 2) is batting .500 (10 for 20) over his past six games...is a career .356 hitter (48 for 135) against Los Angeles, which is tied for the second-highest career average against the team.

### **LOS ANGELES NOTES**

- The Los Angeles Angels are 3-20 when scoring three runs or fewer and 7-22 when their opponents score first...are 8-3 on this 14-game road trip through Kansas City (3-1), Seattle (3-0), Oakland (2-2) and Los Angeles (three games).
- Ervin Santana had his five-game winning streak snapped, which was his longest since winning six straight to open the 2008 season (April 3-May 5)... Angels starting pitchers have 7.37 ERA (134 er in 163.2 ip) in their 30 losses compared to a 2.09 ERA (52 er in 224.1 ip) in 33 wins.
- Jason Bulger has not allowed a run in 16 of his past 18 appearances.
- Erick Aybar (2 for 4) has hit safely in seven of his past eight games and is batting .454 (15 for 33) over that span...is hitting .314 (43 for 137) on the road and .208 (22 for 106) at home.
- Torii Hunter (1 for 4) is batting .341 (14 for 41) in 10 games this month ... has hit safely in nine of 11 games on the road trip.
- Hideki Matsui (1 for 4) has hit safely in 15 of his past 19 games and is hitting .333 (24 for 72) over that stretch...is batting .316 (12 for 38) against the A's this season.
