OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have lost six of their past seven games and nine of their last 11 to move to a season-high five games under .500...are 6-15 in June, which is the second-worst record in the American League (Baltimore, 4-15)...are now 17-30 (.362) at night compared to 17-9 (.654) during the day...are 0-2 on this six-game homestand against Cincinnati (0-2) and Pittsburgh (three games).
- Dallas Braden** is 0-5 with a 4.31 ERA (23 er in 48.0 ip) in eight starts since pitching his perfect game on May 9...the eight-start winless streak ties Mark Buehrle for the longest such streak in Major League history following a perfect game...has thrown six or more innings in 12 of his 15 starts this season and has walked one batter or fewer 13 times...is 0-3 with a 2.97 ERA (10 er in 30.1 ip) in five career interleague starts...A's starting pitchers are 2-7 with a 4.46 ERA (39 er in 78.2 ip) over their past 13 games.
- Brad Ziegler** has retired 20 of his last 22 first batters faced and they are now 4 for 34 (.118) with a walk this season...has a 1.04 ERA (2 er in 17.1 ip) at home this season compared to a 5.09 ERA (10 er in 17.2) ip on the road.
- Conor Jackson** (1 for 4) recorded his 500th career hit with an infield single in the sixth inning...is 8 for 25 (.320) in eight games since he was acquired from Arizona.
- Kevin Kouzmanoff** (0 for 3) had his 16-game home hitting streak snapped and is now batting .358 (24 for 67) in his past 17 contests at the Coliseum...it was tied for the third-longest such streak in Oakland history.
- Cliff Pennington** (2 for 3) has committed an error in each of the past two games...has now made six errors in his last 13 games after making five errors in his first 56 contests.

CINCINNATI NOTES

- The Cincinnati Reds have now won their past two games after losing six of their previous seven...are 22-7 when scoring first, 29-2 when leading after seven innings and 32-2 when leading after eight...are 2-3 on this six-game road trip through Seattle (0-3) and Oakland (2-0).
- Bronson Arroyo** has now pitched eight or more innings four times this season...has thrown at least seven innings in each of his past four starts and five of his past six...Reds starters have a 2.84 ERA (10 er in 31.2 ip) in five games during this road trip.
- Francisco Cordero** recorded his 268th career save, which moves him past Bob Wickman for sole possession of 25th place on the all-time saves list.
- Brandon Phillips** (3 for 5) is hitting .398 (39 for 98) over his past 23 games after batting .257 (48 for 187) in his first 48 contests.
- Scott Rolan** (2 for 4) is batting .359 (28 for 78) over his past 20 games.
- Joey Votto** (1 for 5) has reached base safely in each of his last 31 games, which is the second-longest such streak in the Major Leagues this year (Evan Longoria, 32 games)...it is the longest streak by a Reds player since Austin Kearns reached base in 32 consecutive games in 2003 (April 19-May 25).
