#### OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have won back-to-back games for the first time since winning four straight from May 26-29...are 23-16 at home compared to 13-24 on the road...had their eighth shutout this season...are 8-0 all-time against the Pirates, the only team the A's have never lost to...are 2-3 on this six-game homestand against Cincinnati (0-3) and Pittsburgh (2-0).
- Trevor Cahill** recorded a career high 10 strikeouts...the 10 strikeouts matched a season high for the A's (Dallas Braden, April 6 vs. SEA)...has a six-game winning streak over his last eight starts and has a 2.21 ERA (13 er in 53.0 ip) over that span...it is the longest winning streak by an A's starting pitcher since Dan Haren won 10 straight from April 18-July 1, 2007...has not allowed a run in the first inning this year and has gone 15 consecutive starts without allowing a run in the first dating back to last season...is 3-0 with a 2.46 ERA (7 er in 25.2 ip) in four interleague starts this year.
- Craig Breslow** has retired each of the last 18 batters he has faced and opponents are 1 for 32 (.031) against him over his past 12 appearances.
- Daric Barton** (3 for 4) tied an Oakland record with three doubles and had a career high four RBI...is on a six-game hitting streak and is batting .381 (8 for 21) over that stretch.
- Coco Crisp** (2 for 3) has hit safely in each of his four games since being activated off the DL and is batting .438 (7 for 16) over that span.
- Jack Cust** (1 for 3) is batting .333 (18 for 54) over his last 18 games after hitting .229 over his first 15 contests.
- Kurt Suzuki** (1 for 4) hit his ninth home run and is now batting .298 (25 for 84) with five home runs and 13 RBI in 20 games in June.

#### PITTSBURGH NOTES

- The Pittsburgh Pirates have lost five in a row and are 5-23 over their past 28 games...have lost 16 consecutive road games, which is their longest such streak since losing a club record 19 straight in 1985...were shut out for the eighth time this season...are 0-5 on this nine-game road trip through Texas (0-3), Oakland (0-2) and Chicago (NL) (three games).
- Daniel McCutchen** set career highs in innings pitched (6) and pitches thrown (103)...is now 0-2 with an 11.33 ERA (13 er in 10.1 ip) in three starts on the road.
- Pedro Alvarez** (0 for 3) had two strikeouts and has now struck out at least once in each of his 10 games this season (17 total).
- Lastings Milledge** (1 for 3) has hit safely in 12 of his last 13 starts (.396, 19 for 48) and has reached base safely in 35 of his last 39 starts.
