OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have won three games in a row for the first time since winning four straight from May 26-29...earned their third sweep of
 the season and their first since May 21-23 against San Francisco...are 18-10 in day games compared to a 19-30 record at night...are 13-7 in
 one-run games, which is the second best record in the American League (Chicago, 15-8)...are 9-0 all-time against the Pirates, the only team
 the A's have never lost to...went 3-3 on this six-game homestand against Cincinnati (0-3) and Pittsburgh (3-0)...begin a six-game road trip on
 Tuesday through Baltimore (three games) and Cleveland (three games).
- Gio Gonzalez has a 1.30 ERA (5 er in 34.2 ip) in five starts during the day and a 5.11 ERA (35 er in 61.2 ip) in 11 starts at night...has a 2.36 ERA (14 er in 53.1 ip) in eight starts at home and a 5.44 ERA (26 er in 43.0 ip) in eight starts on the road.
- Craig Breslow committed a fielding error in the eighth that allowed Garret Jones to reach base, the first batter to reach base against him after retiring the previous 19 batters he had faced...opponents remain hitless against him in his past eight games (6.0 ip) and are 1 for 35 (.029) against him over his past 13 appearances.
- Daric Barton (0 for 4) had his six-game hitting streak snapped and is now batting .320 (8 for 25) over his past seven games.
- Cliff Pennington (1 for 2) is batting .447 (21 for 47) over his last 15 games after going 2 for 46 (.065) over his previous 14 contests...batted .396 (21 for 53) in interleague play, which is the third highest average by an A's player for a single season.
- Kurt Suzuki (1 for 4) has homered in back-to-back games for the third time this season (Apr. 22-23 vs. NYY and CLE, June 2-3 at BOS) and now has six home runs in June.

PITTSBURGH NOTES

- The Pittsburgh Pirates have lost six in a row and are 5-24 over their past 29 games...have lost 17 consecutive road games, which is their longest such streak since losing a club record 19 straight in 1985...are 0-6 on this nine-game road trip through Texas (0-3), Oakland (0-3) and Chicago (NL) (three games).
- Ross Ohlendorf has not received more than three runs of support in any of his 11 outings this season...has a 2.16 ERA (6 er in 25.0 ip) in four starts on the road this season.
- Bobby Crosby (1 for 4) is 11 for 26 (.423) over his past seven games.
- Lastings Milledge (2 for 4) has hit safely in 13 of his last 14 starts (.404, 21 for 52) and has reached base safely in 36 of his last 40 starts.
