### OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics are 4-15 against New York over the past three years...are 0-1 on this six-game homestand against New York (0-1) and Los Angeles (three games).
- Ben Sheets pitched a season-high 7.1 innings and retired the last 15 batters he faced...has allowed at least three extra-base hits in each of his last eight starts, which is the longest such streak in Oakland history...has received three runs of support or fewer in 14 of his 18 starts this season ...is 2-5 with a 6.20 ERA (31 er in 45.0 ip) in eight starts against the American League East this year and 1-3 with a 3.94 ERA (27 er in 61.2 ip) in 10 starts against everyone else.
- Michael Wuertz has not allowed a run over his past eight appearances (6.1 ip) after allowing seven runs in his previous six appearances (5.1 ip, 11.82 ERA).
- Coco Crisp (0 for 3) is 0 for 13 over his last four games after batting .407 (11 for 27) in his first seven games following his reinstatement from the disabled list on June 22.
- Kevin Kouzmanoff (1 for 3) snapped his 0 for 30 streak with a fourth-inning single...the streak was the longest since Scott Brosius also had a 0 for 30 streak from August 26-September 19, 1995.
- Cliff Pennington (1 for 3) is batting .432 (32 for 74) over his last 22 contests after going 3 for 46 (.065) over his previous 14 games.

#### **NEW YORK NOTES**

- The New York Yankees are now a season-high 20 games over .500...have won eight of their past 11 road games...have won four of their past five games overall and eight of their last 12...are 45-0 when leading after eight innings...are 16-9 (.640) at Oakland dating back to 2004, which is the highest winning percentage by any American League team in Oakland over that span...are 1-0 on this seven-game road trip through Oakland (1-0) and Seattle (four games).
- Javier Vazquez made his 400<sup>th</sup> career start, becoming the seventh pitcher to do so as a Yankee...New York is now the only team with two active pitchers with 400 or more starts (Andy Pettitte, 474)...has struck out at least one batter in 337 consecutive games, the longest such streak among active players...is 4-2 with a 2.93 ERA (15 er in 46.0 ip) over his past seven starts.
- Derek Jeter (1 for 4) has gone 19 consecutive games without a RBI, the longest such streak of his career.
- Mark Teixeira (1 for 4) has hit safely in 22 of his past 25 games and is hitting .319 (30 for 94) during that stretch...has 10 hits in his last 22 at-bats (.455).
