OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have lost two in a row after losing two of their previous nine games...are 4-16 against New York over the past three years...are 0-2 on this six-game homestand against New York (0-2) and Los Angeles (three games).
- Trevor Cahill** had his career-high seven-game winning streak snapped and is now 7-1 with a 2.76 ERA (20 er in 65.1 ip) over his last 10 starts...the winning streak was the second-longest in the American League this season (Lester, BOS, 8) and was the longest by an A's starter since Dan Haren had a 10-game winning streak from April 18-July 1, 2007...allowed a season-high-tying six runs (April 30 at TOR).
- Daric Barton** (0 for 3) was ejected by home plate umpire Mike Winters in the fifth inning, his first career ejection.
- Coco Crisp** (1 for 2) snapped his 0 for 15 streak with a first-inning single but is 1 for 15 over his last five games after batting .407 (11 for 27) in his first seven games following his reinstatement from the disabled list on June 22...now has 19 career steals against New York, his most against any team.
- Rajai Davis** (1 for 3) ended his 0 for 11 streak with a third-inning single but is 2 for 31 over his last 11 games...has gone 11 games without a stolen base, matching his longest such streak as an Athletic (June 29-July 13, 2008).

NEW YORK NOTES

- The New York Yankees have won four in a row and eight of their last 13 and are now a season-high 21 games over .500...have won nine of their past 12 road games...are now 20-7-1 in series this season, the most series wins in the Major Leagues...are 9-5-0 in road series...are 17-9 (.654) at Oakland dating back to 2004, which is the highest winning percentage by any American League team in Oakland over that span...had lost 11 of their previous 15 games in Oakland from 2001 to 2003...are 2-0 on this seven-game road trip through Oakland (2-0) and Seattle (four games).
- CC Sabathia** has won seven straight starts after going winless in his previous five starts...is the second time in his career he has won seven in a row (Aug. 6-Sept. 7, 2005) and the first time a Yankee starter has won seven straight since Roger Clemens won eight consecutive games from May 26-July 4, 2001...had season highs in strikeouts (10) and pitches thrown (118).
- Derek Jeter** (0 for 3) snapped his 19-game streak without a RBI, which was the longest such streak of his career.
- Alex Rodriguez** (2 for 3) hit his 21st career grand slam, which ties Manny Ramirez for second in Major League history (Gehrig, 23)...it was the ninth this season for the Yankees, which leads the Major Leagues...had his first two home run game of the season...now has 21 career home runs at the Coliseum, the most ever by a visiting player (previous: Rafael Palmeiro, 20)...has at least one RBI in 11 of his last 14 games and has a total of 23 RBI over that stretch.
- Mark Teixeira** (0 for 3, hbp) has reached base safely in each of his last 27 games, the second-longest such streak by a Yankee this season (Jeter, 28 games, May 12-June 10).
