#### **OAKLAND NOTES**

- The Oakland Athletics were swept by the Yankees after going 7-2 over their previous nine games against Pittsburgh, Baltimore and Cleveland...had not been swept by New York in Oakland since May 13-15, 2005 and are now 4-17 against the Yankees over the past three years...are now 20-29 against opponents that were at or above .500 when playing them and 21-16 against teams that were below .500...are 0-3 on this six-game homestand against New York (0-3) and Los Angeles (three games).
- Gio Gonzalez tied his season-high with five walks...has had run support of three runs or less in each of his last six starts and 12 of his 18 starts this season overall...is 1-2 with a 6.60 ERA (11 er in 15.0 ip) in three career starts against the Yankees.
- Daric Barton (0 for 3) is 0 for 12 in his past four games after going 16 for 43 (.372) over his previous 12 contests.
- Ryan Sweeney (2 for 4) now has a 51-game homerless streak, which ties his career-high (Aug. 28, 2009-May 3, 2010).

- The New York Yankees have won five in a row and are now a season-high 22 games over .500...have won four straight road games and 10 of their past 13 games away from Yankee Stadium...earned their fifth series sweep of the season and their first on the road...are 18-9 (.667) at Oakland dating back to 2004, which is the highest winning percentage by any American League team in Oakland over that span...are 3-0 on this seven-game road trip through Oakland (3-0) and Seattle (four games).
- A.J. Burnett has allowed no runs over 13.2 innings in two starts in July after going 0-5 with a 11.35 ERA in June...has held opponents to two earned runs or less eight times in 17 starts this season...has a 2.60 ERA (8 er in 27.2 ip) in four career starts in Oakland.
- Nick Swisher (3 for 4) equaled his season-high with three hits.
- Mark Teixeira (1 for 4) has reached base safely in each of his last 28 games, matching Derek Jeter (May 12-June 10) for the longest such streak by a Yankee this season...has also hit safely in 16 of 18 games and is batting .304 (21 for 69) over that span.
