#### OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have lost four straight after going 7-2 over their previous nine games...are 20-30 against opponents that were at or above .500 when playing them and 21-16 against teams that were below .500...have lost seven of their past 10 one-run games but are 13-9 in such contests this season...are 3-5 in extra-inning games...have lost 11 of their last 15 games to the Angels in Oakland...are 0-4 on this six-game homestand against New York (0-3) and Los Angeles (0-1).
- Vin Mazzaro** has a 3.12 ERA (15 er in 43.1 ip) over his past seven starts after posting a 6.08 ERA (9 er in 13.1 ip) in his first four outings (one start).
- Daric Barton** (0 for 5) is 0 for 17 in his past five games after going 16 for 43 (.372) over his previous 12 contests.
- Jack Cust** (1 for 4) ended his 22-game homerless streak with a solo shot in the sixth inning...the streak was his second-longest as an Athletic (26, July 21-Aug. 17, 2009).
- Cliff Pennington** (2 for 4) is batting .420 (34 for 81) with 10 multiple-hit games over his past 25 games after going 3 for 46 (.065) over his previous 14 contests.
- Ryan Sweeney** (1 for 4) extended his homerless streak to 52 games, which is a new career high.
- Brett Anderson** allowed one run on four hits over two innings in his first rehab start with the A's Arizona League affiliate against the Angels...he struck out two and walked none.

#### LOS ANGELES NOTES

- The Los Angeles Angels snapped their five-game road losing streak and are 17-10 in their last 27 road games overall...are 4-3 in extra-inning contests this season...have now outscored their opponents 55-33 in the first inning...are 15-10 in one-run games...are 1-4 on this seven-game road trip through Chicago (0-4) and Oakland (1-0).
- Joel Pineiro** has pitched six or more innings in nine straight starts and in 16 of 18 starts this season...has a 2.33 ERA (13 er in 50.1 ip) over his past seven starts.
- Bobby Abreu** (3 for 4) is batting .366 (15 for 41) against Oakland this season...has reached base safely in 50 of his last 58 starts.
- Erick Aybar** (2 for 5) has now hit safely in 11 of his past 12 games (.346, 18 for 52)...is hitting .314 (54 for 172) on the road compared to .241 (35 for 145) at home.
- Howie Kendrick** (0 for 4) had his 10-game road hitting streak snapped and is now batting .422 (19 for 45) over his past 11 road games.
