#### OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have won their past two games after losing four in a row...are now 20-10 in day games compared to 23-36 at night...earned the series win over Los Angeles in Oakland for only the second time in the past 10 series (last: Sept. 16-18, 2008)...went 2-4 on this six-game homestand against New York (0-3) and Los Angeles (2-1) that takes them into the All-Star Break...begin post-break play with a three-game road trip to Kansas City.
- Trevor Cahill** is 8-1 with a 2.49 ERA (20 er in 72.1 ip) over his past 11 starts...is 4-1 with a 1.60 ERA (7 er in 39.1 ip) in six starts during the day and 5-2 with a 3.88 ERA (24 er in 55.2 ip) in nine starts at night...is 3-1 with a 2.10 ERA (9 er in 38.2 ip) in six career starts against Los Angeles.
- Andrew Bailey** earned his 44<sup>th</sup> career save, which ties him for seventh place in Oakland history (Koch, Foulke)...has been named to the American League All-Star team...he replaces Jered Weaver, who replaced Cahill...it is the first time the A's have had multiple players named to the All-Star team since 2004 (Mark Mulder, Tim Hudson)...Bailey is the first Athletic to be an All-Star in back-to-back seasons since Mulder made the team from 2003-2004...is also the first A's closer to be named to the team in consecutive seasons since Dennis Eckersley (1991-1992).
- Jack Cust** (2 for 4) has now homered in two of his past three games after going 22 consecutive games without a home run, which was his second-longest such streak as an Athletic (26, July 21-Aug. 17, 2009)...had the fifth stolen base of his career in the sixth inning (last: Aug. 4, 2009 vs. TEX)...is now batting .386 (17 for 44) during the day compared to .250 (23 for 92) at night.
- Ryan Sweeney** (1 for 4) is 15 for 46 (.326) against the Angels this year and is a career .345 hitter (50 for 145) against Los Angeles, the fifth-best average against the club all-time (minimum 150 plate appearances).

#### LOS ANGELES NOTES

- The Los Angeles Angels have lost three straight series for the first times since July 17-25, 2007 (vs. TB, MIN, OAK)...have lost seven of their past eight road games after going 16-5 over their previous 21 road games...are off to a 3-8 start in July after going 18-9 in June...went 1-6 on this seven-game road trip through Chicago (0-4) and Oakland (1-2) that takes them into the All-Star Break...begin post-break play with a four-game homestand against Seattle.
- Jered Weaver** has allowed nine runs in 12.1 innings (6.57 ERA) over his past two starts after going 3-0 with a 1.67 ERA (5 er in 27.0 ip) in his previous four starts...is 0-2 with a 8.25 ERA (11 er in 12.0 ip) in two starts in Oakland this season...has pitched at least six innings 17 times in 19 starts this season and in 23 of his last 26 starts dating back to last season...Angels starters have a 7.43 ERA (203 er in 246.0 ip) in losses and a 2.13 ERA (76 er in 320.1 ip) in wins this season.
- Bobby Abreu** (2 for 4) is batting .362 (17 for 48) against the A's this season...has reached base safely in 51 of his last 60 starts.
- Erick Aybar** (3 for 5) is hitting .317 (57 for 180) on the road compared to .241 (35 for 145) at home...is a career .371 hitter (65 for 175) in July.
- Kevin Frandsen** (0 for 3) is hitless in his past 19 at-bats, his longest hitless streak since joining the Angels.
