OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have won six of their past seven games and 13 of 20 since losing 10 of their previous 12 games...improve to 15-10 in one-run games and 4-5 in extra-inning games...have stolen at least one base in seven consecutive games, which matches their season high (May 28-June 3)...are 1-1 on this six-game homestand against Boston (1-1) and Chicago (three games).
- Dallas Braden is 0-5 with a 4.10 ERA (24 er in 52.2 ip) in nine starts since pitching his perfect game on May 9...the nine starts without a win following a perfect game is the longest such streak in Major League history...has walked one batter or fewer in 14 of his 16 starts this season...is 3-1 with a 2.86 ERA (11 er in 34.2 ip) in six starts against American League East teams and is 1-6 with a 4.22 ERA (30 er in 64.0 ip) in 10 starts against everyone else.
- Craig Breslow made his 200th career appearance.
- Coco Crisp (1 for 5) snapped his 0 for 18 streak with a third-inning double...is 7 for 54 (.130) over his past 14 games after going 11 for 27 (.407) in his first seven games following his reinstatement from the disabled list June 22...was ejected by home plate umpire Bob Davidson in the 10th inning.
- Gabe Gross (0 for 4) is hitless in his past 16 at-bats and is batting .156 (12 for 77) over his past 28 games...that has dropped his batting average to .240, the lowest it has been since it was .238 on May 23.
- Kurt Suzuki (1 for 2) is a .346 career hitter (36 for 104) against the Red Sox, his second-highest average against any AL team (New York, .354).

BOSTON NOTES

- The Boston Red Sox have dropped nine of their past 13 games...have lost 10 of their last 16 games away from Fenway Park...have lost 14 of their last 20 games against the A's in Oakland...are 1-1 on this 10-game road trip through Oakland (1-1), Seattle (four games) and Los Angeles (three games).
- Tim Wakefield snapped his career-high nine-start streak of allowing at least one home run, which was the longest such streak by a Red Sox pitcher since Roger Clemens allowed homers in 10 straight from April 11-June 1, 1986.
- Daniel Bard has not allowed a run in a career-high 13 straight outings (12.2 ip).
- Mike Cameron (1 for 3) has hit safely in 10 of his past 13 games and is batting .326 (14 for 43) over that span...is hitting .320 (16 for 50) over his past 15 road games.
- Darnell McDonald (2 for 4) snapped his 0 for 12 streak with a RBI double in the second inning...has hit safely in 11 of his last 14 road games and is hitting .333 (16 for 48) over that span.
- Marco Scutaro (2 for 5) has hit safely in 19 of his last 22 games (.276, 27 for 98)...is batting .246 (16 for 65) in July but is hitting .305 (61 for 200) over his past 45 games.
- John Farrell was ejected by home plate umpire Bob Davidson in the 10th inning.
