OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have won 10 of their last 11 day games and are 27-11 during the day this season, which is the best record in the Major Leagues...have won 10 of their last 14 games at home...are 22-11 in the third game of a series this year...went 4-2 on this six-game homestand against Kansas City (2-1) and Texas (2-1)...begin a six-game road trip through Seattle (three games) and Minnesota (three games) tomorrow.
- Trevor Cahill had his career-high 23.0-inning scoreless streak snapped in the sixth inning...has a streak of 19 consecutive starts with six hits or fewer and five innings pitched or more, which is the second-longest such streak in modern Major League history (20, Nolan Ryan, July 27, 1972-April 18, 1973)...is 5-1 with a 1.33 ERA (7 er in 47.1 ip) in seven starts during the day...is 5-1 with a 1.11 ERA (6 er in 48.2 ip) in seven starts against the American League West this season...is 6-1 with a 1.55 ERA (9 er in 52.1 ip) in eight career starts against the Rangers.
- Daric Barton (0 for 1) left the game in the fifth inning due to left shoulder spasms.
- Coco Crisp (2 for 4) is 9 for 22 (.409) in six games against Texas this season and is a career .292 (50 for 171) hitter against the Rangers.
- Mark Ellis (1 for 3) doubled in the second inning to snap a 15-game streak without an extra-base hit, which was the second longest such streak of his career (16 games, July 19-Aug. 6, 2006)...is batting is 8 for 52 (.154) over his last 17 games...is 2 for 19 (.105) against Texas this year but is a career .301 (120 for 399) hitter against the team.
- Cliff Pennington (1 for 4) has committed 12 errors in his last 49 games after making five in over his first 56 games...has 17 errors this season, which are the most among American League shortstops and second most in the Major Leagues (Desmond, WAS 26).
- Kurt Suzuki (0 for 3) committed his career-high eighth error of the season, which is second among American League catchers (Kendall, KC 11)...is 6 for 34 (.176) over his last nine games after batting .405 (17 for 42) in his previous 11 games.
- Matt Watson (0 for 0) is being treated for a non-baseball related injury.

TEXAS NOTES

- The Texas Rangers have lost 16 of their last 24 against the A's dating back to last season...went 4-5 on the nine-game road trip through Los Angeles (1-2), Seattle (2-1) and Oakland (1-2)...begin a five-game homestand against New York (two games) and Boston (three games) Tuesday.
- Colby Lewis remains winless in his past four starts but has a 3.12 ERA (9 er in 26.0 ip) over that span...is 2-2 with a 3.06 ERA (17 er in 50.0 ip) in 10 games, eight starts, against Oakland.
- Darren O'Day has pitched 25 consecutive scoreless innings over his last 26 appearances, which is the longest active scoreless streak in the Major Leagues.
- Elvis Andrus (1 for 3) committed a fielding error in the fifth inning, which snapped his career-high 25-game errorless streak...hit safely in seven of nine games this road trip (.364, 12 for 33) but is batting .228 (29 for 127) over his last 33 games.
- Nelson Cruz (0 for 3) had his career-high 25-game on-base streak snapped and is now batting .337 (34 for 101) over his last 26 games...batted .194 (6 for 31) on the road trip but is hitting .344 (31 for 90) in 23 games since the All-Star Break.
- Josh Hamilton (2 for 4) is batting .406 (39 for 96) over his last 25 games...has reached base in 55 of his last 60 games...is batting .388 (19 for 49) against the A's this season and is a career .327 (55 for 168) hitter against Oakland.
