- Tonight, the Blue Jays continue their 10-day, 9-game road trip with the opener of a 3-game series vs. the A's...Are 2-1 on the current trip after taking two of three from the Angels following yesterday's 4-1 victory in the series finale...Following the series with A's, enjoy an off-day on Aug. 19 before concluding the trip in BOS vs. the **Red Sox** in a **3**-game weekend set.
- Are 31-31 away from Rogers Centre this season...Have not been over .500 on the road since June 27 (20-19)...The Jays are 10-6 on the road since the All-Star break...Have now won back to back series on the road (NYY & LAA) for the 1st time since May 3-9 (CLE & CWS).

- The Blue Jays are 2nd in the Majors with 78-HR hit on the road this season (BOS leads with 91)...TOR ranks $\mathbf{2}^{nd}$ in the Majors with 220-XBH on the road (BOS leads 230)...Jose Bautista leads the Club & ranks T-4th in the AL with 13-HR hit on the road this season.

◆ Yesterday, Jose Bautista had streak of 11 straight series with a home run come to an end as he failed to go deep in the previous 3-game set vs. the Angels...The 11 straight series with a HR set a new Blue Jay record, surpassing the previous best (Carlos Delgado-10 in 2001)...In fact, it was the longest streak by any major-league player since Ryan Howard of PHI had an 11series streak in 2008.
