WHERE WE STAND:

- ◆ The Jays own a record of **63-55** & sit **4th** in the **AL East, 9.0 GB** of the **1st** place **Yankees (72-46) & Rays (72-46)**...Are **3.5 GB** of the **3rd** place **Red Sox (67-52) & 21.5 GA** of the **5th** place **Orioles (42-77)**.
- ◆ Are **eight** games above **.500** for the **1st** time since **June 6 (33-25)**...Have not been a **season high nine** games above **.500** since **June 5 (33-24)**.
- ◆ The Jays are **T-2nd** in the **ML & 2nd** in the **AL** with a **.655 (19-10)** winning % post **All-Star break (MIN** leads the **AL** at **.733)**...The Jays have won **four** of their last **five, seven** of their last **10, nine** of the last **14 & 13** of the last **19** contests.

ROAD WARRIORS:

- ◆ Own a record of **32-31** away from **Rogers Centre & are** now over **.500** for the **1st** time since **June 27 (20-19)**...The Jays are **11-6** on the road since the **All-Star break**...Are looking to win **three** straight series on the road for the **1st** time since **Apr. 10-26, 2009 (CLE, MIN & CWS)**.
- ◆ The Blue Jays are **2nd** in the **Majors** with **80-HR** hit on the road this season (**BOS** leads with **91**)...**Jose Bautista** leads the Club & ranks **T-3rd** in the **AL** with **14-HR** hit on the road this season.
- ◆ The Jays **lead the AL** with **20** saves on the road & have recorded the most strikeouts at **444**.

DID YOU KNOW:

- ◆ Last night at OAK represented the **20th** time **one-hitter** in Club history (**3rd** this season)...The **three one-hitters** match the most by the Jays in **one** season (**2nd** time) & **1st** since **Dave Stieb** accomplished the feat on his own back in **1988** when he tossed **three 1-hitters** that year.
- ◆ The Jays have had **eight** games this season where the starter has gone at least **5.0 IP** without allowing a hit...That **ties a ML record** for the most in a season (**6th** time, last **CWS** in '08).

BLUE JAYS vs. ATHLETICS:

- ◆ **2010:** Play the A's **seven** times this season, **four** at **Rogers Centre & three** at **Alameda County Coliseum**.
- ◆ Are **4-1** vs. **OAK (3-1** at home & **1-0** on the road)...Have won **eight** of their last **10** dating back to '09...Are **18-9** dating back to the end of '07...Coming into this year, have won **three** straight season series in OAK going **11-5** (including **2010**).
- ◆ **LAST SEASON:** Posted an overall record of **6-3 (2-1** at home & **4-2** on the road).
- ◆ **ALL-TIME:** Overall are **167-191, 79-99** at home & **88-92** on the road...With last night's victory have now won three straight season series vs. OAK & are **16-8** over that span.

SIGN THEM UP:

- ◆ Last night, the Toronto Blue Jays agreed to terms with their **11th** overall pick from the **2010 June Draft, RHP William (Deck) McGuire**...In addition to McGuire, the Blue Jays also agreed to terms with **LHP Griffin Murphy (2nd** round - **61st** overall), **RHP Samuel Dyson (4th** round), & **SS Dickie Thon (5th** round) prior to last night's 11:59 pm deadline.

KING OF THE YARD:

- ◆ Last night at OAK, **Jose Bautista** hit his **Major League leading 37th** HR of the season (**six** more than **A. Dunn** who ranks **2nd**)...**Jose** also **leads the Majors** with **13-HR** since the **All-Star break & leads the AL** in **August** with **6-HR**...Has now homered **11** times over his last **20** games...Dating back to **Sept. 1, 2009, Bautista leads the Majors with 47-HR, 11** more than **Albert Pujols** with **36** who ranks **2nd** over that time.

ON FIRE:

- ◆ Since the **All-Star break, Jose Bautista leads the Majors** in **HR (13), RBI (33), SLG (.755), XBH (22) & TB (83)**...In those **29** games since the **ASB**, is batting **.318 (35-110)** with a **.411 OBP**.
- ◆ In **28** contests since the break, **Adam Lind** is batting **.311 (33-106)** with **14-XBH (7-2B, 2-3B, 5-HR)**...Over his last **12** games, is batting **.409 (18-44)** with **4-2B, 1-3B, 3-HR & 7-RBI**.

LEADING THE WAY:

- ◆ The Blue Jays **lead the Majors** with **183-HR** this season, **22** more than **BOS** who rank **2nd** with **161**...Also **lead the Majors** with **47-HR** hit **after the break (4** more than **BOS** who rank **2nd**) & **lead with 25-HR** in **August (1** more than **BOS** who rank **2nd**).
- ◆ The Jays also **lead the Majors** with **451 XBH** this season & rank **2nd** with a **.458 SLG (BOS** leads at **.459)**.

GOING THE DISTANCE:

- ◆ Last night at OAK, **Shaun Marcum** tossed a CG, one hitter (9.0, ER, BB, 5K, HR), the **1st** **CG of his Major League career**...It was the **5th** time a Jay has tossed a CG this season & the **3rd** different player (**Romero-3X & Morrow** being the others).
- ◆ Marcum became the **10th** different Blue Jay pitcher (**16th** time overall by an individual) to toss a **complete game one-hitter in Club history**...It was the **2nd** of the season, both occurring in the month of **August (previous: Morrow, Aug. 8 vs. TB)**.

ZERO-ING IN:

- ◆ Last night, **Shaun Marcum** had a no-hitter going after **six** **innings** vs. the A's...It was the **5th** time this season that a Toronto starter had gone thru **six** **innings** without allowing a hit...The last team to have **five** games where their starter had a **no-hitter thru at least six** **innings** was the **1992 A's...courtesy of Elias**

CLOSE, BUT NO CIGAR:

8/8 vs. TB, carried a **no-hitter** into the **9th inning with two outs** before giving up a single to Evan Longoria...Became the **6th pitcher (9th time)** in franchise history to lose a no-hit bid in the 9th inn (previous: Dustin McGowan on June 24, 2007 vs. COL).

MAKING THEM MISS:

8/8 vs. TB recorded a **career high 17 strikeouts** which is the **most by any pitcher in the majors this season & ranks 2nd on the all-time Club list** for most-SO in a single game (one shy of Roger Clemens' 18 on Aug. 25, 1998 vs. KC).

Has won a **career high four consecutive starts** and has not lost since **6/29 @ CLE (6 starts total)**.

BETTER AT HOME:

At Rogers Centre is **7-1** in 11 starts with a **2.83 ERA**, allowing only **21 walks in 76 innings**...Has struggled to date on the road posting a **2-5** record with an **6.44 ERA** in 11 road starts, **walking 36 batters in 57.1 innings**.

Has allowed **three or less runs 15 times in 22 starts**.

Walked six, losing 6-7 at BOS, May 10...1.2IP, 3H, 6ER, 6BB, 4K... **Set a Blue Jays record with five walks in one inning**

Picked up his 1st win as a Blue Jay Apr. 19 vs. KC (8-1)...Did not allow a hit until the **6th inning (7.0IP, 3H, ER, 2BB, 8K)**

Made his debut as a Blue Jay, April 9 at BAL...Received a no-decision in a 7-6 win (5IP, 4H, 5ER, HR, 5BB, 5K).

Is now 13-9 with a 4.44 ERA in 37 games as a starter...Although has held opponents to a .241 average when starting.

Was acquired from Seattle December 23, 2009 in exchange for RHP Brandon League OF Johermyn Chavez.

2009 SEASON:

Began season as the closer and converted first six save opportunities to begin the season, April 9-May 10...Had 1.29 ERA (1 ER, 7.0 IP) in first 7 relief appearances.

Finished the 2009 season 2-1, 3.68 ERA, 51.1 IP, 43 K, as a starter (10 starts).

Set a career high with **10 games started** and **69.2 IP**.

On 15-day disabled list with biceps tendinitis in right arm, April 24-May 9.

2008 SEASON:

Made his 1st Major League start Sept. 5 vs. NYY and pitched 7.2 IP, H, ER, 9K...Tossed 7.2 hitless innings

In 40 relief appearances went 1-2 with 10 saves and a 1.47 ERA. (6ER, 36.2IP)

STRETCH OF ZEROS

Recorded a career high **17.2 consecutive scoreless innings streak** from May 27-July 9 which was the longest stretch by a Mariner in 2008. Held opponents to a .036 AVG (2-55) with 23K over that time.
