OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have won six consecutive home series, their longest such streak since also winning six consecutive home series from July 27 to September 3, 2006...had their sixth walk-off win of the season...are 43-19 when stealing a base and 16-41 with no stolen bases...have won 12 of their last 14 day games and are 29-12 during the day for the season, which is the best record in the Major Leagues...are 2-1 on this seven-game homestand against Toronto (2-1) and Tampa Bay (four games).
- Gio Gonzalez has allowed one run or fewer in seven of his last 11 starts and is 4-3 with a 2.42 ERA (19 er in 70.2 ip) over that span after going 1-2 with a 5.65 ERA over his previous five starts...is 6-1 with a 2.01 ERA (14 er in 62.2 ip) in nine starts during the day compared to 4-7 with a 4.34 ERA (44 er in 91.1 ip) in 16 starts at night...is 1-1 with a 3.20 ERA (7 er in 19.2 ip) in three career starts against Toronto...A's starting pitchers have allowed one earned run or fewer in eight of the last 11 games for a 1.52 ERA (13 er in 77.0 ip) but are 4-6 over that stretch.
- Coco Crisp (3 for 3) has had back-to-back three-hit games (.857, 6 for 7)...the three hits match a season high (four times)...has hit safely in 10 of his last 11 games and is batting .452 (19 for 42) over that span...has eight extra-base hits (six doubles, two home runs) over his last 13 games after recording three extra-base hits in his previous 17 games.
- Kevin Kouzmanoff (0 for 4) is 2 for 28 (.071) over his last nine games...is now batting .145 (8 for 55) in August after combining for a .303 batting average in June and July.
- Cliff Pennington (1 for 3) had his first career walk-off hit.
- Steve Tolleson (2 for 4) has back-to-back multiple-hit games for the first time in his career (.571, 4 for 7).

- The Toronto Blue Jays are 10-17 against left-handed starting pitchers compared to 53-40 against right-handers...are 5-50 when trailing after eight innings this season...are 3-3 on this nine-game road trip through Los Angeles (2-1), Oakland (1-2) and Boston (three games).
- Marc Rzepczynski matched his career high with five walks (Aug. 26, 2009 at TB)...is 0-1 with a 7.45 ERA (8 er in 9.2 ip) in three games during the day compared to 1-0 with a 2.77 ERA (4 er in 13.0 ip) in three games at night.
- Jason Frasor has not allowed a run in 14 of his last 15 appearances and has a 1.26 ERA (2 er in 14.1 ip) over that stretch.
- J.P. Arencibia (1 for 4) snapped his 0 for 15 streak with a RBI single in the ninth inning.
- · Aaron Hill (0 for 4) had his season-high seven-game hitting streak snapped and is now batting .267 (8 for 30) over his last eight games.
- Fred Lewis (2 for 4) matched his season high with three RBI.
