OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have won their past two games after losing four in a row...have a 31-20 record against teams that are below .500 when playing them and are 36-48 against opponents that are at or above .500...have won 14 of their last 18 day games and are 31-14 during the day for the season, which is the best record in the Major Leagues...are 2-0 on this nine-game homestand against Los Angeles (2-0), Seattle (three games) and Boston (three games).
- Trevor Cahill** had a career-high six walks (previous: 5; last: April 18, 2009 at TOR)...is 5-1 with a 2.20 ERA (12 er in 49.0 ip) in seven starts since August 1...is 6-1 with a 0.99 ERA (6 er in 54.2 ip) in eight starts against the American League West and is 9-5 with a 3.57 ERA in 17 starts against everyone else...is 4-1 with a 1.81 ERA (9 er in 44.2 ip) in seven career starts against Los Angeles.
- Daric Barton** (1 for 3) has reached base safely via a hit or walk in 19 of his last 20 games and is 21 for 62 (.339) over that span.
- Coco Crisp** (0 for 3) stole a base in the third inning and has now been successful in each of his last 15 stolen base attempts, which is the longest such streak by an Athletic since Rickey Henderson also had 15 consecutive steals from July 22 to August 19, 1998...is 6 for 41 (.146) over his last 10 games after batting .377 in his previous 17 games.
- Rajai Davis** (1 for 3) is batting .429 (15 for 35) in 10 games against Los Angeles this year and is a .320 (39 for 122) career hitter against the Angels.

LOS ANGELES NOTES

- The Los Angeles Angels are 3-9 over their last 12 games and are 5-13 over the last 18 games...are 18-27 since the All-Star Break and 21-35 since July 1...are 2-3 on this six-game road trip through Seattle (2-1) and Oakland (0-2).
- Jered Weaver** is 0-4 with a 3.97 ERA (15 er in 34.0 ip) over his last five starts...has allowed three runs or less in 22 of 29 starts this season...has pitched six or more innings in 19 of his last 20 starts...is 0-3 with a 5.40 ERA (15 er in 25.0 ip) against the A's this season...had a 31.1-inning streak without run support snapped when Hunter homered in the eighth inning.
- Bobby Abreu** (0 for 3) is batting 2 for 33 (.061) in his last 10 games.
- Alberto Callaspo** (2 for 4) has hit safely in 30 of 37 games since being acquired from Kansas City and is batting .317 (44 for 139) over that span...is a .355 (22 for 62) career hitter against the A's.
- Torii Hunter** (1 for 2) snapped his 20-game streak without a RBI when he hit a solo home run in the eighth inning, which was the second longest such streak of his career (22 games, April 30-July 29, 2000).
- Howie Kendrick** (2 for 3) has hit safely in 11 of 16 games and is batting .359 (23 for 64) over that span but is 3 for 18 (.167) on the road trip.
- Jeff Mathis** (0 for 3) is 5 for 54 (.093) over his last 16 games...is hitting .156 (21 for 135) since May 1 after batting .324 (11 for 34) in April.
