OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have lost five of their past seven games...are 2-58 when trailing after eight innings compared to 59-0 when leading after eight...are 17-48 when their opponents score first and 50-21 when scoring first...are 2-1 on this nine-game homestand against Los Angeles (2-1), Seattle (three games) and Boston (three games).
- Vin Mazzaro did not record a strikeout for the second time in 37 career appearances (also: July 4, 2009 at CLE)...has a six-game losing streak, which is the longest by an Athletic this year...has a 5.60 ERA (28 er in 45.0 ip) over that eight-start stretch...is 1-2 with a 5.92 ERA (16 er in 24.1 ip) in five career starts against the Angels.
- Daric Barton (1 for 4) has reached base safely via a hit or walk in 20 of his last 21 games and is 22 for 66 (.333) with 23 walks over that span.
- Rajai Davis (1 for 3) stole his 42nd base of the season, which is a new career high...now has 15 stolen bases against the Angels, his most against any team...is batting .421 (16 for 38) in 11 games against Los Angeles this year and is a .320 (40 for 125) career hitter against the team.
- Kevin Kouzmanoff (1 for 3) left the game in the fifth inning with lower back spasms.
- Jeff Larish (1 for 5) snapped his 0 for 12 streak with a two-run double in the fourth inning.

LOS ANGELES NOTES

- The Los Angeles Angels are 25-19 against the American League West and 41-52 against everyone else...went 3-3 on this six-game road trip through Seattle (2-1) and Oakland (1-2)...begin a six-game homestand against Cleveland (three games) and Seattle (three games) tomorrow.
- Ervin Santana is 7-2 over his last nine starts but has a 4.89 ERA (31 er in 57.0 ip) over that span...won his 74th game as an Angel, which ties Dean Chance for 10th place on the all-time list...won his 15th game of the season and has now won 15 or more games three times in his career...has pitched six innings or more in 12 of his last 14 starts and in 34 of 41 starts dating back to last year...is 12-3 with a 1.80 ERA (25 er in 125.1 ip) in 20 career appearances, 19 starts, against Oakland.
- Bobby Abreu (2 for 4) is hitting .328 (19 for 58) against Oakland this season.
- Hideki Matsui (3 for 5) is batting .400 (22 for 55) since August 14.
