OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have won 15 of their last 20 day games and are 32-15 during the day for the season, which is the best record in the Major Leagues...are 60-0 when leading after eight innings...have won eight of their last nine games against the Mariners in Oakland...played on Labor Day for the first time since 2007 (loss at LAA, 9-5) and snapped their four-game losing streak on the holiday (last win: 2002, 7-6 over KC)...are 3-1 on this nine-game homestand against Los Angeles (2-1), Seattle (1-0) and Boston (three games).
- Brett Anderson snapped his career-high-tying four-game losing streak and now has a 2.78 ERA (11 er in 35.2 ip) over his last six starts...did not walk a batter for the fifth time this season and has walked two batters or fewer in all 14 of his starts...is 2-1 with a 0.68 ERA (2 er in 26.2 ip) in four starts against Seattle this year and is 4-3 with a 2.10 ERA (13 er in 55.2 ip) in nine career starts against the Mariners.
- Daric Barton (2 for 4) has reached base safely via a hit or walk in 21 of his last 22 games and is 24 for 70 (.343) with 23 walks over that span...is 14 for 41 (.341) in 12 games against Seattle this year and is a career .338 (45 for 133) hitter against the Mariners, his best mark against any team.
- Matt Carson (1 for 4) snapped his 0 for 15 streak with a fourth-inning home run... is 3 for 28 (.107) in Oakland and 6 for 24 (.250) on the road.
- Coco Crisp (2 for 4) hit his third career leadoff home run (last: Aug. 18, 2003 vs. TB)...it was the first by an Athletic this season (last: Kennedy, July 29, 2009 at BOS).
- Mark Ellis (1 for 4) is on a season-high seven-game hitting streak (.423, 11 for 26) but is hitting .233 (34 for 146) over his last 43 games...is 12 for 30 (.400) in eight games against Seattle this year.

SEATTLE NOTES

- The Seattle Mariners are 5-11 over their last 16 games and are 19-31 since the All-Star Break...are 21-46 on the road this season and 33-38 at home...have scored three runs or less in 11 consecutive games, the second-longest such streak in franchise history (12 games, June 10-22, 1988)...have lost six of their last nine day games and are 14-28 during the day this season...are on a six-game losing streak in Oakland, which is their longest since losing 10 in a row from September 7, 2006 to August 16, 2006...are 14-17 all-time on Labor Day...are 0-1 on this six-game road trip through Oakland (0-1) and Los Angeles (three games).
- Jason Vargas is on a four-game losing streak and has a 7.23 ERA (19 er in 23.2 ip) over that span...is 2-5 with a 5.27 ERA (42 er in 71.2 ip) in 12 road starts and is 7-4 with a 2.58 ERA (28 er in 97.2 ip) in 15 starts at home...is 1-1 with a 6.10 ERA (7 er in 10.1 ip) in two starts against the A's this season.
- Franklin Gutierrez (2 for 4) has recorded a RBI in a career-high four consecutive games...is batting .341 (15 for 44) against the A's this season.
- Casey Kotchman (0 for 4) had his season-high six-game hitting streak snapped and is now batting .269 (7 for 26) over his past seven games.
- Ichiro Suzuki (1 for 4) is on an eight-game hitting streak and is batting .400 (14 for 35) during that stretch...is batting .235 (12 for 51) against Oakland this season but is a career .327 (244 for 747) hitter against the A's.
