LEFTY ALERT

Seattle is scheduled to face a left-handed starter in 3 straight games starting today...faced only one LH starter in last 22 games (Sabathia, 8/22 @NYY).

1 FOR THE MONEY

Friday night was the Mariners 3rd 1-0 win of '10 (also: June 18 & 20 vs. CIN) and the 40th 1-0 win in club history...Seattle is 40-43 all-time in 1-0 decisions.

GUTI = RBI

Franklin Gutierrez has missed the last 2 games with an upset stomach, but has still recorded an RBI in 3 straight games, tying a career-high.

THE COUNTDOWN BEGINS

Ichiro currently has 178 hits, and is 22 short of his 10th consecutive 200-hit season...would break the AL record for 200-hit seasons in a career (currently tied with Ty Cobb) and tie the ML record held by Pete Rose.

YOUNGEST TO 1,000 STRIKEOUTS

Felix Hernandez turned 24 years, 139 days old Aug. 25, and struck out 9 Red Sox to give him 1,002 strikeouts in 166 games (now 1,019)...he became the 4th youngest player in MLB history to reach 1,000 strikeouts.

40 / 40 TEAMMATES

Chone Figgins (35) & Ichiro (36) have a shot to be the 2nd pair of Mariners to each have 40 steals in a season...they would join Harold Reynolds (60) and Phil Bradley (40) who did so in 1987...since 1994, the 2009 Tampa Bay Rays (Crawford & Upton) are the only team to boast 2 players with 40+ steals.

DAREN BROWN

Daren Brown took over as interim manager on Aug. 9...Seattle is 12-13 overall with Brown at the helm.

LEAGUE LOCKDOWN

Brandon League is 4-0 with 2 saves and a 0.70 ERA (2 ER, 25.2 IP) since July 11...has allowed only 1 ER over his last 20.0 innings (0.45 ERA)...T7th in the AL with 61 appearances and T1st in the Majors with 9 relief wins.

TODAY'S TILT...the Mariners open the penultimate road trip of the 2010 season with a 2-team, 6-game trip today with the first of three games against the Oakland A's...following an off day on Thursday in Southern California, will play three games vs. the Angels...went 4-6 on just concluded 10-game homestand against the Twins (1-2), Angels (1-2) and Indians (2-2)...today's game will be broadcast on 710 ESPN Seattle and the Mariners Radio Network and televised by FSN Northwest in HD.

ODDS AND ENDS...won yesterday to improve to 2-3 in September...won 4 of last 8 games and are 10-12 in last 22 games...lost 38 of last 60 games; 19-30 post ASG...were 13-14 in August, 6-22 in July; 14-13 in June...held a lead in 92 of 137 games (40 blown leads in losses)...trailed at some point in 28 of 54 wins...33-38 at home; 21-45 on the road.

- Have lost 21 games in the opponents final at-bat (last: 8/16 at BAL), including 10 walk-off losses.
- Mariners have won 5 of last 9 series openers after dropping their previous 8.
- Seattle leads the Majors with an average time of game of 2:39:23 in regulation 9-inning games.
- Ichiro leads MLB w/ 48 infield hits...505 career inf. hits, 2nd among active players, trails L. Castillo (530).
- Ichiro is 1st in MLB w/57 multi-hit games (Prado, 53) & 2nd in MLB in hits (178; Josh Hamilton, 183).
- Mariners batted around 5 times (last: 7/22 vs. BOS)...sent 9 men to plate 7 times (last: 8/17 at BAL).
- 70 of 137 G decided by 1 or 2 runs...19-23 in 1-run, 13-15 in 2-run.
- Seattle is 35-17 when scoring 4 or more runs, compared to 19-66 when scoring 3 runs or less.
- Felix Hernandez has a current streak of 16.1 consecutive scoreless innings.
- Have scored 2 runs or less in 61 (10-51) of 137 games; 1 or less in 35 games (3-32) incl. 12 shutouts.
- The Mariners have used 112 different batting lineups and 89 different defensive alignments this year.
- Seattle is 14-27 in day games (lost 5 of last 8) and 40-56 in night games.
- Russell Bryan has hit 17 of his 23 home runs this season on the road...5 of 23 HR vs. LHP.
- **Current Hitting Streaks** -- Ichiro 7 G (.419/13x31), Kotchman 6 G (.318/7x22).

SEATTLE VS. ATHLETICS...today is the 13th (5-7) of 19 games between the Mariners and A's in 2010...Seattle is 1-5 in Oakland, and 4-2 at Safeco Field...the Mariners were 14-5 vs. the A's last season (6-4 on the road, 8-1 at home); Seattle is 42-27 vs. the A's since 2007...Mariners trail the all-time series 206-277, including going 87-156 in Oakland.

STOP THE STREAK...the Mariners have dropped 5 of 6 games in Oakland this season...current 5-game losing streak following a 5-3 win on Opening Day...5-game losing streak here is the longest since a 10-gamer Sept. 7, 2005-Aug. 16, 2006.

WORKING ON A HOLIDAY...the Mariners are 14-16 all-time on Labor Day...enjoyed the holiday last year with an off day, but has won 5 of last 7 Labor Day games...played at Oakland on Labor Day in 2005 (2-0 win for only shutout on Labor Day in club history).

BRANYAN'S BLASTS...Russell Bryan has homered in consecutive games for the 5th time this season (3rd with Seattle)...homered in 3 of his last 4 games, and has hit 7 of the Mariners last 10 home runs...for the season has hit 23 homers (15th in the AL), including 13 in 48 games with the Mariners (10 w/CLE).

START IT UP...Mariners starters rank 2nd in the AL with a 3.70 ERA (356 ER, 865.0 IP)...trail only Oakland (3.45) and are ahead of 3rd-place Tampa Bay (3.87)...also leads the league with 10 complete games and T4th with 2 CG shutouts...Mariners led the AL in 2009 with a 3.89 starters ERA (also led with overall 3.87 mark), and have a current 2-year run where the starters have posted the best AL mark at 3.80 (299 G, 772 ER, 1827.1 IP, 1258 K, 566 BB)...Felix Hernandez is 30-15, 2.40 (122 ER, 458.0 IP) over the last 2 seasons.

THIS WOULD BE GREAT IF WE WERE GOLFING...the Mariners have scored 3 or less runs in 10 consecutive games (4-6)...scored 4 runs in game #2 Aug. 25 at Boston, the only time in their past 13 games to reach 4 runs...have not scored 5 or more runs in a game since Aug. 21 at NYY...**current 10-game streak of scoring 3 or fewer runs is the 2nd-longest in club history**...trails only a 12-gamer in 1988 (June 10-22)...has scored 3 or fewer runs in 15 consecutive home games, the longest streak of its kind by a Major League team since the 1954 Orioles.

DOMINATION...following his 8.0 shutout innings yesterday, Felix Hernandez has allowed just 1 ER in his last 6 starts for a 0.20 ERA (1 ER, 45.0 IP)...has a current string of 16.1 consecutive scoreless innings, the longest streak by a Mariners hurler this season...posted a 0.82 ERA in August, the 2nd-lowest by a Mariners pitcher in ANY month (M. Langston, 0.50, September 1988)...**among AL starters, ranks 2nd in ERA (2.30), 1st in starts (30), 1st in quality starts (27), 1st in innings (219.1) and 1st in strikeouts (209).**

YOU KNOW HE WILL GET YOU TO THE 7TH...Felix Hernandez has pitched into the 7th inning in 21 consecutive starts...it is the longest single-season streak in club history and tied for the overall club record set by Randy Johnson in 1992 (last 11 GS) and 1993 (first 10 GS)...Felix is 9-7, 1.72 (31 ER, 162.1 IP) during the 21-start stretch (since May 23).

IT DOES SEEM LIKE THE HITS COME IN BUNCHES...Ichiro recorded career hit #2,200 Wednesday vs. the Angels (current hit total is 2,208), reaching the 2,200-hit mark faster than any player over the last 65 years...Ichiro recorded hit #2,220 in career game 1,559...the previous quickest players to reach 2,200 hits (since 1945): Stan Musial (1,669 G), Tony Gwynn (1,693), Kirby Puckett (1,705 G), Wade Boggs (1,710).

ON THE FARM...the Tacoma Rainiers and Clinton LumberKings both clinched playoff spots yesterday...that means 8 of the Mariners 9 minor league affiliates, including the Dominican and Venezuelan Mariners, advance to the post-season this year...see full minor league report by visiting the Mariners virtual press box at <http://multimedia.mariners.com/>.

YOU ALREADY KNOW THAT...Russell Bryan has hit 13 home runs in his 43 games with the Mariners this season...**BUT DID YOU KNOW?**...that he ranks 2nd in club history hitting a home run once every 13.66 at-bats (min. 700 PA)?...Bryan has hit 44 home runs in 164 games with the Mariners over the last two seasons, and trails only Ken Phelps (13.32) for highest AB/HR ratio in club history...Ken Griffey Jr. is 3rd on the list with a homer every 15.15 at-bats (as a Mariner only).

ABOUT VARGAS...pronounced VAR-gus.

- 27-year-old lefty making 27th start of season, 81st career MLB appearance (61st start) today vs. the A's.
- Acquired from Mets in 3-team, 12-player trade 12/10/08.
- Selected by Marlins in 2nd round, 68th overall in '04 draft.
- Made Major League debut w/1.0 shutout inning of relief July 14, 2005 at PHI (with FLA)...first ML start July 18, 2005 at Arizona (5.0,4,3,2,4,3).
- Traded by the Marlins to the Mets in exchange for Henry Owens (rhp) and Matt Lindstrom (rhp) on Nov. 20, 2006.
- Did not pitch during the 2008 season, spending the year recovering from surgery to repair the labrum in his left hip...had surgery on March 17, 2008 and spent the summer rehabbing at the Mets minor league facility in Port St. Lucie, FL.
- Played college baseball at LSU (2002), Cypress Junior College (2003) and Long Beach State (2004)...as a junior at LBSU, went 7-4, 4.14 on the mound and hit .354 with 14 doubles and 5 home runs as the DH.
- Is 0-4, 3.92 ERA (19 ER, 43.2 IP) in 12 G/6 GS in career in September.
- Is 8-12, 4.87 ERA (88 ER, 162.2 IP) in 37 G/25 GS in Post All-Star games.

LAST TIME OUT...suffered L#8, his 3rd straight, in last start Sept. 1 vs. LAA...took a 2-1 lead into the 7th, but allowed a 2-out, 2-run HR to H. Matsui...was his 19th quality start this season.

UNCHARTED TERRITORY...has set career-highs in wins (9, old was 5 in '05), innings (165.0, old was 91.2 in '09), games (26, old was 23 in '09), starts (26, old was 14 in '09) and strikeouts (103, old was 59 in '05).

SUPER QUALITY...has recorded 8 starts of at least 6.0 innings while allowing 1 or fewer earned runs...T10th among AL starters with 7 starts of at least 7.0 IP and 1 ER or fewer.

STREAK SNAPPED AT 3...had his career-high string of three consecutive winning starts snapped in his outing Aug. 21 at NYY...had never won more than 2 straight starts...went 3-0, 2.84 (6 ER, 19.0 IP) during the 3-start stretch.

THAT'S QUALITY...has recorded 19 quality starts this season to rank T5th in the American League and 2nd on the team (behind Felix Hernandez -27)...12 QS in last 17 starts, going 6-5 with a 3.77 ERA (45 ER, 107.1 IP)...tossed 7 consecutive quality starts April 14-May 20, T6th longest in the AL this season...has pitched at least 6.0 innings (not consecutive) in 21 of 26 starts (10 GS of at least 7.0 IP).

HOME SUCCESS...has proven to be a more effective pitcher in his home ballpark, compared to the road...is 7-4, 2.58 ERA (28 ER, 97.2 IP) in 15 starts at Safeco Field, compared to 2-4, 4.95 (37 ER, 67.1 IP) in 11 starts the road...was 2-1, 2.77 (12 ER, 39.0 IP) in 10 G/6 GS at Safeco Field last season, compared to 1-5, 6.49 (38 ER, 52.2 IP) in 13 G/8 GS on the road...in his career, is 13-8, 3.08 at home (39 G/30 GS) and 5-14, 6.18 (41 G/30 GS) on the road.

SAFECO ERA LEADER...has 2.63 ERA (40 ER, 136.2 IP) in 25 games, 21 starts at Safeco Field...that is the lowest ERA at Safeco Field history (min. 100.0 IP)...ahead of Kazuhiro Sasaki (2.66), Shigetoshi Hasegawa (2.68), and J.J. Putz (2.68)...**Felix Hernandez** is 11th (3.18).

HOTTER THAN ANY DAY IN SEATTLE THIS YEAR...after allowing 5 runs in 5.1 innings during his first outing of the season, Vargas has allowed only 60 earned runs over his last 25 starts...during this stretch he is 9-7 with a 3.38 ERA (60 ER, 159.2 IP)...currently ranks 17th in the AL with a 3.55 ERA.

STAYING IN THE GAME...in his start on Aug. 8 vs. Kansas City, held the Royals to 1 run in 6.0 innings...it was the 8th time this season he has limited opponents to 1 ER or less in a start...has allowed 3 ER or less in 21 of his 26 starts this season.

THANKS FOR YOUR SUPPORT...has received just 3.65 runs per game in his 26 starts this season (67 RS, 165.0 IP)...the Mariners have scored 2 runs or less while he is in the games in 16 of 26 starts.

QUITE A YEAR...Vargas has already pitched more Major League innings this season than he pitched in the big leagues in the past 4 years, **combined**...Jason enters today's game having tossed 165.0 innings in 26 games, all starts...from 2006-2009, he pitched 145.0 innings in 37 games, 21 starts.

2010 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS...

- Limited opponents to a .243 average (153x629), including a .198 (32x162) clip vs. left-handers.
- Limited opponents to a .206 (45x218) average with 12 2B, 1 3B, 5 HR, 13 BB, 46 K going through first time through the lineup.
- Has already surpassed his innings total from 2009...threw 107.2 innings in 23 G/14 GS for the Mariners last season.
- Career-high 4-game winning streak May 9-June 22, 2010...his previous high was 3 games, July 27-Aug. 10, 2005 with the Marlins.
