OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have lost six of their past nine games...are 28-43 against Seattle since 2007, which is the lowest winning percentage by any American League team over that span...are 3-2 on this nine-game homestand against Los Angeles (2-1), Seattle (1-1) and Boston (three games).
- Dallas Braden allowed a season-high-tying six runs (also: April 28 at TB)...has received run support of two runs or fewer in 15 of 25 starts this year and has walked two batters or fewer 24 times...is 4-8 with a 3.81 ERA (43 er in 101.2 ip) in 16 starts at night and 5-3 with a 2.88 ERA (19 er in 59.1 ip) in nine starts during the day...is 2-2 with a 4.93 ERA (21 er in 38.1 ip) in seven career appearances, six starts, against Seattle.
- Daric Barton (0 for 3, 2 bb) has reached base safely via a hit or walk in 22 of his last 23 games and is 24 for 72 (.333) with 25 walks over that span.
- Mark Ellis (2 for 5) is on a season-high eight-game hitting streak (.419, 13 for 31) but is hitting .238 (36 for 151) over his last 44 games...is 14 for 35 (.400) in nine games against Seattle this year.
- Jeremy Hermida (1 for 4) snapped his 0 for 20 streak with a ninth-inning single...it was the longest hitless streak of his career.
- Cliff Pennington (1 for 4) has committed an error in back-to-back games and now has 16 errors over his last 76 games after making five over his first 56 games...has now committed 21 errors this season, which is the most among American League shortstops and the most by an A's shortstop since Miguel Tejada also had 21 in 2003.
- Steve Tolleson (3 for 4) had a career-high three hits.

SEATTLE NOTES

- The Seattle Mariners have won three of their past five games after going 3-9 in their previous 12 games...had seven hits in the second inning, the most they have had in a single inning this season (previous: 6, four times; last: July 25 vs. BOS)...went 6 for 8 with runners in scoring position in the inning...had not had six hits with runners in scoring position in a game since going a season-high 8 for 14 against San Diego May 21...snapped their 11-game streak of scoring three runs or less, which was the second longest such streak in franchise history (12 games, June 10-22, 1988)...snapped their six-game losing streak in Oakland, which was their longest since losing 10 in a row from September 7, 2005 to August 16, 2006...are 1-1 on this six-game road trip through Oakland (1-1) and Los Angeles (three games).
- Doug Fister allowed a season-high four walks...has allowed three runs or less in 18 of his 24 starts this year...is 4-1 with a 1.80 ERA (7 er in 35.0 ip) in six career starts against Oakland.
- Ichiro Suzuki (2 for 5) now has 2,211 career hits, which ties him with Willie McCovey for 169th place on the all-time list...is on a nine-game hitting streak and is batting .400 (16 for 40) with seven multiple-hit games during that stretch...has hit safely in 18 of his last 19 games in Oakland (.397, 31 for 78)...is a career .363 (137 for 377) hitter in Oakland, which is the highest batting average by any player at the Coliseum.
- Matt Tuiasosopo (2 for 3) snapped his 0 for 10 streak with a second-inning single.
