TONIGHT'S TILT...the Mariners continue the penultimate road trip of the 2010 season with a 2-team, 6-game trip tonight with the 2nd of three games against the Oakland A's (0-1)...following an off day on Thursday in Southern California, will play three games vs. the Angels...went 4-6 on recently concluded 10-game homestand against the Twins (1-2), Angels (1-2) and Indians (2-2)...tonight's game will be broadcast on 710 ESPN Seattle and the Mariners Radio Network and televised by FSN Northwest in HD.
