Among AL catcher's with at least 40 starts, **Adam Moore** ranks 2nd with a 3.26 catcher's ERA...Kurt Suzuki (OAK) leads the AL with a 3.22 CERA.

**THE COUNTDOWN BEGINS**

**Ichiro** currently has 181 hits, and is 19 short of his 10th consecutive 200-hit season...would break the AL record for 200-hit seasons in a career (currently tied with Ty Cobb) and tie the ML record held by Pete Rose.

**YOUNGEST TO 1,000 STRIKEOUTS**

**Felix Hernandez** turned 24 years, 139 days old Aug. 25, and struck out 9 Red Sox to give him 1,002 strikeouts in 166 games (now 1,019)...he became the 4th youngest player in MLB history to reach 1,000 strikeouts.

**40 / 40 TEAMMATES**

**Chone Figgins** (35) & **Ichiro** (36) have a shot to be the 2nd pair of Mariners to each have 40 steals in a season...they would join **Harold Reynolds** (60) and **Phil Bradley** (40) who did so in 1987...since 1994, the 2009 Tampa Bay Rays (Crawford & Upton) are the only team to boast 2 players with 40+ steals.

**DAREN BROWN**

**Daren Brown** took over as interim manager on Aug. 9...Seattle is 13-14 overall with Brown at the helm.

**TONIGHT'S TILT**...the Mariners continue the penultimate road trip of the 2010 season with a 2-team, 6-game trip tonight with the final game of a 3-game set against the Oakland A's (1-1)...following an off day on tomorrow in Southern California, will play 3 games vs. the Angels...went 4-6 on recently concluded 10-game homestand against the Twins (1-2), Angels (1-2) and Indians (2-2)...tonight's game will be broadcast on 710 ESPN Seattle and the Mariners Radio Network and televised by FSN Northwest in HD.

**ODDS AND ENDS**...won last night to improve to 3-4 in September...won 5 of last 10 games and are 11-13 in last 24 games...7-7 in last 14 road games...lost 39 of last 62 games; 20-31 post ASG...held a lead in 93 of 139 games (40 blown leads in L)...trailed at some point in 28 of 54 wins...33-38 at home; 22-46 on the road.

- Have lost 21 games in the opponents final at-bat (last: 8/16 at BAL), including 10 walk-off losses.
- Seattle leads the Majors with an average time of game of 2:39:23 in regulation 9-inning games.
- **Ichiro** leads MLB w/ 49 infield hits...506 career inf. hits, 2nd among active players, trails L. Castillo (530).
- **Ichiro** is 1st in MLB w/58 multi-hit games (Prado, 53) & 2nd in MLB in hits (181; Josh Hamilton, 183).
- Mariners batted around 6 times (last: 9/7 at OAK)...sent 9 men to plate 7 times (last: 8/17 at BAL).
- 71 of 139 G decided by 1 or 2 runs...19-23 in 1-run, 14-15 in 2-run.
- Seattle is 36-17 when scoring 4 or more runs, compared to 19-67 when scoring 3 runs or less.
- **Felix Hernandez** has a current streak of 16.1 consecutive scoreless innings.
- Have scored 2 runs or less in 62 (10-52) of 139 games; 1 or less in 35 games (3-32) incl. 12 shutouts.
- The Mariners have used 113 different batting lineups and 89 different defensive alignments this year.
- Seattle is 14-28 in day games (lost 6 of last 9) and 41-56 in night games.
- **Russell Branyan** has hit 17 of his 23 home runs this season on the road...5 of 23 HR vs. LHP.
- Seattle has recorded 6 sac flies over its last 9 games...had 6 SF in previous 28 G (7/29-8/29).
- **Ryan Rowland-Smith** has been selected as one of 30 finalists for the 2010 Roberto Clemente Award.
- **Current Hitting Streaks** -- **Ichiro** 9 G (.400/16x40).

**SEATTLE VS. ATHLETICS**...tonight is the 15th (6-8) of 19 games between the Mariners and A's in 2010...Seattle is 2-6 in Oakland, and 4-2 at Safeco Field...finish out the 2010 season with a 4-game series in Seattle, Sept. 30-Oct. 3...Seattle is 43-28 vs. the A's since 2007, including winning 2 of last 3 season series...Mariners trail the all-time series 207-278, including going 88-157 in Oakland.

**STREAK SNAPPED**...the Mariners snapped a 6-game losing streak in Oakland last night...won on Opening Day (4/5) and then dropped the next 6 games...6-game losing streak at Oakland Coliseum was the longest since a 10-gamer Sept. 7, 2005-Aug. 16, 2006.

**(HIT) KING OF THE COLISEUM**...**Ichiro** has recorded at least one hit in 77 of 90 career games at Oakland-Alameda County Stadium (86%)...has a hit in 18 of his last 19 games here (since 7/9/08), batting .397 (31x78) during the stretch...overall, is a career .363 (137x377) hitter at OACS, the highest batting average by any player at this venue (min. 200 PA)...Derek Jeter is next closest at .347 (90x63).

**BIG INNING**...the Mariners scored 5 runs and recorded 7 hits (all singles) in the top of the 2nd inning last night...set a season-high for hits in an inning (previous was 6), the most since also recording 7 on Sept. 26, 2008 vs. Oakland (3rd inning)...first time since Aug. 1, 2008 to record scored more than 5 runs in a frame for the 7th time this season (last: 8/14 at CLE).

**RISP EXPLOSION**...Mariners went 6-for-11 with 6 RBI with runners in scoring position last night...was batting .139 w/RISP (5x36) in 6 September games prior to last night...6 hits w/RISP were T2nd-most this season, and most since a season-high 8 on May 21 vs. San Diego.

**BREAKING OUT THE STICKS**...recorded 13 hits last night, only the 6th time this season with at least 13 hits in a game...most hits since also recording 13 Aug. 14 at Cleveland.

**HOMER HAPPY**...after going 7 consecutive games without a home run Aug. 25-Sept. 1 (T2nd-longest homerless streak in club history), the Mariners have homered in 5 of their last 6 games...homered in last 4 games, one off season-high 5-game HR streak (Aug. 16-21).

**KEEPING THE RECORD IN THE BOOKS**...the Mariners scored 7 runs last night, snapping a string of 11 consecutive games scoring 3 or less runs...the 11-game streak was 2nd-longest in club history, falling one-game short of the record set in 1988... has scored 3 or fewer runs in 15 consecutive home games, the longest streak of its kind by a Major League team since the 1954 Orioles.

**AS JOSH GOES. M'S GO**...Josh Wilson has started a career-high 82 games this season, including 75 at shortstop...Seattle has gone 36-46 when Wilson starts in the field (SS-75, 3B-3, 1B-3, 2B-1)...in the 36 wins, Wilson is batting .328 (41x125) with 7 2B, 1 3B, 1 HR, 12 RBI...in the 46 losses, .194 (31x160).

**DOMINATION**...following his 8.0 shutout innings Sunday, **Felix Hernandez** has allowed just 1 ER in his last 6 starts for a 0.20 ERA (1 ER, 45.0 IP)...has a current string of 16.1 consecutive scoreless innings, the longest streak by a Mariners hurler this season...posted a 0.82 ERA in August, the 2nd-lowest by a Mariners pitcher in ANY month (M. Langston, 0.50, September 1988)...among AL starters, ranks 2nd in ERA (2.30), 1st in starts (30), 1st in quality starts (27), 1st in innings (219.1) and 1st in strikeouts (209).

**ON THE FARM**...the **Everett AquaSox** beat the Vancouver Canadians last night to clinch the Northwest League Western Division pennant...Everett advances to the Northwest League Championship Series to face the Spokane Indians...the Frogs will compete for their first championship since 1985...see full minor league report by visiting the Mariners virtual press box at <http://multimedia.mariners.com/>.

**YOU ALREADY KNOW**...that **David Aardsma** recorded his 29th save of the season last night...**BUT DID YOU KNOW?**...that he is on the verge of becoming just the 4th pitcher in Mariners history to record consecutive 30-save seasons?...Aardsma tallied 38 saves in 2009, and with one more save, will join Kazuhiro Sasaki (2000-02), J.J. Putz (2006-07) and Mike Schooler (1989-90) as the only Seattle hurlers with consecutive 30-save seasons...Aardsma has saved 29 of the Mariners 55 wins, including the last 5 W's.

- 24-year-old left-hander makes his 9th 2010 start (12th appearance) & 21st career start (27th appearance).
- Made first two '10 appearances w/Mariners in relief.
- Is 7-7, 4.64 (45 ER, 87.1 IP) in 15 career starts with SEA.
- Traded to Seattle with minor league LHP Mauricio Robles on July 31, 2009 in exchange for LHP Jarrod Washburn.
- Made Major League debut in 9th inning May 15, 2009 in a relief appearance vs. the Oakland A's (1.0,0,0,0,0,1).
- Spent entire career prior to trade in Tigers organization... originally selected by Detroit in 8th rd. of 2004 June Draft.
- Born in Salina, KS and currently resides in Littleton, CO ...attended Heritage High School...signed an NLI to play college baseball at UNLV.
- Participated in the inaugural AFLAC All-American High School Baseball Classic in 2003 (as 1B).
- Making 4th career appearance, 3rd start in September (1-1, 5.25ERA).

**LAST START...**W#4, his 2nd straight, with 7.0 shutout, 1-hit innings in a 1-0 win vs. CLE.....did not allow a hit until 1-out in 7th...faced just 23 men in 7.0 innings, 2 over the minimum...his 4th start of at least 7.0 innings while allowing 1 earned run or less.

**AND THE ONE BEFORE THAT...**W#3 Aug. 29 vs. MIN...allowed only a 7th inning solo home run (M. Cuddyer)...retired the first nine batters he faced and faced the minimum over the first four innings...also retired nine of the final 10 he faced.

**CENTRAL SUCCESS...**is 6-1, 3.25 ERA (20 ER, 55.1 IP) in 9 games (all starts) against the AL Central...vs. CLE: 2-0, 2.08 ERA (3 ER, 13.0 IP) in 2 starts; vs. CWS: 0-0, 6.75 ERA (4 ER, 5.1 IP) in 1 start; 3-0, 2.79 ERA (6 ER, 19.1 IP) in 3 starts; 1-1, 3.57 ERA (7 ER, 17.2 IP) in 3 starts.

**CAREER NIGHT...**turned in what at the time was the best start of his career Aug. 6 vs. Kansas City...earned W#1 of '10 allowing 1 run in a career-high 8.0 innings (101 pitches/65 strikes)...scattered 9 hits (8 singles, 1 double) and did not walk a batter (struck out 4)...only run allowed came in the 3rd inning...finished his start with 5.0 scoreless innings, retiring 11 of the last 12 batters he faced.

**SAFECO SAFETY...**is 3-1, 2.01 ERA (7 ER, 31.1 IP) in 6 games including 4 starts in Seattle this season...in 4 GS is 3-1, 1.93 ERA (6 ER, 28.0 IP).

**WITH SEATTLE...**combined to go 4-4 with a 3.64 ERA (24 ER, 59.1 IP) in 11 games (8 GS) with the Mariners...in 8 starts is 4-4, 3.38 (19 ER, 50.2 IP) and in 3 relief appearances is 0-0, 5.19 (5 ER, 8.2 IP).

**PCL ALL-STAR...**named to the Pacific Coast League All-Star team but was unable to participate after being called up by Seattle on July 9th... during first half was 10-2, 2.69 ERA (30 ER, 100.1 IP) in 15 starts, striking out 54 with 1 complete game.

**THIRD TIME IS A...**is in his 3rd stint with the Mariners this season...recalled June 6 (Fister DL), optioned June 18 (Mike Sweeney activated)... recalled July 9 (Cliff Lee traded)...optioned July 10 (Justin Smoak reported)...recalled July 28 (Rowland-Smith DL).

**IN THE MINORS...**started season with AAA Tacoma Rainiers (PCL)...was 11-3, 2.94 (37 ER, 113.1 IP) in 17 GS w/Rainiers...at time of recall, ranked 2nd in PCL in ERA, T1st in wins and 2nd in WHIP...tossed 6.0+ innings in 14 off 17 starts, including 8.0+ innings in 3 GS...played under current interim manager Daren Brown with the Rainiers.

**MARINERS DEBUT...**earned the win in his Mariners debut Aug. 5, 2009 at Kansas City...allowed 9 hits and 4 runs in 5.0 IP in Mariners 11-6 win over KC...struck out 2, walked one and allowed 2 home runs.
