

# BOSTON RED SOX GAME NOTES

BOSTON RED SOX (78-63) at OAKLAND ATHLETICS (70-70)

**ON THE ROAD AGAIN:** The Red Sox continue a 6-day, 6-game road trip with the 2<sup>nd</sup> of 3 games in Oakland..Boston will also visit Seattle (9/13-15) on their penultimate road trip..The club has an off-day next Thursday (9/16) before beginning a 6-day, 6-game homestand against the Blue Jays (9/17-19) and Orioles (9/20-22)..Of Boston's remaining 21 regular season games, 12 are on the road and 9 will be at Fenway Park.

The club has dropped 7 of their last 11 road games overall but has won 11 of their last 20 and 13 of their last 24 tilts away from home..They are 28-23 (.549) on the road since 5/22, the 3<sup>rd</sup>-best road mark in the American League in that time after the White Sox (32-24, .571) and Yankees (25-19, .568).

Overall, the club's 36-33 (.522) road mark is 6<sup>th</sup> in the Majors and 3<sup>rd</sup> in the AL after the Rays (42-29, .592) and Yankees (38-29, .567).

**RECORD KEEPER:** At 78-63 (.553), the Sox are T-9<sup>th</sup> in the Majors, and tied with CWS and TEX (both 78-63) for 4<sup>th</sup> in the AL after NYY (87-54, .617), TB (85-55, .607) and MIN (83-58, .589)..The club has lost 8 of its last 12 tilts but is 23-19 since 7/26.

Boston is 3<sup>rd</sup> in the AL East, 9.0 games behind the 1<sup>st</sup>-place Yankees..The Sox are tied with the White Sox for 2<sup>nd</sup> in the AL Wild Card race, 7.5 games behind the Rays.

**KING OF THE HILL:** Last night's starter Clay Buchholz yielded 5 runs in 1.0+ inning of work, the shortest non-injury-related start of his career..Despite the setback, Buchholz ranks 2<sup>nd</sup> in the American League with a 2.53 ERA (43 ER/152.2 IP), trailing only Seattle's Felix Hernandez (2.30) for tops in the circuit.

**SWEET RELIEF:** The Red Sox bullpen combined for 7.0 scoreless innings last night..It matches the club's longest single-game scoreless relief effort since 2004, also accomplished 5/30/08 at Baltimore (6 relievers) and 7/15/10 vs. TEX (4 relievers).

**LENDING ASSISTANCE:** Ryan Kalish picked up his 3<sup>rd</sup> career outfield assist last night in his 34<sup>th</sup> career Major League game, throwing out Coco Crisp at 3<sup>rd</sup> base in the 4<sup>th</sup> inning..Since 1995, he is just the 2<sup>nd</sup> Red Sox player to record 3 outfield assists that quickly, joining Brandon Moss, who tallied 3 in his 1<sup>st</sup> 21 ML games from 2007-08.

**OLD TRICKS:** With a win over the Rays at 44 years, 37 days old on Wednesday night, Tim Wakefield became the oldest Red Sox pitcher to earn a victory..He passed Dennis Eckersley, who was 43 years, 349 days old in his last Sox win, 9/17/98 at BAL.

**MARCO THE LEADER:** Marco Scutaro went 4-for-5 with a double, 2 home runs, 3 RBI and 3 runs as Boston's lead-off hitter in Wednesday's win over TB, matching career highs in homers (2<sup>nd</sup> time, also 7/22/09 vs. CLE with TOR) and hits (7<sup>th</sup> time, last 8/9/09 vs. BAL with TOR)..According to Elias, he became the 4<sup>th</sup> player in Red Sox history to record at least 4 hits and 2 home runs in the same game from the 1<sup>st</sup> slot in the batting order, joining Wade Boggs (8/6/84 vs. DET-GM 2), Darren Bragg (8/8/98 at TEX) and Johnny Damon (7/9/04 vs. TEX).

Scutaro leads the AL with 12 games of at least 3 hits as a shortstop and is tied for 1<sup>st</sup> in the AL with 43 multi-hit games at the position (also NYY's Derek Jeter).

**CROSSING 1,000:** With his 2-run homer in the 2<sup>nd</sup> inning on Wednesday, Adrian Beltre collected his 1,000<sup>th</sup> and 1,001<sup>st</sup> career RBI..He became the 27<sup>th</sup> Major League third baseman (played at least 50% of career games at 3<sup>rd</sup> base) to reach the milestone since the stat was tracked in 1920 and is 1 of 4 active 3<sup>rd</sup> basemen, joining Chipper Jones, Scott Rolen and Aramis Ramirez..Beltre leads the Sox with 95 RBI this year, tied for 10<sup>th</sup> in the AL..His 40 RBI since the All-Star Break are T-2<sup>nd</sup> in the AL.

**30 ROCKS:** David Ortiz knocked his 29<sup>th</sup> homer in Wednesday night's win, topping his mark from 2009 (28)..He ranks 6<sup>th</sup> in the American League and is 1 shy of his 6<sup>th</sup> career 30-HR campaign, 1<sup>st</sup> since 2007..The 6, 30-HR seasons will tie Manny Ramirez for 2<sup>nd</sup> most in Red Sox history behind Ted Williams (8).

**TO THE VICTOR:** Victor Martinez is batting .385 (20-for-52) with 5 homers and 12 RBI over his last 12 games dating back to 8/27..In that time ranks among AL leaders in homers (T-1<sup>st</sup>), RBI (T-2<sup>nd</sup>) and batting average (5<sup>th</sup>)..He has hit safely in 14 of his last 15 games overall at .367 (22-for-60).

**10 SPOTS:** With Marco Scutaro's 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> homers on Wednesday night, the Sox now have 8 players in double-digits in 2010 (also Beltre, Drew, Hall, Martinez, Ortiz, Pedroia and Youkilis), tied with the Yankees and Blue Jays for the most in the Majors..It is the most by a Red Sox club since the 2003 squad boasted 9 players with 10 or more homers.

**TO THE NINES:** Darnell McDonald is the only Major Leaguer with at least 9 homers and 9 sac hits in 2010..He is the 1<sup>st</sup> Sox player to do it since 1993, when John Valentin (11 HR, 16 SH) and Billy Hatcher (9 HR, 11 SH) accomplished the feat.

**STRIKING RESULTS:** Red Sox hurlers have recorded 8 double-digit strikeout games in their last 18 contests and 4 in 9 September tilts..Their 36 games with at least 10 K's in 2010 lead the AL..Boston paces the AL with 1,036 strikeouts this season, including an AL-high 306 K's since the beginning of August, trailing only the Padres (323), Phillies (322) and Dodgers (308) for the ML lead in that time.

**DRIVE MOVING ON:** Boston's Single-A Greenville affiliate swept the South Atlantic League's best-of-3 Southern Divisional Championship with a 5-4 Game 2 win last night in Savannah (NYM)..The Drive enter the SAL Championship Series for the 2<sup>nd</sup> straight season, with Greenville hosting Games 1 and 2 on Monday and Tuesday.

**BIRTHDAY ON TAP:** Jacoby Ellsbury celebrates his 27<sup>th</sup> birthday today..He shares his birthday with former Red Sox outfielder Ellis Burks amongst others.

The Sox continue a 3-game series in OAK tonight, their final set against the A's this year..The teams play a total of 9 times in 2010 with the Sox trailing 3-4 thus far.

Victories in the last 2 games of this series will give Boston a win in the season set with Oakland, its 4<sup>th</sup> straight year with a win or split..The Sox have won or split 5 of the last 6 season series with the A's since 2004, losing only in 2006 (3-7)..Boston is 35-29 overall vs. Oakland since the start of 2004.

The Red Sox have won 2 of their last 5 and just 6 of their last 22 contests at the Coliseum dating back to 7/26/06..Boston has not won a set in Oakland since 4/1-2/08 (2-0), after the 2 clubs opened that season with a split (1-1) in Japan.

The Sox have won 7 of their last 13 tilts vs. the A's and 17 of 30 beginning 6/7/07.

**ROSTER RECAP:** On Thursday, Boston claimed right-hander Matt Fox off waivers from the Twins and now has 34 players on the active roster (16 pitchers, 4 catchers, 6 infielders, 7 outfielders, 1 DH)..The club also has 5 players currently on the DL.

The Sox have had 50 different players appear in a game this year, most in the AL and 3<sup>rd</sup> in the Majors behind the Marlins (52) and Pirates (51)..The club had 52 players appear in a game last year.

Boston has used 23 pitchers in 2010, 2<sup>nd</sup> most in the AL behind the Royals (25).

**LOVULLO WITH SOX:** Triple-A Pawtucket manager Torey Lovullo joined the Red Sox in Oakland yesterday.

**YOUTH IS SERVED:** On Monday vs. TB, the Red Sox started 3, 22 year-old players: Lars Anderson (22 years, 346 days), Ryan Kalish (22, 162) and Yamaico Navarro (22, 310)..It was the 1<sup>st</sup> time Boston featured a starting lineup with at least 3 players under the age of 23 since 10/4/80 vs. Toronto (G2): Glenn Hoffman (22, 89), Reid Nichols (22, 60) and Chico Walker (21, 314).

### COMMUNITY CORNER

The 7<sup>th</sup> annual Day of Remembrance blood drive took place today at Fenway Park earlier today..The American Red Cross, the Red Sox and Beth Israel Deaconess Medical Center invited those eligible to donate blood in honor of those lost; so others may survive..Donors received a Red Cross and Beth Israel Deaconess Medical Center co-branded tote bag with a Red Cross Blood Donor of the Game t-shirt.

**2010:** 12-9, 4.48 ERA (91 ER/183.0 IP) in 28 GS  
**CAREER:** 114-80, 3.89 ERA (727 ER/1,684.0 IP) in 262 G, 261 GS  
**2010 SPRING TRAINING:** 1-1, 1.35 ERA (3 ER/20.0 IP) in 5 GS

**LAST START:** Took the 3-1 loss to CWS in game 2 of a Fenway Park twinbill on 9/4...Lasted 7.0 IP, giving up 3 runs (1 ER) on 4 hits with 2 walks and 7 K's...Allowed 1 unearned run through his 1<sup>st</sup> 6.0 innings, but gave up 2 tallies in the 7<sup>th</sup>, turning a 1-1 game into a 3-1 deficit...In that frame, Carlos Quentin hit an RBI double and Ramon Castro delivered a sac fly after a Ryan Kalish throwing error.

► Was his 28<sup>th</sup> start of the season, passing his 2009 total (27) for his most since 2007 (33).  
 ► Fanned at least 7 batters for the 3<sup>rd</sup> straight start, his longest such streak of the season and longest overall since a 3-gamer from 7/29-8/9/09.

► Lost for the 1<sup>st</sup> time this year when allowing 3 runs or less...Was 8-0 in his 1<sup>st</sup> 14 such starts...Has a 2.42 run support avg. (14 total runs in 52.0 IP) while on the mound in his 9 losses this year...Dropped back-to-back starts for the 4<sup>th</sup> time this year, last 8/2 vs. CLE and 8/7 at NYY...Has not lost 3 straight starts since 8/4-14/06 while with LAA (vs. TEX, at CLE and at NYY).

**POST-BREAK:** Has tallied a 3.99 ERA (31 ER/70.0 IP) over 10 starts since the All-Star break, after posting a 4.78 ERA in 18 starts prior to the break...Last season, went 7-4 with a 3.05 ERA in 15 starts following the break after going 4-4 with a 4.93 ERA over 12 1<sup>st</sup>-half starts.

**INNINGS EATER:** Leads the club with 183.0 innings...Has completed at least 6.0 IP a team-high 24<sup>th</sup> times, tied for 8<sup>th</sup> in the AL in 2010...Has gone at least 5.0 IP in 26 of 28 tilts, tied for 14<sup>th</sup> in the AL.

**NIGHT IS RIGHT:** T-3<sup>rd</sup> in the AL with 11 wins at night in 2010, trailing only Clay Buchholz (13) and Jon Lester (13)...Ranks 7<sup>th</sup> in the circuit with a .733 (11-4) win pct. at night...Owns a 3.79 ERA (56 ER/133.0 IP) in 20 night starts this year compared to 1-5, 6.30 ERA (35 ER/50.0 IP) in 8 day outings.

► Of his 114 career wins, 83 have been at night, tied with Mark Buehrle for 2<sup>nd</sup>-most in the American League since 2002 after only CC Sabathia (90).

**QUANTITY OF QUALITY:** Has notched 17 quality starts this season, tied with Jon Lester for most on the team...Of his last 17 starts since 6/6, 11 have been quality outings...Has gone 6-6, 4.20 ERA (54 ER/115.2 IP) during that stretch...Owns 155 career quality starts, 4<sup>th</sup>-most in the AL since 2002...Ranks 3<sup>rd</sup> in the AL with 145 quality starts since 2003.

**VS. OAKLAND:** Makes 2<sup>nd</sup> start vs. OAK this year after earning the win, 6/1 at Fenway...Tossed 6.0 innings, allowing 4 runs on a season-high 12 hits, with 2 walks and 4 K's in that outing...Owns 17 career wins against the A's, tied with Jamie Moyer for the most among active hurlers and tops among all pitchers since 2002.

**HEALTHY AT HOME:** Owns 9 home wins in 2010, 6<sup>th</sup> in the AL...Is 9-4 in 14 starts at home compared to a 3-5 record in 13 road starts this year...Notched 5 straight quality starts at home from 6/11-7/17, T-2<sup>nd</sup>-longest such streak of his career...Won 7 straight home games from 4/24-6/29, the longest such run in the AL this season...Posted a 3.91 ERA (20 ER/46.0 IP) during that streak.

**PREVIOUS STARTS:** Suffered the defeat in a 5-3 loss at TB on 8/29...Lasted 6.1 innings, giving up 5 runs on 9 hits with 3 walks and 7 K's...Allowed 5 or more earned runs for the 9<sup>th</sup> time this year, the most such starts of any season in his career...He is the only pitcher in the AL to have won as many as 2 such starts...Allowed just a solo HR to Carlos Pena through his 1<sup>st</sup> 5.0 frames, but surrendered a 2-run shot to Carl Crawford in a 3-run 6<sup>th</sup> inning...Hideki Okajima allowed an inherited runner to score in the 7<sup>th</sup>...Tossed 8.0 IP, giving up 3 runs (2 ER) in a 6-3 win over SEA at Fenway on 8/23...Struck out a season-high 10, all within his 1<sup>st</sup> 16 outs recorded, his 12<sup>th</sup> career double-digit K game, 1<sup>st</sup> with the Sox...Was his most K's since fanning 10 for LAA on 6/15/09 at SF...Earned his 12<sup>th</sup> win of 2010, surpassing his victory total from 2009 (11)...Was his 1<sup>st</sup> consecutive wins since 6/11 vs. PHI and 6/17 vs. ARI.

**MORE 2010 HIGHLIGHTS:** Allowed 2 runs in 7.1 innings to earn his 10<sup>th</sup> win of the year in a 4-2 victory at LAA on 7/27...He and Mark Buehrle are the only AL pitchers to record 10 or more wins in all 8 seasons from 2003-2010...Took a no-hitter into the 8<sup>th</sup> inning at SEA on 7/22, but a 2-out single by Josh Bard broke up the bid...Tossed 8.0 innings, allowing 1 run (0 ER), but received a ND in an 8-6, 11-inning Sox win...The only run scored on a passed ball...Gave up 2 hits, equaling a season-low...Left with a 6-1 lead, but was denied the win when the bullpen allowed 5 runs in the 9<sup>th</sup>.
