OAKLAND NOTES

• The Oakland Athletics have lost three in a row and four of their last five games...allowed season-highs in runs (previous: 12, May 15 at LAA) and hits (previous: 18, twice; last: June 3 at BOS)...the 22 hits allowed ties the Oakland record for most hits allowed in a nine-inning game (also: August 26, 1997 vs. NYY)...lost the series 3-1, snapping their 11-series unbeaten streak (10-0-1)...their last home series loss came when they were swept by New York from July 5 to 7...went 3-4 on the final homestand of the season, a seven-game affair against Chicago (2-1) and Texas (1-3)...begin a season-ending seven-game road trip against Los Angeles (three games) and Seattle (four games) tomorrow.

- Trevor Cahill allowed a career-high 12 hits (previous: 10, July 27, 2009 at BOS)... is 3-3 with a 6.09 ERA (23 er in 34.0 ip) over his last six starts after going 6-2 with a 1.46 ERA in his previous nine starts.
- Rajai Davis (4 for 6) matched his career-high with four hits (fourth time; last: July 10 vs. LAA)... is 16 for 42 (.381) over his last 10 games and is batting .314 (27 for 86) in September...hit .368 (25 for 68) against Texas this year.

• Mark Ellis (1 for 3) is on a six-game hitting streak (.381, 8 for 21)...is batting .400 (34 for 85) in 24 games in September...is a career .309 (197 for 637) hitter in September, his best mark for any month of the season.

• Steve Tolleson (1 for 1) hit his first Major League home run in the eighth inning.

## TEXAS NOTES

- The Texas Rangers have won 12 of their last 17 games since losing five games in a row...set season-highs in runs (previous: 13, three times; last: June 23 vs. PIT) and hits (previous: 20, May 20 vs. BAL)...it is their most hits in a game since they had 29 in a 30-3 win at Baltimore August 22, 2007...it was their most runs in a game since scoring 19 runs against Baltimore April 15, 2009...scored seven runs in the ninth, equaling their season high for an inning (also: June 4 vs. TB, 4<sup>th</sup> inning)...went 5-5 on this 10-game road trip through Seattle (1-2), Los Angeles (1-2) and Oakland (3-1)...finish the regular season with a seven-game homestand against Seattle (three games) and Los Angeles (four games) beginning tomorrow.
- Colby Lewis recorded six strikeouts and now has 192 for the season, moving him past Edwin Correa (1986) for seventh most on the Rangers single season list... is 3-1 with a 2.13 ERA (6 er in 25.1 ip) in four starts since snapping his nine-start winless streak (0-7, 5.07 ERA).
- Jeff Francoeur (4 for 6) is 14 for 31 (.452) with 11 RBI in his last eight games and is batting .385 (15 for 39) in 10 games since joining the Rangers.
- Mitch Moreland (3 for 6) had his first career multiple-home run game...had a career-high five RBI.
