OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have lost their first two games of the season after starting the season 0-2 only once over the previous 12 seasons (2007)...are 33-45 (.423) against the Mariners since 2007, which is the lowest winning percentage by any American League team over that span...are 0-2 on this three-game homestand against the Seattle Mariners.
- Brett Anderson extended his unbeaten streak to seven games dating back to last season, which includes a career-high-tying four-game winning streak and 2.09 ERA (11 er in 47.1 ip)...is 5-3 with a 1.97 ERA (15 er in 68.2 ip) in 11 career starts against the Mariners.
- Daric Barton (3 for 4) is a .333 (53 for 159) career hitter against Seattle, which is his best average against any American League team...is a career .291 (53 for 182) hitter in April, his best mark for any month of the season.
- Mark Ellis (1 for 4) is on a career-high 15-game hitting streak (.390, 23 for 59) dating back to last season...now has a 10-game hitting streak against Seattle dating back to August 11 of last year and is batting .390 (16 for 41) during the streak.

- The Seattle Mariners have won their first two games against the A's this season after losing their previous five games against the team...are 2-0 on this six-game road trip against the Oakland A's (2-0) and Texas Rangers (three games).
- Jason Vargas is winless in his past nine starts dating back to last season and is 0-7 with a 5.20 ERA (31 er in 53.2 ip) over that span...is 2-1 with a 3.32 ERA (8 er in 21.2 ip) in five career appearances against the A's.
- Justin Smoak (1 for 2) extended his hitting streak to a career-high 12 games (.425, 17 for 40) dating back to last season...is a career .325 (13 for 40) hitter against the A's.
- Ichiro Suzuki (2 for 5) recorded the 2,248th hit of his career with an infield single in the ninth inning, surpassing Edgar Martinez for the most in franchise history... is a career .330 (258 for 783) hitter against the A's.
