#### OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have won seven of their last 11 games since opening the season 1-4...are 5-0 in the last game of a series...are 5-1 in day games and 3-7 at night...have committed nine errors in their past six games and now have 18 errors this season, which is the most in the Major Leagues...are 2-2 on this six-game homestand against Detroit (2-2) and Boston (two games).
- Trevor Cahill** had a season-high nine strikeouts and has now struck out seven or more in three of his four starts this season...did not walk a batter for the eighth time in his career...is 2-0 with a 0.56 ERA (1 er in 16.0 ip) in two starts during the day and has no decisions and a 4.82 ERA (5 er in 9.1 ip) in two starts at night...A's starting pitchers have now posted a 2.08 ERA (24 er in 104.0 ip) this season.
- Mark Ellis** (2 for 4) snapped his 0 for 13 streak with a double in the sixth inning.
- Andy LaRoche** (0 for 2) is hitless in 11 at-bats since his six-game hitting streak (7 for 19, .368) was snapped...the hitting streak was the longest by an Athletic this season...is 3 for 33 (.091) in his career against the Tigers.

#### DETROIT NOTES

- The Detroit Tigers have not allowed a home run in each of the last 10 games...it is the longest single season streak by the Tigers since not allowing a home run in 17 consecutive games from April 28 to May 19, 1947...did not record a double, snapping their season-opening streak in which they had at least one double in each of their first 15 games...it was their longest such streak to open a season since at least 1919...are 2-2 on this seven-game road trip through Oakland (2-2) and Seattle (three games).
- Brad Penny** is 0-2 with a 10.44 ERA (17 er in 14.2 ip) in three starts on the road compared to having no decisions and a 4.05 ERA (3 er in 6.2) in one start at home...is 1-2 with a 6.88 ERA (13 er in 17.0 ip) in three career starts against the A's.
- Austin Jackson** (1 for 4) snapped his 0 for 16 streak with a single in the ninth inning...is a career 8 for 36 (.222) hitter against the A's.
