#### **OAKLAND NOTES**

- The Oakland Athletics have won eight of their last 12 games since opening the season 1-4...are over .500 for the first time this season and the first time since September 24 of last season...have committed 10 errors in their past seven games and now have 19 errors this season, which is the most in the Major Leagues...are 26-22 (.542) against the Red Sox since 2006, which is the best record by any American League team over that span...have won 17 of their last 23 games against Boston in at the Coliseum...are 3-2 on this six-game homestand against Detroit (2-2) and Boston (1-0).
- A's starting pitchers have a 0.27 ERA (1 er in 33.2 ip) over their past five games and now have a 2.01 ERA (25 er in 112.0 ip) this season.
- Brett Anderson allowed one walk and has now walked one batter or fewer in each of his four starts this season...is 4-1 with a 2.08 ERA (9 er in 39.0 ip) in six career starts against Boston.
- Daric Barton (1 for 4) snapped his 0 for 10 streak with a RBI single in the eighth inning.
- Mark Ellis (1 for 3) has doubled three times over his past two games...is a .310 (71 for 229) career hitter against the Boston, his second highest average against any team (Tampa Bay, .313).
- Hideki Matsui (1 for 4) had a two-run double in the eighth inning and now has eight RBI in his past nine games.

- The Boston Red Sox had their season-high three-game losing streak snapped...are winless on the road (0-7) compared to 5-4 at home...are 0-1 on this nine-game road trip through Oakland (0-1), Los Angeles (four games) and Baltimore (three games).
- Terry Francona was ejected by home plate umpire Jim Reynolds in the fourth inning...it was his first ejection of the season and the 30<sup>th</sup> of his
  managerial career.
- John Lackey is 0-2 with a 9.32 ERA (10 er in 9.2 ip) in two starts on the road...is now 17-6 with a 2.86 ERA (66 er in 208.0 ip) in 32 career starts against the A's.
- Adrian Gonzalez (2 for 4) is on a four-game hitting streak (6 for 16, .375) and has now hit safely in 10 of 16 games this season.
- Jed Lowrie (0 for 4) had his seven-game hitting streak snapped and is now batting .536 (15 for 28) over his last eight games.
