#### OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have won seven of their last 12 games and 11 of their last 18...are 1-0 on this seven-game homestand against Texas (1-0) and Cleveland (three games).
- Trevor Cahill** has tossed at least six innings in four of his six starts this year and allowed one run or fewer five times...walked three batters in the first inning, the fifth time in his career he has walked three batters in an inning (last: July 17, 2009 vs. LAA)...is now 4-0 with a 1.88 ERA (8 er in 38.1 ip) this season...is 2-0 with a 1.02 ERA (2 er in 17.2 ip) in three starts against AL West competition this year and 13-6 with a 2.23 ERA (37 er in 149.1 ip) in 23 starts in his career...is 7-2 with a 2.27 ERA (16 er in 63.1 ip) in 10 career starts against Texas.
- Josh Willingham** (2 for 4) doubled home Jackson from second base in the fifth inning and is now 10 for 28 (.357) with 12 RBI with runners in scoring position this season.

#### TEXAS NOTES

- The Texas Rangers have lost 10 of their last 16 games...are 4-6 on the road compared to 11-5 at home...had their three-game winning streak in Oakland snapped, which was their longest such streak since also winning three straight from September 16, 2007 to May 3, 2008...are 0-1 on this seven-game road trip through Oakland (0-1) and Seattle (three games).
- C.J. Wilson** is now 3-1 with a 3.12 ERA (14 er in 40.1 ip) in six starts this season...is 1-1 with a 2.29 ERA (5 er in 19.2 ip) in three career starts against the A's.
- Adrian Beltre** (1 for 4) is batting .324 (23 for 71) over his past 19 games to raise his average from .107 to .263 (26 for 99)...has hit safely in his past nine road games (13 for 36, .361).
- Michael Young** (2 for 5) now has 225 career hits against the A's, which the sixth most ever against Oakland...has hit safely in 17 of his last 19 games (29 for 77, .377) to raise his average from .241 to .340 (36 for 106).
