OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics are 6-12 in night games compared to 9-3 during the day...now have 10 pickoffs this season, which lead the Major Leagues...are 3-2 on this seven-game homestand against Texas (3-1) and Cleveland (0-1).
- **Tyson Ross** threw a career-high 97 pitches (previous: 78, May 20, 2010 vs. DET)...has a 0.68 ERA (1 er in 13.1 ip) over his past two starts after allowing three earned runs in 4.1 innings in his first start...is now 1-2 with a 2.38 ERA (6 er in 22.2 ip) in six appearances, three starts, overall this season.
- **Coco Crisp** (0 for 4) had his season-high-tying five-game hitting streak snapped and is now batting .480 (12 for 25) over his past six games.
- **Hideki Matsui** (2 for 4) is batting .282 (22 for 78) over his past 20 games after going 4 for 25 (.160) in his first seven games.
- **Kurt Suzuki** (0 of 4) had his five-game hitting streak snapped and is now 7 for 23 (.304) over his last six games.

CLEVELAND NOTES

- The Cleveland Indians are on a seven-game winning streak...at 20-8, are off to their best start since 1999 when they also started 20-8...are 5-2 against American League West opponents this season...are 1-0 on this six-game road trip through Oakland (1-0) and Los Angeles (three games).
- **Fausto Carmona** pitched a season-high 8.0 innings...earned his first road win of the season and is now 1-2 with a 3.92 ERA (9 er in 20.2 ip) in three starts on the road...is 2-2 with a 2.79 ERA (9 er in 29.0 ip) in four starts against the A's over the past two seasons.
- **Asdrubal Cabrera** (3 for 5) has hit safely in six of his past seven games (10 for 29, .345).
- **Jack Hannahan** (2 for 4) has hit safely in 10 of his last 11 games (14 for 40, .350).
- **Matt LaPorta** (2 for 4) is batting .340 (16 for 47) with 10 RBI over his past 13 games.
