TRIBE AT A GLANCE: The Indians will begin a 3-game set with the Oakland Athletics tonight at 10:07PM ET in Oakland... Series is part of a 6-game trip to Oakland and LA Angels... Just finished a perfect 6-0 homestand sweeping both the Detroit Tigers and Kansas City Royals... Recently finished a 6-game trip to Kansas City and Minnesota at 2-4... Earlier concluded a 3-game series/homestand by sweeping the Baltimore Orioles... Indians are 13-2 on the year at home and 6-6 on the road... **Indians have won 13 straight home games, equaling their longest home winning streak since winning 13-straight in April/May 1996...** The Indians won 8 straight from April 3-11 marking their longest winning streak since 2008 (10 straight 8/17-27)... Have already surpassed their season long win streak from 2010 (7G, 9/24-10/1).

ABOUT THE START: The Indians last started 19-8 (or better) in 1999 when they started 20-8... Have been in first place or shared first place for each of the last 26 days since April 7 ... Indians are season-high 11 games over .500 for first time since the end of 2007... **Indians set a new franchise record for wins in April with 18 surpassing the old mark of 16 set in 1999, 1996 & 1988...** Indians current 13-game home winning streak is T5th longest in club history... Tribe has not started 13-2 at home since 1941 (Elias).

MAKEUP DATE SET: The Indians and Twins game that was postponed due to rain on April 22 in Minnesota has been re-scheduled for Monday, July 18th at 1:10PM ET in Target Field... The game will be part of a day/night doubleheader with the originally scheduled game beginning at 8:10PM ET.

THIS & THAT: After completing a sweep of Detroit on Sunday, the Indians now have 5 series (all 3G) sweeps this season... Had just four sweeps all of last year... **Indians currently own the best record in MLB...** Last time they had or shared the best record in MLB was at the end of the 2007 season when Cleveland & Boston both posted identical records of 96-66... **Indians hold the largest run differential +47 (146RS/99RA) of any team in MLB...** The NY Yankees are 2nd at +39 (144RS/105RA).

DID YOU KNOW?
Indians currently own the best record in MLB at 19-8... Have won 6 straight games.
Indians AAA affiliate Columbus Clippers have won 12 straight games... Own the best record in MiLB at 20-5.
Tribe is 13-2 when they score 1 st and 15-1 when they outhit their opponents.
Indians are hitting .319 (69-216) w/RISP... Hit .248 w/ RISP last year... Last 15G with RISP are 43-123 (.350).
Dating back to last year, RAFAEL PEREZ has not allowed an earned run in his last 22 app. (18.1IP, 14H, 1R, 9BB, 11K).
SHIN-SOO CHOO has hit in 8-straight games batting .367 (11-30) w/ 2HR & 5RBI.
GRADY SIZEMORE has 12XBH (8 2B, 4HR) in 12G... Had 8XBH in 33G last year.
JOSH TOMLIN has now pitched at least 5.0 innings in each of his first 17 career appearances in 2010-2011 as he is the ONLY pitcher in club history to accomplish the feat... Currently ranks T4th in the AL in wins (4), 9th in ERA (2.45) & 5th in avg. against (.188).
CARLOS SANTANA is T3rd among MLB primary catchers in RBI (17).

TROUBLE BY THE BAY: The east side of the Bay has not been kind to the Tribe in recent years as since July 29-31 of 2002, Tribe has lost 9 of their last 10 series (split 2G series in 2006) in Oakland... Since 2003 Indians are 8-23 against the A's in Oakland... Last year Indians lost 2 of 3 in Oakland by a combined score of 22-6 (Were shutout 10-0 & 11-0).

SUCCESSFUL STARTERS: Over the last 25 games Indians starting pitchers are 13-3 w/a 2.92 ERA (157.1IP, 135H, 51ER) with 20 quality starts... Allowed 17ER in 9.2IP over the first two games... On the year starters own a 3.66 ERA, which is 3rd best in the AL... Starters have pitched at least 6.0IP in 21 of 27G and at least 7.0IP in 12 of 27G... **20 quality starts are T2nd in MLB with PHL trailing LAA 21.**

POTENT OFFENSE: The Indians are currently tied with Texas for the AL in runs scored with 146... **Are 2nd in AL in runs/game at 5.4 trailing NYY 5.5...** Tribe also leads the AL in on-base % (.344), are 2nd in average (.272), 3rd in slugging % (.445), 3rd in HR (34) & 7th in walks (97)... Last year thru 27 games had scored 95 runs (3.52RS/G) & were hitting .242 (217-896)... **Have scored 5 or more runs in 14 of 27 games... Are 15-2 when scoring at least 4 runs.**

SLICK D: The Indians currently are 4th in the AL in fielding % at .987 and have made the T3rd fewest errors in the league at 13... Last year thru 27 games Tribe made 17E... Have not made an error in 16 of 27G... As a result of their defense, **Tribe has allowed just 4 unearned runs all year, tied with Baltimore for fewest in the AL.**

GOOD RELIEF: Tribe bullpen currently sports the 5th lowest ERA in the AL at 3.08... Pen has limited hitters to a .216 (63-292) average against which is the 5th lowest relief average against in the AL... **Pen has allowed just 1R/ER in their last 12.0IP & just 3R/ER in their last 17.1IP (5G).**

VETERAN PRESENCE: Indians 2B ORLANDO CABRERA, signed as a free agent Feb. 16 currently is tied for the team lead with 17RBI... On the year he is batting .294 (30-102) w/ 16RS, 3 2B, 2HR & 17RBI... **7 of his 17RBI have either tied or give the Indians the lead (4 give lead)...** Has hit in each of last 5 games batting .450 (9-20) w/ 5RBI.

MASTERFUL MASTERSON: Despite not getting a decision on Sunday, RHP JUSTIN MASTERSON remains 5-0 w/a 2.25 ERA in 6 starts... He is T2nd in the AL in wins (5), 6th in ERA (2.25) & T12th in IP (40.0)... **He is only the 4th Indians pitcher in team history to win 5 games in April in one season...** He has still won 7 of his last 8 decisions since last year... Last year did not win his 5th game until Aug. 26th in his 26th start.

LAST GAME: The Indians defeated the Detroit Tigers 5-4 on Sunday as they swept the 3G set, winning all 3G in their last at-bat... JUSTIN MASTERSON (7.0IP, 7H, 3R/2ER) started but did not receive a decision... CHAD DURBIN (0.1IP, 1K) picked up his 1st win and CHRIS PEREZ (1.0IP, 2H, 1ER) recorded his 7th save... MATT LAPORTA was 2-3 w/ 2 2B & 3RBI... ORLANDO CABRERA (2-3, RBI) plated the go-ahead run in the bottom of the 8th with a RBI single.

RHP FAUSTO CARMONA (2-3, 5.15ERA)

FAUSTO CARMONA ... Is making his 7th start and appearance of the 2011 season today in Oakland...Is his 3rd start on the road and his 1st start vs. the A's this year (10th career start & 11th appearance vs. OAK)... **Selected to his 1st career All-Star game on last year on July 4 by AL Manager Joe Girardi & was the Indians lone representative...Signed long-term contract through 2011 w/club options for 2012, 2013 & 2014 seasons on April 10, 2008.**

- ⇒ Product of the Indians' Dominican Academy was the Tribe's Minor League Pitcher of the Year in 2003.
- ⇒ In 2003 was named to the **Baseball America** Low Class A All-Star team and the #3 prospect overall in the Indians organization by **BA**...Pitched primarily at A Lake County where he led the South Atlantic League in wins (17) and ERA (2.06) and was a SAL All-Star... Won 10 games between 3 stops along the Tribe's minor league trail in 2004 and after the season was added to the club's 40-man roster.
- ⇒ Split the 2005 minor league season between Akron and Buffalo, going a combined 13-9 w/a 3.68 ERA in 27 games/26 starts between AAA Buffalo and AA Akron...His 173.2IP led the entire Indians organization.
- ⇒ Was the first member of the Indians' Lake County (A) affiliate to appear in a game for Cleveland...Split 2006 between Buffalo and Cleveland...
- ⇒ In 2007 posted one of the finest seasons by an Indians right-handed pitcher in recent memory, finishing with 19 wins, the most by an Indians pitcher since RHP Bert Blyleven in 1984 (19) at the age of 23...Youngest Indian RHP to reach 200.0IP since Eckersley in 1977... Finished 4th in the AL Cy Young voting, 2nd in the AL in ERA, he finished T2nd in wins (19), T10th in innings (215.0)...He was the youngest Indians RHP to win 17 or more games since Bob Feller did it each year between 1938-41 (ages 19-22)...Went a combined 13-19 in 2008-09.

LAST YEAR... Enjoyed a bounce-back season as he led the team in virtually every pitching category and was the Indians lone All-Star representative, marking his 1st selection to the game... Finished 20th in the AL in ERA (3.77), T11th in innings pitched (210.1), T18th in wins (13), T5th in CG (4) and 17th in slugging % allowed (.380)... Also led the AL in GIDP (30)... Went 2-1 with a 1.99 ERA in 6 starts from September 1 through the end of the season as his 1.99 ERA was 3rd lowest in the American League over that time... Had a club season-high 22.0IP scoreless streak from September 3-16...

THIS YEAR... Went 5-2 w/a 3.72 ERA in 7 starts this spring (29.0IP, 32H, 12ER, 8BB, 24K, 4HR, .288AVG)...Led AL pitchers in wins (no other pitcher had as many as 4) and was 1st in innings and 3rd in strikeouts...

- ⇒ Made first opening day start on Friday, April 1 and didn't fair to well in the 15-10 loss to the Sox and Mark Buehrle...3.0IP, 11H, 10R/ER, 1BB, 5K, HR to Quentin and Dunn...Tied for the most ER allowed in a season-opening start in MLB since 1919 and the most since 1949...
- ⇒ Did not get a decision in his 2nd start of the season of Thursday, April 7 in Progressive Field vs. Boston, a 1-0 win over Daniel Bard (A Cabrera squeeze bunt in the 8th inning)...7.0IP, 2H, 0R, 2BB, 4K...Became the first pitcher since 1905 to allow 0 runs in 2nd start of the season after allowing 10 runs in his opening start...Tough luck loser in 3rd start at LAA (7.2IP, 4H, 2R/ER)... Earned his 1st win of the season on April 17 vs. Baltimore in Progressive Field, a 4-2 win over the Orioles... 7.0IP, 5H, 2R/1ER, BB, 5K...**Over his last 5 starts is 2-2 w/a 2.94 ERA (33.2IP, 23H, 11ER, 18K).**
- ⇒ Thru 6 starts batters are hitting .246 (34-138, 4HR) off him...LHH are hitting .222 (16-72) w/a HR and RHH are batting .273 (18-66) with 3HR ...Batters are hitting .352 (19-54) with runners on and .258 (8-31) with RISP, 1 for 10 with RISP/2outs....1SB/0CS..4GIDP (T11th in the AL)...Is 4th in GB/FB ratio of 2.26 (70GB/31FB)

LAST START: Won his last start of Thursday, April 28 against the Kansas City Royals in Progressive Field, an 8-2 win over the Royals and Kyle Davies (4HR all'd)...7.0IP, 5H, 2R/ER, 2BB, 2K to improve to 2-3...LHH were 1 for 12, 1 for 6 w/RISP

ON THE ROAD: Today is Fausto's 3rd start on the road this season... **THIS YEAR:** Is 0-2 w/a 5.68 ERA (12.2IP, 11H, 8R/ER, 7BB, 7K) in 2 road starts... **CAREER:** Is 22-25 w/a 4.80 ERA in 74 games/56 starts (352.2IP, 375H, 188ER, 147BB, 204K) on the road.

WEDNESDAY'S STARTER: RHP JOSH TOMLIN will be making his 6th start of the season on Wednesday, May 4th in Oakland...Improved to 4-0 in his last start of Wednesday, April 27 against the Kansas City Royals in Progressive Field...Was a 7-2 win over the Royals and Jeff Francis (5run 1st inning)...6.0IP, 5H, 2R/ER, 1BB 3K, HR to Francoeur and Aviles...**Is 4-0 w/a 2.45 ERA in 5 starts this year (33.0IP, 22H, 9R/ER, 8BB, 18K)... Is T3rd the AL in wins (4), 5th in average against (.188) & 10th in ERA (2.45)... Is the only Indians pitcher in club history to go at least 5.0IP in each of his first 17 appearances with the club...** Went 0-1 w/a 4.15 ERA in 2 spring starts/4 games in Arizona (13.0IP, 17H, 6 ER, 2 BB, 9 K, .321AVG) and also recorded scoreless minor league outings on March 16 and March 21, 31 to nail down a spot in the rotation...Split the 2011 season between AAA Columbus and Cleveland making 12 Major League starts from July 27th thru the end of the season... Began the year in Columbus and went 8-4 with a 2.68 ERA in 20 games/17 starts for the Clippers... Named to the Triple A All-Star team... Won his Major League debut on July 27 vs. the New York Yankees as he allowed 1R/ER in 7.0IP (3H, 0BB, 2K) in a 4-1 Indians win...
