OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have won five of their past seven games and 14 of 24 (.583) since their 2-5 start...are 8-6 in games decided by two runs or less this season...are 4-2 on this seven-game homestand against Texas (3-1) and Cleveland (1-1).
- Trevor Cahill** is on a season-opening five-game winning streak, the first Athletic to start the season 5-0 since Rich Harden in 2008...now has a 1.79 ERA (9 er in 45.1 ip) in seven starts this season...is 3-0 with a 1.01 ERA (3 er in 26.2 ip) in four starts at home and 2-0 with a 2.89 ERA (6 er in 18.2 ip) in three starts on the road...is 2-1 with a 3.06 ERA (6 er in 17.2 ip) in three career starts against Cleveland...threw a career-high-tying 116 pitches (also Sept. 4, 2010 vs. LAA).
- Coco Crisp** (1 for 4) has hit safely in six of his past seven games (13 for 29, .448).
- David DeJesus** (2 for 3) hit a home run in the first inning, snapping a 55-game homerless streak dating back to last season (June 13, 2010 at CIN)...it was the second-longest homerless streak of his career (61 games, April 26-July 1, 2007)...added a second home run in the fourth inning, the first multiple home run game of his career and first by an Athletic this season.

- The Cleveland Indians had their seven-game winning streak snapped...are 7-7 on the road this season compared to 13-2 at home...are 1-1 on this six-game road trip through Oakland (1-1) and Los Angeles (three games).
- Josh Tomlin** allowed a home run to DeJesus in the first inning...it was the first hit in the first inning he has allowed this season after opponents got off to an 0 for 16 start...had his four-game winning streak snapped and is now 4-1 with a 2.43 ERA (11 er in 40.2 ip) in six starts.
- Michael Brantley** (2 for 4) is batting .344 (21 for 61) over his past 16 games.
- Travis Hafner** (2 for 4) is on a seven-game hitting streak (10 for 28, .357).
- Matt LaPorta** (1 for 4) has hit safely in his past five games (8 for 20, .400) and is now batting .333 (17 for 51) over his past 14 games.
