TRIBE AT A GLANCE: The Indians will continue a 3-game set with the Oakland Athletics tonight at 10:07PM ET in Oakland... Series is part of a 6-game trip to Oakland and LA Angels... Are 1-0 on the trip... Just finished a perfect 6-0 homestand sweeping both the Detroit Tigers and Kansas City Royals... Recently finished a 6-game trip to Kansas City and Minnesota at 2-4... Earlier concluded a 3-game series/homestand by sweeping the Baltimore Orioles...Indians are 13-2 on the year at home and 7-6 on the road...Indians have won 13 straight home games, equaling their longest home winning streak since winning 13straight in April/May 1996... The Indians won 8 straight from April 3-11 marking their longest winning streak since 2008 (10 straight 8/17-27)... Have already surpassed their season long win streak from 2010 (7G, 9/24-10/1).

HISTORICAL START: The Indians 20-8 on the year which equals the BEST start in the club history... Marks the 4th time in the 111 year history they have started 20-8 as they also started 20-8 in 1999, 1966 & 1920... Have started a year 21-8 only one other time (1920)... Have been in first place or shared first place for each of the last 27 days since April 7 ... Indians are season-high 12 games over .500 for first time since the end of 2007...Indians set a new franchise record for wins in April with 18 surpassing the old mark of 16 set in 1999, 1996 & 1988... Indians current 13-game home winning streak is T5th longest in club history... Tribe has not started 13-2 at home since 1941 (Elias).

<u>MLB BEST:</u> Indians currently hold the best record in the Majors at 20-8... Last time they had or shared the best record in MLB was at the end of the 2007 season when Cleveland & Boston both posted identical records of 96-66...Last night became the 1st MLB team to 20 wins... Marks the 6th time that Indians have been outright (no tied) first MLB team to 20 victories... Also did it in 1916, 1920, 1952, 1954 & 1999 (*Elias*).

LAST AT-BAT MAGIC: Last night Indians won their 4th straight game in their last at-bat of the game, which equals a club-record... Last time the Indians won 4-straight in their last at bat was July 2-5 of 1962... Also won 4 consecutive in their last at bat in June of 1943 (Elias)... Indians now have 6 wins in their last at-bat this year...

THIS & THAT: After completing a sweep of Detroit on Sunday, the Indians now have 5 series (all 3G) sweeps this season... Had just four sweeps all of last year... JOSH TOMLIN...Is making his 6th start/appearance of the 2011 season against the Oakland Athletics in Oakland...It is his 3rd start on the road this year and his 1st start career start against the Athletics (18th career Major League start).

⇒ Was the 19th round selection (581st overall) by the Cleveland Indians in the 2006 June Draft out of Texas Tech University...25 years old.

⇒ 2009 Spent the entire season with AA Akron going 14-9 with a 4.16ERA in 26 games/25 starts (145.0IP, 149H, 81R/67ER, 27BB, 125K)...His 14 wins were a league high... His 125 strikeouts were second-most, along with his 1.21 WHIP... Made two starts for the Eastern League Champions going 2-0 with a 1.93ERA spanning 14.0 innings (8H, 4R/3ER, 0BB, 15K, .160avg)...2008 Spent most of the year at A Kinston where he was tied for the Carolina League lead in shutouts (1) and complete games (1)...Was 2nd in runners/9.0IP (9.34) among league relievers...Named to the Carolina League regular season All-Star team...Did not allow an earned run over his final eight appearances with two saves (12.0IP, 4H, 1R, 4BB, 17K)...Made one start for AAA Buffalo (W, 7.0IP, 6H, 3R/ER, BB, 3K, 2HR)...2007 Ranked 3rd in the Indians Player Development System in ERA (3.36), 3rd in winning percentage (.733) and T4th in wins (11)...Named to the South Atlantic League All-Star team...2006 Named to the New York-Penn League All-Star Team...Led the NYPL in starts (15), was 2nd in wins (8) and 3rd in ERA (2.09).

LAST YEAR... Split the season between AAA Columbus and the big leagues, making 12 impressive Major League starts from July 27 through the end of the Major League season...

⇒Was a late addition to the Triple-A All-Star Game in Lehigh Valley (1.0IP, 0R)...As a starter, was 7-3 with a 2.41ERA in 17 games with one complete game...100.2IP, 79H, 29R/27ER, 29BB, 76K... Triple-A batters hit just .212 (83-391) off him this year with 11HR...LH hitters batted .246 (44-179) off him with 8HR while righties hit .184 (39-212, 3HR, .485OPS)...At time of his July 27th call-up, led International League starters with a .215 opponent average (79-368) and was tied for the fewest baserunners per 9.0IP ratio (9.83)...Ranked 2nd in ERA (2.68), WHIP (1.08) and overall opponent average (.212).

⇒ Won his big league debut on Tuesday, July 27th vs. the New York Yankees in Cleveland, a 4-1 win over the Yankees and CC Sabathia...7.0IP, 3H, 1R/ER, 0BB, 2K, faced the min thru 7.0IP before departing in the 8th...According to Elias, the performance by Tomlin (3 baserunners in 7.0IP) was only the 2nd time in club history an Indians pitcher allowed 3 or fewer baserunners in at least 7.0IP (Scott Lewis, 9/10/2008 @BAL) in his debut... Pitched his first career CG on Sept. 24 vs. Kansas City...9.0IP, 4H, 3R/ER, 2BB, 6K, HR, 112 pitches/75 strikes...

 $\Rightarrow \text{Among AL rookie pitches was T4th in wins (6), 6th in GS (12) and innings (73) and 9th in K...LHH had a .682 OPS off him and hit just .236 at the big league level...Allowed only 2 steals against 3 CS...Batters hit .300 (30-100) off him w/runners on base... Tribe Record: 7-5 (.583)...Tribe avg. RS in GS: 4.5 (54RS/12GS)...Tossed at least 5.0 innings in each of his first 12 career starts becoming just the 2nd Indian pitcher since 1920 to have started their career with that such streak: Steve Dunning went 3-5 w/a 4.08ERA in his 12G streak during 1970.$

⇒ Won his 2011 debut vs. Boston on April 5, a 3-1 win over Josh Beckett...7.0IP, 3H, 1R/ER...Improved to 2-0 in his 2nd ML start of 2011 on Sunday, April 10th against the Seattle Mariners in Safeco Field, a 6-4 win over the M's and Erik Bedard...6.2IP, 3H, 3R/ER, 3BB, 4K, HR to Langerhans... Earned his 3rd straight win in his 3rd start on April 21 vs. Baltimore in Progressive Field, a 8-3 win over the O's... 6.0IP, 6H, 2R/ER, 0BB, 4K, 2HR...

 \Rightarrow Did not receive a decision in his 4th start of the season on April 21 at Kansas City in a 3-2 Indians loss... 7.1IP, 5H, 1R/ER, BB, 4K... Improved to 4-0 after his start of April 27 vs. the KC Royals in Progressive Field, a 7-2 Indians win... 6.0IP, 5H, 2R/ER, BB, 3K... Tomlin (4-0) & Justin Masterson (5-0) are the 1st Indians pitchers to start 4-0 or better by team game #23 since 1988 when Tom Candiotti (4-0) & Greg Swindell (5-0) did so... So far this year he is 4-0 with a 2.45 ERA (33.0IP, 22H, 9R/ER, 8BB, 18K) in 5 starts... Ranks T4th in the AL in wins (4), 5th in avg. against (.188) & 9th in ERA (2.45).

 \Rightarrow Thru 5 starts, batters are hitting .188 (22-117) with 5HR, the 5th lowest average against in the AL... RHH are 10 for 47 (.213, 3HR) and LHH are 12 for 70 (.171, 2HR), 16th lowest in the AL... Batters hitting .200 (8-40) with runners on base and are just 2 for 13 (.154) thru 5 games with RISP... 0SB/0CS...4GIDP induced... Is 5th in the AL in on-base % allowed (.244) and 5th in baserunners per 9.0IP (8.45)... Has not allowed a hit (0-15) in the 1st inning.

Appeared in relief on Sunday, April 24 in relief of Carlos Carrasco in a 4-3 loss to the Twins and Carl Pavano...ND, 3.0IP, 3H, 1R/ER, 1BB, 1K...Made first start on Tuesday, April 19 in Kansas City against the Royals (L, 4.1IP, 9H, 5R/ER, 2BB, 3K)...Is 0-1 w/a 6.23 ERA (13.0IP, 22H, 9R/ER, 3BB, 8K) in 3 games/2 starts so far this year... Started the year at AAA Columbus and earned the win in his 1st start of the season on April 8 at Toledo as he allowed 2R/ER on 7 hits in 5.2IP (2BB, 4K)... Tossed a complete game shutout on April 14 at Toledo to record his 2nd win of the year (7.0IP, 8H, 0R, BB, 7K)... So far this year at AAA Columbus is 2-0 with a 2.42 ERA in 2 starts (12.2IP, 15H, 2R/ER, 3BB, 11K)... This spring went 0-1 w/a 5.50 ERA (18.0IP, 17H, 11R/ER, 7BB, 14K) in 6 games/2 starts in ML camp as he competed for the final spot in the Indians rotation... Was optioned to AAA Columbus on March 25... Last year spent the majority of the season at AAA Columbus going 8-8 with a 5.20 ERA (116.0IP, 129H, 74R/67ER, 42BB, 78K) in 20 starts... Also made 11 starts for the Indians in 2010, going 4-5 with a 4.68 ERA (57.2IP, 73H, 36R/30ER, 22BB, 34K) as he ended the season in the Tribe rotation...
