TRIBE AT A GLANCE: The Indians will continue a 3-game set with the Oakland Athletics tonight at 10:07PM ET in Oakland... Series is part of a 6-game trip to Oakland and LA Angels... **Are 1-0 on the trip...** Just finished a perfect 6-0 homestand sweeping both the Detroit Tigers and Kansas City Royals... Recently finished a 6-game trip to Kansas City and Minnesota at 2-4... Earlier concluded a 3-game series/homestand by sweeping the Baltimore Orioles... Indians are **13-2** on the year at home and **7-6** on the road... **Indians have won 13 straight home games, equaling their longest home winning streak since winning 13-straight in April/May 1996...** The Indians won 8 straight from April 3-11 marking their longest winning streak since 2008 (10 straight 8/17-27)... Have already surpassed their season long win streak from 2010 (7G, 9/24-10/1).

HISTORICAL START: The Indians **20-8 on the year which equals the BEST start in the club history...** Marks the 4th time in the 111 year history they have started 20-8 as they also started 20-8 in 1999, 1966 & 1920... Have started a year 21-8 only one other time (1920)... Have been in first place or shared first place for each of the last 27 days since April 7 ... Indians are season-high 12 games over .500 for first time since the end of 2007... **Indians set a new franchise record for wins in April with 18 surpassing the old mark of 16 set in 1999, 1996 & 1988...** Indians current 13-game home winning streak is T5th longest in club history... Tribe has not started 13-2 at home since 1941 (Elias).

MLB BEST: Indians currently hold the best record in the Majors at 20-8... Last time they had or shared the best record in MLB was at the end of the 2007 season when Cleveland & Boston both posted identical records of 96-66... **Last night became the 1st MLB team to 20 wins...** Marks the 6th time that Indians have been outright (no tied) first MLB team to 20 victories... Also did it in 1916, 1920, 1952, 1954 & 1999 (Elias).

LAST AT-BAT MAGIC: Last night Indians won their 4th straight game in their last at-bat of the game, which equals a club-record... Last time the Indians won 4-straight in their last at bat was July 2-5 of 1962... Also won 4 consecutive in their last at bat in June of 1943 (Elias)... Indians now have 6 wins in their last at-bat this year...

THIS & THAT: After completing a sweep of Detroit on Sunday, the Indians now have 5 series (all 3G) sweeps this season... Had just four sweeps all of last year... Indians hold the largest run differential +50 (150RS/100RA) of any team in MLB... The St. Louis Cardinals are 2nd at +38 (161RS/123RA).

DID YOU KNOW?

Indians currently own the best record in MLB at 20-8... Have won 7 straight games.

Indians AAA affiliate Columbus Clippers have won 13 straight games... Own the best record in MiLB at 21-5.

Indians have drawn at least 1 walk in all 28 games this season.

Tribe is 13-2 when they score 1st and 16-1 when they outhit their opponents.

Indians are hitting .321 (72-224) w/RISP... Hit .248 w/ RISP last year... Last 16G with RISP are 46-131 (.351).

Dating back to last year, RAFAEL PEREZ has not allowed an earned run in his last 22 app. (18.1IP, 14H, 1R, 9BB, 11K).

MATT LaPORTA is batting .340 (16-47) w/ 2HR & 10RBI in last 13G... Has hit in 4 straight (3 straight MHG): .438 (7-16) w/a HR & 5RBI.

JOSH TOMLIN has pitched at least 5.0 innings in each of his first 17 career appearances in 2010-2011 as he is the ONLY pitcher in club history to accomplish the feat... Currently ranks T4th in the AL in wins (4), 9th in ERA (2.45) & 5th in avg. against (.188).

SUCCESSFUL STARTERS: Over the last 26 games Indians starting pitchers are 14-3 w/a 2.83 ERA (165.1IP, 140H, 52ER) with 21 quality starts... Allowed 17ER in 9.2IP over the first two games... On the year starters own a 3.55 ERA, which is 3rd best in the AL... Starters have pitched at least 6.0IP in 22 of 28G and at least 7.0IP in 13 of 28G... 21 quality starts are tied with LAA & PHL for most in MLB.

POTENT OFFENSE: The Indians are currently 2nd in the AL in runs scored with 150... Are 2nd in AL in runs/game at 5.36 trailing NYY 5.40... Tribe also leads the AL average (.274) and on-base % (.346), are 3rd in slugging % (.440), 3rd in HR (34) & 7th in walks (100)... Last year thru 28 games had scored 99 runs (3.54RS/G) & were hitting .242 (224-928)... Have scored 5 or more runs in 14 of 28 games... Are 16-2 when scoring at least 4 runs.

SLICK D: The Indians currently are 2nd in the AL in fielding % at .988 and have made the 2nd fewest errors in the league at 13... Last year thru 28 games Tribe made 18E... Have not made an error in 17 of 28G... As a result of their defense, Tribe has allowed just 4 unearned runs, fewest in the AL.

GOOD RELIEF: Tribe bullpen currently sports the 4th lowest ERA in the AL at 3.04... Pen has limited hitters to a .214 (63-295) average against which is the 3rd lowest relief average against in the AL... Pen has allowed just 1R/ER in their last 13.0IP & just 3R/ER in their last 18.1IP (6G).

MR CLUTCH: Indians 2B ORLANDO CABRERA, signed as a free agent Feb. 16 currently is 2nd on the team with 18RBI... On the year he is batting .301 (31-103) w/ 17RS, 3 2B, 2HR & 18RBI... 8 of his 18RBI have either tied or give the Indians the lead (5 give lead)... Has hit in each of last 6 games batting .476 (10-21) w/ 6RBI.

MASTERFUL MASTERSON: Despite not getting a decision on Sunday, RHP JUSTIN MASTERSON remains 5-0 w/a 2.25 ERA in 6 starts... He is T2nd in the AL in wins (5) & 7th in ERA (2.25)... He is only the 4th Indians pitcher in team history to win 5 games in April in one season... He has still won 7 of his last 8 decisions since last year... Last year did not win his 5th game until Aug. 26th in his 26th start.
