OAKLAND NOTES

The Oakland Athletics are now 4-4 in extra-inning games this season...today's 12-inning game was their longest since playing 13 innings on May 11, 2010 at Texas, a 7-6 A's win...it was their longest game in terms of time of game this season at 3:42 (previous: 3:32, April 12 at Chicago)...at 16-16, have been exactly .500 nine times this season, including four times in the past seven days...went 4-3 on this seven-game homestand against Texas (3-1) and Cleveland (1-2)...begin a six-game road trip tomorrow through Kansas City (three games) and Texas (three games).

Brett Anderson pitched a season-high nine innings...did not walk a batter for the second time this season and has now walked one batter or fewer in six of his seven starts...has allowed only eight walks in 48.2 innings for an average of 1.48 walks per nine innings...is 1-0 with a 1.29 ERA (3 er in 21.0 ip) in three career starts against Cleveland...is now 2-2 with a 2.77 ERA (15 er in 48.2 ip) this season.

Ryan Sweeney (5 for 6) had a career-high five hits...it is the first five-hit game by an Athletic since Adam Kennedy did so on August 15, 2009 vs. Chicago-AL.

- The Cleveland Indians have won eight of their past nine games...are 8-7 on the road this season compared to 13-2 at home...earned their first series win in Oakland since July 29-31, 2002...are 2-1 on this six-game road trip through Oakland (2-1) and Los Angeles (three games).
- Jeanmar Gomez had a no decision and is now 0-1 with a 4.91 ERA (10 er in 18.1 ip) in four games, three starts, this season
- Orlando Cabrera (1 for 5) is on an eight-game hitting streak (12 for 30, 400) and has hit safely in 14 of his last 16 games (20 for 64, .313).
- Travis Hafner (2 for 5) is on an eight-game hitting streak (12 for 33, .364).
- Jack Hannahan (1 for 5) hit the go-ahead RBI single in the 12th inning.
- Lou Marson (3 for 5) hit his first career triple in the eighth inning...matched his career high with three hits (fourth time, last: Aug. 15, 2010 vs. SEA).
