OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have now been exactly .500 a total of 11 times this season...are 5-8 in the first game of a series...are 7-16 when scoring fewer than four runs and 12-3 when scoring four or more...are 9-15 at night and 10-4 during the day...are 0-1 on this seven-game homestand against Chicago (0-1), Los Angeles (two games) and Minnesota (two games).
- Brandon McCarthy is on a career-high-tying four-game losing streak (also June 25-Sept. 10, 2006)...has a 3.89 ERA (15 er in 34.2 ip) in five starts over that span...committed an error in the second inning and has now committed four errors this season, which are the most among Major League pitchers...has walked two batters in each of his past three starts after walking one or fewer in each of his first five starts...has now walked 10 batters in 56.2 innings this season.
- Coco Crisp (0 for 3) is 3 for 28 (.107) over his last eight games after going 12 for 21 (.571) with four multiple-hit games over his previous five games...is batting .202 (18 for 89) at night compared to .371 (13 for 35) during the day.

 Mark Ellis (0 for 3) is 8 for 66 (.121) with no walks over his last 19 games...his streak of 19 consecutive games without a walk matches the longest of his
- career (Sept. 20, 2006 to April 10, 2007)...is a .192 (40 for 208) career hitter against the White Sox, his lowest mark against any AL team.
- Kurt Suzuki (1 for 4) struck out in the second inning, snapping a 17-game, 73-plate appearance streak without a strikeout...it was the longest such streak of his career and the longest by an Athletic since Marco Scutaro had an 18-game streak from July 8 to August 6, 2004.
- Ryan Sweeney (1 for 3) is on a seven-game hitting streak (12 for 24, .500), the longest by an Athletic this season...is a .364 (16 for 44) career hitter against the White Sox.

CHICAGO NOTES

- The Chicago White Sox have won five of their past six games...are 7-5 in their last 11 games in Oakland after going 6-28 in their previous 34...are 5-2 on this nine-game road trip through Seattle (2-1), Los Angeles (2-1) and Oakland (1-0).
- Phil Humber is 2-1 with a 2.33 ERA (7 er in 27.0 ip) over his past four starts...allowed six hits in 6.0 innings, snapping his streak of allowing three hits or less while throwing 7.0 innings or more in three straight starts...it was tied for the longest such streak in White Sox history (also Billy Pierce, May 30-June
- Sergio Santos has not allowed a run in 18.0 innings this season and is the only qualifying reliever in baseball yet to allow a run...the scoreless streak is the second longest to begin a season by a White Sox pitcher...his 14 scoreless appearances are tied for second longest to open a season.
- Paul Konerko (2 for 4) is 16 for 37 (.432) in his last 11 games.
