#### OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics are 11-8 over the last 19 games and have not won or lost more than two in a row over that span...are 11-4 in day games this season and 9-15 at night...are 13-3 when scoring four or more runs this season and 7-16 when scoring fewer than four...are 59-33 against the White Sox since the start of the 2001 season, which is the best record by any American League team over that span...are 1-1 on this seven-game homestand against Chicago (1-1), Los Angeles (two games) and Minnesota (two games).
- Tyson Ross** pitched a career-high 7.1 innings (previous: 7.0 ip, April 27, 2011 at LAA), threw a career-high 102 pitches (previous: 97, May 3, 2011 vs. CLE) and recorded a career-high eight strikeouts (previous: 4, three times; last: May 8, 2011 at KC)...is 2-1 with a 2.32 ERA (8 er in 31.0 ip) in five starting assignments since he was moved into the rotation April 22 after Braden was placed on the disabled list...allowed a home run to Konerko in the sixth inning, snapping a season-opening 34.1-inning stretch without allowing a home run...the innings pitched were the most in the majors among pitchers with no home runs.
- David DeJesus** (1 for 3) hit a two-run triple in the fifth inning, which was the 1,000<sup>th</sup> hit of his career.
- Mark Ellis** (0 for 3) is 8 for 69 (.116) with no walks over his last 20 games...his streak of 20 consecutive games without a walk is the longest of his career (previous: 19, Sept. 20, 2006 to April 10, 2007).
- Ryan Sweeney** (0 for 5) had his seven-game hitting streak snapped and is now 12 for 29 (.414) over his past eight games...the hitting streak was the longest by an Athletic this season.
- Andrew Bailey** pitched 1.1 innings and threw 18 pitches in a rehab appearance at extended spring training (2 h, 1 r, 1 er, 0 bb, 0 so).

#### CHICAGO NOTES

- The Chicago White Sox have lost 10 of their past 16 games...are 5-3 on this nine-game road trip through Seattle (2-1), Los Angeles (2-1) and Oakland (1-1).
- Gavin Floyd** allowed five runs on a season-high nine hits...is 1-3 with a 6.29 ERA (17 er in 24.1 ip) in four starts during the day compared to 3-0 with a 2.48 ERA (8 er in 29.0 ip) in four starts at night...was charged with his first career loss against the A's and is now 3-1 with a 2.35 ERA (10 er in 38.1 ip) in seven starts against the team...is 3-8 with a 5.70 ERA (38 er in 60.0 ip) in 11 career starts on the West Coast.
- Brent Morel** (1 for 3) is 7 for 18 (.389) over his past five games after going 4 for 41 (.098) in his previous 15 games.
- Juan Pierre** (0 for 4) is 3 for 25 (.120) over his past six games.
- Adam Dunn** (2 for 4) is 12 for 29 (.414) with seven doubles in his last seven games.
- Paul Konerko** (1 for 4) homered in the sixth inning to extend his hitting streak to seven games (13 for 28, .464) and is 17 for 41 (.415) over his last 12 games.
- Alexei Ramirez** (1 for 3) is 8 for 25 (.320) with six runs scored over his last six games.
