GAME NOTES

- Tonight's first pitch was delayed 42 minutes due to rain.

OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics are now tied with Texas for first place in the American League West...it is the first time they have had a share of first place since June 3 of last year when they were tied for first with the Rangers...are now two games over .500 at 22-20, which matches their season high (also: 19-17, May 9)...scored a season-high 14 runs, their most runs in a game since scoring 15 runs on July 10 of last year against Los Angeles...the 14-run margin of victory is the third largest in Oakland history in a shutout...had a 16-0 shutout of San Francisco on June 26, 2005 and a 15-0 shutout of Baltimore August 30, 2001...with tonight's win, completed a two-game sweep of the Angels...the sweep snaps a 13-series streak in which the A's had not swept a series or been swept...it was the longest such season-opening streak in Oakland history...are 3-2 on this seven-game homestand against Chicago (1-2), Los Angeles (2-0) and Minnesota (two games).
- Gio Gonzalez** is 3-0 with a 1.74 ERA (4 er in 20.2 ip) in three starts in May after going 2-2 with a 2.70 ERA in five starts in April...has struck out 48 batters in 50.2 innings...has a 1.74 ERA (6 er in 31.0 ip) in five starts at night and a 3.20 ERA (7 er in 19.2 ip) in three starts during the day.
- Mark Ellis** (3 for 4) recorded season highs in RBI (4) and runs scored (3)...also had a season-high-tying three hits (second time, also: May 15 vs. CWS)...is 7 for 19 (.368) with four runs scored and five RBI on the homestand.
- David DeJesus** (2 for 4) is 6 for 13 (.462) on the homestand...is a .330 (73 for 221) career hitter against Los Angeles, his best mark against any team.
- Kurt Suzuki** (2 for 4) is 7 for 18 (.389) on the homestand and is now batting .318 (21 for 66) at home compared to .200 (13 for 65) on the road.
- Andrew Bailey** pitched one inning and threw 19 pitches today in his second rehab appearance at extended spring training (0 h, 0 r, 0 er, 2 bb, 1 so).

LOS ANGELES NOTES

- The Los Angeles Angels have lost five of their past six games...are 0-13 when trailing after seven innings and 0-16 when trailing after eight...are 4-8 in their last 12 games against the A's in Oakland...are 1-4 on this seven-game road trip through Texas (1-2), Oakland (0-2) and Seattle (two games).
- Tyler Chatwood** allowed a career-high seven runs...five of the runs were earned, which matches his career high (second time, also: May 1, 2011 at TB)...pitched a career-low 2.1 innings (previous: 4.0 ip, May 1, 2011 at TB)...has a 7.43 ERA (11 er in 13.1 ip) on the road compared to 3.23 (11 er in 30.2 ip) at home.
- Peter Bourjos** (0 for 3) is on an 0 for 20 streak and is batting .167 (9 for 54) in May after batting .300 in April.
- Alberto Callaspo** (0 for 3) had his season-high eight-game hitting streak snapped and is batting .361 (13 for 36) in his past nine games.
- Mark Trumbo** (0 for 3) is 3 for 25 (.120) over his past eight games.
