### **OAKLAND NOTES**

- The Oakland Athletics have lost five of their last eight games...are now 22-22, which marks the 13<sup>th</sup> time they have been exactly .500 this season...are 7-19 when scoring when scoring less than four runs and 15-3 when scoring four or more...went 3-4 on this seven-game homestand against Chicago (1-2), Los Angeles (2-0) and Minnesota (0-2)...begin a seven-game road trip tomorrow through San Francisco (three games) and Los Angeles (four games).
- Tyson Ross left the game due to a left oblique strain...did not retire a batter and was removed after seven pitches...the last A's starting pitcher to not retire a batter in a start was Omar Olivares on June 16, 2000 at Kansas City...since Stats, Inc. began tracking pitching counts in 1987, no A's starting pitcher had tossed fewer than 10 pitches in a game...the previous low was 10 by Olivares.
- David Purcey allowed a home run to Rivera in the second inning...the home run snapped a 23-game, 65.0-inning streak in which the A's bullpen had not allowed a home run.
- Brad Ziegler allowed his first run in 17 appearances this season and now has a 0.66 ERA (1 er in 13.2 ip).
- Mark Ellis (1 for 4) now has 999 career hits and needs only one more to become the 12<sup>th</sup> player in Oakland history to reach the 1,000 plateau...is 8 for 21 (.381) over his last five games.
- Ryan Sweeney (0 for 3) is 2 for 13 (.154) over his last six games after hitting safely in an A's season-high seven consecutive games (12 for 24, .500).

#### MINNESOTA NOTES

- The Minnesota Twins have won their past three games since losing nine in a row...scored a season-high 11 runs (previous: 10, April 23 vs. CLE)...hit three home runs in a game for the first time this season and the first time since September 25, 2010 at Detroit...are 13-8 when scoring first compared to 2-19 when their opponents score first...are 10-5 in their last 15 games against the A's...are 3-1 on this seven-game road trip through Seattle (1-1), Oakland (2-0) and Arizona (three games).
- Nick Blackburn is 2-0 with a 1.63 ERA (5 er in 27.2 ip) in four starts in May after going 1-4 with a 5.14 ERA in five starts in April...has won his last 10 decisions in the month of May...is 3-1 with a 2.97 ERA (10 er in 30.1 ip) in five starts during the day and 0-3 with a 3.91 ERA (11 er in 25.1 ip) in four starts at night.
- Justin Morneau (3 for 5) is 19 for 38 (.500) with six home runs and 15 RBI in his last 11 games in Oakland and is a .319 (68 for 213) career hitter with 15 home runs and 45 RBI against the A's.
- Rene Rivera (2 for 4) hit a home run in the second inning...it was his first home run since July 9, 2006 against Detroit.
- Danny Valencia (2 for 5) snapped an 0 for 19 streak with a RBI double in the eighth inning.
