OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have won three of their last four games after losing a season-high six consecutive games...left 15 runners on base, which matches their season high (also April 20 vs. BOS)...turned a season-high-tying four double plays (also May 15 vs. CWS)...are 18-4 when scoring four runs or more and 7-23 when scoring less than four...have won 18 of their last 22 games against the Orioles, including 10 of the last 11 in Oakland...are 73-31 (.702) against the Orioles since the start of the 1999 season, which is the best winning percentage against Baltimore by an American League team over that span...are 1-0 on this six-game homestand against Baltimore (1-0) and New York (three games).
- Gio Gonzalez finishes May with a 1.67 ERA (6 er in 32.1 ip) in five starts, which is the lowest single-month ERA of his career (previous: 1.98, August 2010)...remains on a three-game winning streak, which is one short of his career high of four (twice, last: Aug. 24-Sept. 8, 2010)...is 1-0 with a 2.08 ERA (4 er in 17.1 ip) in three career starts against Baltimore.
- Joey Devine has not allowed an earned run in his last 30 games and 30.1 innings dating back to 2008...also has a 65-game, 64.0-inning, 255-batter homerless streak dating back to 2006.
- David DeJesus (1 for 3) is on a six-game hitting streak (10 for 20, .500) and is now batting .370 (17 for 46) over his last 14 games.
- Ryan Sweeney (2 for 5) is batting .375 (18 for 48) in 18 games in May after batting .222 in 16 games in April.
- Bob Geren was ejected by home plate umpire Angel Campos in the sixth inning...it was his first ejection of the year and 10th of his career as a manager.
- Andrew Bailey made a rehab appearance with Triple-A Sacramento and did not allow a run in one inning (2 h, 0 bb, 1 so)...has not allowed a run in his four rehab appearances with the River Cats (4.0 ip, 3 h, 1 bb, 3 so).

BALTIMORE NOTES

- The Baltimore Orioles had their season-high five-game winning streak snapped...it was their longest winning streak since they also won five straight from June 17 to 21, 2009...hit into a season-high-tying four double plays (also May 12 vs. SEA)...are 7-11 in the first game of a series...are 4-20 when scoring fewer than four runs and 20-5 when scoring four or more...are 15-18 at night compared to 9-7 during the day...are 0-1 on this on this six-game road trip through Oakland (0-1) and Seattle (three games).
- Chris Tillman did not allow a home run and has now gone seven consecutive starts without allowing a home run...the last Orioles starter to go seven or more starts without allowing a home run was Daniel Cabrera, who did not allow a home run in eight straight from September 12, 2006 to April 20, 2007...is 1-2 with a 5.61 ERA (16 er in 25.2 ip) in six starts on the road compared to 1-1 with a 3.63 ERA (9 er in 22.1 ip) four starts at home.
- Vladimir Guerrero (1 for 3) is on a 12-game hitting streak (20 for 53, .377), which matches the longest hitting streak by an Oriole this season.
- Nick Markakis (1 for 3) is on a 12-game hitting streak (18 for 50, 360), which matches the longest hitting streak by an Oriole this season (Brian Roberts, April 13-26)...has now recorded a base hit in 157 consecutive series, which is the longest such streak in the majors since Ichiro Suzuki hit in 160 straight series from June 2000 to June 2004.
