



# BALTIMORE ORIOLES GAME NOTES

Baltimore Orioles (24-24) vs. Oakland Athletics (24-27)

RH Chris Tillman (2-3, 4.95) vs. LH Gio Gonzalez (5-2, 2.20)

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Orioles and Athletics meet in the opener of their three-game set and the first game of a six-game road trip...The Orioles went 5-3 on their last homestand and have won five games in a row for the first time this season...The O's are in search of their 25<sup>th</sup> win of 2011, after not winning their 25<sup>th</sup> game in 2010 until July 4<sup>th</sup>...The Orioles are looking for their 10<sup>th</sup> road win after not picking up their 10<sup>th</sup> road win of 2010 until July 8<sup>th</sup>...The Orioles have won five straight games for the first time since June 17-21, 2009...The O's are .500 for the first time since May 1, when they were 13-13.

**VS. OAKLAND:** The Orioles lost the season series 3-7 in 2010 as they went 2-4 in Baltimore and 1-3 in Oakland...The Orioles trail in the all-time series 237-239, going 113-122 in Baltimore and 124-117 in Oakland...The Orioles have not won a season series with the A's since going 8-3 in 1998 (they split eight games in 2007)...Since the 2008 season, the Orioles are just 1-9 in Oakland.

**PRETTY GOOD COMPANY:** Nolan Reimold set career highs with two homers, four hits and four RBI in Thursday's win over Kansas City...According to Elias, the only other O's to homer twice as part of a 4-for-4 or better game were Rafael Palmeiro (1995), Roberto Alomar (1997) and Albert Belle (1999)...Reimold's multi-homer game was the first by an Oriole since Josh Bell took Cliff Lee deep twice in Baltimore August 21, 2010.

**OPENING ACT:** The Orioles are 7-10 in series opening games this year and 21-14 in series openers since Buck Showalter took over as manager August 3, 2010...In the 34 series openers from the start of 2010 until Showalter's arrival, the Birds were 9-25.

**LACK OF SUPPORT:** In his nine starts combined this year, the Orioles have given Chris Tillman 15 runs of support while he was in the game, with 10 of those coming in his last three starts...The Birds have not scored while he was in the game in four of his nine starts...In 2010, the Birds gave him two or fewer runs while he was in the game nine times in 12 starts...Of his 23 runs allowed in 2011, 15 of them have scored in the first two innings...Tillman has not allowed a home run in his last six starts, setting a career-high.

**KEEPING IT IN THE PARK:** Chris Tillman has not allowed a home run in his last six starts...The last Oriole starter to go six or more straight starts without allowing a long ball was Daniel Cabrera from September 12, 2006-April 20, 2007.

**COMEBACK KIDS:** The Orioles rallied from a four-run deficit to win Thursday, the largest deficit they've overcome this year (previously three on April 29 at Chicago)...Jeremy Accardo picked up his third win and second in an extra innings (also May 10)...According to Elias, Vladimir Guerrero's walk-off hit was his 14<sup>th</sup> game-winning hit which moves him into a tie with Orlando Cabrera for fourth-most among active players behind David Ortiz (18), Andruw Jones (17) and Miguel Tejada (15).

**STREAKERS:** Two Orioles could tie Brian Roberts (12 games, April 13-26) for the longest hit streak of the year for the Birds tonight...Nick Markakis has hit in 11 straight games, going 17-for-47 with a double, a homer, 10 runs scored and two RBI...Vladimir Guerrero has also hit in 11 straight games, going 19-for-50 (.380) with five doubles, a homer, six runs scored and eight RBI...His average has gone from .275 to .302 during the streak which contained a career-high seven straight multi-hit games...Guerrero has hit in 14 of his last 15 games, going 24-for-65 (.369).

**DOWN ON THE FARM:** The Orioles have named former major league infielder Leo Gomez manager of the short-season Aberdeen Ironbirds of the New York-Penn League...Gomez has spent the past two seasons as a field coach for the Orioles' Gulf Coast League (2009) and Bluefield (2010) affiliates.

**IN A PINCH:** The Orioles lead the majors with a .545 batting average (6-for-11) and a 1.000 slugging percentage in pinch-hit situations as they have two doubles, a home run and three RBI...In 2010, the Orioles went 8-for-61 (.131) with two doubles, two home runs and seven RBI in pinch-hit situations.

**THE ERASER:** Matt Wieters leads all MLB catchers in caught stealing percentage (48.3 percent, 14-29) and runners thrown out (14)...Wieters is three ahead of San Francisco's Buster Posey (11 of 38).

**BULLPEN BULLIES:** The Orioles bullpen is riding a streak of 15 consecutive scoreless innings over the last four games after allowing 23 earned runs in their previous 24.1 innings (over four games)...The Birds have gone to the bullpen in 46 of the 48 games this year and the bullpen has surrendered at least one earned run in 36 of those games, including 20 of the last 25 games.

**DEALING:** In his last 10 games (14.0 IP), Jim Johnson has allowed just two earned runs, lowering his ERA from 5.14 on May 4<sup>th</sup>, to 3.21...After allowing two home runs in his first four appearances, Johnson has allowed one in his last 18 outings.

**EATING HIS WIET-IES:** Matt Wieters is 19-for-35 (.543) with five doubles, three homers and 25 RBI when batting with runners in scoring position...With two outs and RISP, he is 10-for-19 (.526) with three doubles, a homer and 14 RBI...Wieters began the year 7-for-7 with RISP.

**MAKE YOUR MOVE:** The O's are in the midst of a 30-game stretch (from May 20-June 22) where they will play just three games (Tampa Bay at home June 10-12) against teams that reached the post-season in 2010...The Birds are 5-1 so far during that stretch.

**STRONG START:** In 105 games with Buck Showalter as manager, the Orioles have made 63 Quality Starts and the starters have a 3.57 ERA (638.2IP, 253ER).

**HEATING UP:** Adam Jones (3<sup>rd</sup>-.362); Vladimir Guerrero (10<sup>th</sup>-.341) and Nick Markakis (19<sup>th</sup>-.313) are all among the American League leaders in batting average in May.

**JONESIN':** In his 22 games since May 2, Adam Jones has batted .362 (34-94) with 14 RBI...He has multiple hits in 10 of those 22 contests...He has hit .369 (24-65) with eight extra-base hits in his last 15 games...With runners in scoring position, he is batting .385 (15-39) with two doubles, a triple, three homers and 25 RBI.

**MR. CONSISTENCY:** Nick Markakis has recorded a base hit in 156 consecutive series, the longest such streak in the majors since Ichiro Suzuki hit in 160 straight series from June 2000 to June 2004...Markakis has had a hit in each series since being held hitless in a three-game series (he played in two of the games) by Tampa Bay May 23-25, 2008.

**TOMORROW'S STARTER:** LH Zach Britton makes his 11<sup>th</sup> start of the year and fourth road start...In his three road starts, Britton is 2-1 with a 3.50 ERA (18.0IP, 7ER)...The O's are 7-3 when Britton starts and eight of his 10 starts have been Quality Starts...Britton has never faced the Athletics.

**QUICK HITS:** Had three stints with the Orioles in 2010...Worked a career-high 7.1 innings on July 10, 2010 at Texas, snapping career-high five game losing streak...Made 21 starts for Norfolk (AAA) in 2010 (11-7, 3.34)...Named to the 2010 International League All-Star team...Made his MLB debut July 29, 2009 vs. KC...Started 11 games in 2010, going 2-5 with a 5.87 ERA (53.2IP, 35ER).

**LIFETIME vs. OAKLAND:** Tillman has never faced the Athletics.

**LAST OUTING:** Made his fourth start of the year where the O's did not score while he was in the game, but was taken off the hook by a 7<sup>th</sup> inning two-run homer by Vladimir Guerrero in a 2-1 win over Washington on Sunday.

**LACK OF SUPPORT:** In his nine starts combined this year, the Orioles have given Tillman 14 runs of support while he was in the game, with nine of those coming in his last three starts...The Birds have not scored while he was in the game in four of his nine starts...In 2010, the Birds gave him two or fewer runs while he was in the game nine times in 12 starts...Of his 23 runs allowed in 2011, 15 of them have scored in the first two innings...Tillman has not allowed a home run in his last six starts, setting a career-high.

**WESTERN WARRIOR:** Tillman's 3-1 record and 3.12 ERA in four starts against the AL West are his best numbers against any AL division.

**ROAD WOES:** In 17 career road starts, Tillman is 3-8 with a 5.82 ERA (85.0IP, 55ER)...He has made five Quality Starts in his 17 road outings...The O's are 4-13 in his 17 road starts.

**AT ORIOLE PARK:** Tillman is 3-5 with a 5.00 ERA (77.1IP, 43ER) in 15 starts at Camden Yards but went over a year between his home wins (August 14, 2009 vs. LAA and October 1, 2010 vs. DET)...The O's are 9-6 in his 15 starts.

**KEEPING IT IN THE PARK:** Tillman has not allowed a homer in his last six starts (31.1IP), setting a career-high and making him the first Oriole starter to go six straight starts without allowing a homer since **Daniel Cabrera** went eight from September 12, 2006-April 20, 2007.

**OPENING ACT:** Tillman threw 6.0 innings of no-hit ball in his first start of 2011, April 2 at Tampa Bay...According to Elias, over the last 15 seasons only two other pitchers threw at least 6.0 innings and didn't allow a hit in their first start of a season: **Shaun Marcum** (6 IP) for the 2007 Blue Jays and **Hideo Nomo**, who threw a no-hitter against Baltimore for the 2001 Red Sox.

**IF YOU'RE GOING TO GIVE THEM UP....:** Tillman has allowed 26 home runs in his big league career, with 19 of them being solo shots...Nine of the 26 home runs have come to the leadoff batter of an inning...Only **Alex Rodriguez** (two three-run shots), **Kelly Shoppach** (three-run), **Evan Longoria** (two-run), **Alex Rios** (two-run), **Vernon Wells** (two-run) and **Jose Bautista** (two-run) have taken Tillman deep with men on base.

**PARTY CRASHER:** Tillman spoiled **Cliff Lee's** Texas debut July 10, 2010 by holding the Rangers to two runs (one earned) on two hits and a walk over a career-high 7.1 innings...Did not allow a hit until **Ian Kinsler** singled with one out in the seventh inning...Was the first time an Oriole starter had gone as many as 7.1 innings and allowed two or fewer hits since **Chris Waters** on August 5, 2008 at LAA (8.0IP, 1H).

**AT NORFOLK IN 2010:** Became the first Tides pitcher to toss two nine inning shutouts in the same season since **Brian Bohannon** in 1997...Norfolk had not had a pitcher toss two shutouts (either seven innings or nine innings) in the same year since **Dicky Gonzalez** tossed two seven inning shutouts in 2001...Led the Tides with 11 wins and was second in strikeouts and ERA.

**NO-HITTER:** Tillman fired a nine-inning no-hitter April 28, 2010 for Norfolk at Gwinnett (Braves) as he walked one and fanned six...It was the first nine-inning no-hitter by an Oriole Triple-A farmhand since April 20, 1974, (Rochester's **Wayne Garland** vs. Charleston in a 5-0 win)...The last nine inning no-hitter by an individual in the organization was by Double-A Bowie's **Radhames Liz** on June 1, 2007 vs. Harrisburg...It was the first no-no for an Oriole affiliate since August 5, 2008, when **Brandon Erbe**, **Ryan Oulette** and **Fredy Deza** accomplished the feat for class-A Frederick against Salem.

**PART OF HISTORY:** Was the fifth (of six) Oriole starting pitchers to make his major league debut for the Orioles in 2009, joining **Brad Bergesen**, **Jason Berken**, **David Hernandez**, **Brian Matusz** and **Koji Uehara** (was the only pitcher in that group not to win his major league debut).

**QUICK ASCENT:** At 21 years, 106 days old, became the youngest Oriole to make his major league debut since **Hayden Penn** on May 28, 2005 (20 years and 228 days)...Recorded his first major league win August 14, 2009 vs. Los Angeles (AL) (6.2IP, 7H, 4R, 3ER, 2BB, 3K, HR)...Struck out Kansas City's **Mike Jacobs** for his first major league strikeout July 29...Made his major league debut July 29, 2009 vs. Kansas City.

**THANKS FOR NOTHING:** In 2009, The O's scored 2 or fewer runs while he was in the game in 9 of his 12 starts and he received 3 or fewer runs of support in 7 of his 12 starts...He received 6 runs of support in 4 starts combined, August 19-September 4 (the O's scored just 3 runs while he was in the game).

**ROUGH START:** Allowed 3 HR in 4.2 IP on July 29 to become the first Oriole to allow three homers in his major league debut since **John Stephens** on July 30, 2002 at Tampa Bay (a late Orioles rally took Tillman off the hook for the loss).

**AWARD WINNER:** Started for the U.S. Team in the 2009 MLB Futures Game on July 12 in St. Louis...Elected to the 2009 Triple-A All-Star Game, but did not pitch due to his participation in the Futures Game...Was named Orioles Minor League Pitcher of the Month and Norfolk Pitcher of the Month for April 2009...Named to the 2008 Eastern League South Division All-Star Team...Named Org. Pitcher of the Month for May 2008 and August 2008...Named to the 2008 Second Team Minor League All-Star Team.

## BIRD BITS & COMMUNITY NEWS

**MAKEUP DATES:** The Yankees have announced that their postponed game from April 12 against the Orioles will be played at 7:05 p.m. on Saturday, July 30 as part of a day-night doubleheader in the Bronx...The Orioles' April 22 postponed game against the Yankees at Camden Yards will be made up at 1:05 p.m. on Saturday, August 27 as part of a day-night doubleheader at Oriole Park.

**ORIOLES HALL OF FAME:** On March 19, the Orioles announced that **MIKE BORDICK** has been elected to the Orioles Hall of Fame, with induction set for pre-game on Saturday, August 13 against the Detroit Tigers...Head Athletic Trainer **RICHIE BANCELLS** was named this year's Herb Armstrong Award winner.

**THANK YOU FANS IN SARASOTA:** The Orioles announced that the club set an Ed Smith Stadium record with a total spring attendance of 115,506 (10 sellouts and an average of 7,219 per game). The previous attendance record at Ed Smith was 115,382 in 1994, when the White Sox and **Michael Jordan** spent the spring in Sarasota...This year's attendance number surpasses the 102,219 drawn in 2010, the first year at Ed Smith for the Birds.

## BIRD BATS

The O's have 13 position players on the active roster, 8 right-handers, 3 left-handed hitters and 2 switch hitters...Orioles batters were 8<sup>th</sup> in the AL with a .259 average & 11<sup>th</sup> with a .702 OPS last season...They were 12<sup>th</sup> in the league with a .661 OPS with RISP...O's DHs ranked 2<sup>nd</sup> in OPS (.865), average (.278), HR (31) and 5<sup>th</sup> in RBI (85)...Baltimore PHs batted .131 (8-61) with a .459 OPS in 2010.
