OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have won four of their last five games after losing a season-high six consecutive games...are 19-4 when scoring four runs or more and 7-23 when scoring less than four...have won 19 of their last 23 games against the Orioles, including 11 of the last 12 in Oakland...are 74-31 (.705) against the Orioles since the start of the 1999 season, which is the best winning percentage against Baltimore by an American League team over that span...are 2-0 on this six-game homestand against Baltimore (2-0) and New York (three games).
- Josh Outman earned his first Major League win since June 8, 2009 against Minnesota, a 4-3 A's victory...is now 1-0 with a 2.08 ERA (3 er in 13.0 ip) in two starts this season...matched his career-high by allowing five walks (second time, also: May 24, 2009 vs. ARI).
- Joey Devine has a 14.2-inning scoreless streak dating back to 2008, which is a new career-high (previous: 13.2 ip, three times; last: Aug. 6-Sept. 4, 2008)...has not allowed an earned run in his last 31 games and 31.1 innings dating back to 2008...also has a 66-game, 65.0-inning, 258-batter homerless streak dating back to 2006.
- Brian Fuentes recorded his first save since May 8 at Kansas City.
- Coco Crisp (2 for 5) is 18 for 56 (.321) over his last 13 games after going 3 for 28 (.107) over his past eight games.
- Mark Ellis (2 for 4) snapped his 49-game homerless streak dating back to October 2 of last season...the homerless streak matched the second longest of his career (57, June 18-Aug. 28, 2010).
- Cliff Pennington (2 for 4) has hit safely in each of his last seven games (12 for 28, .429), which matches the longest hitting streak of his career (third time, last: Aug. 2-8, 2009)...is a .346 (18 for 52) career hitter against the Orioles, his best mark against any American League team.

BALTIMORE NOTES

- The Baltimore Orioles have lost their past two games following their season-high five-game winning streak...are 4-21 when scoring fewer than four runs and 20-5 when scoring four or more...are 9-12 on the road compared to 15-14 at home...are 6-11 against left-handed starting pitchers...are 15-19 at night compared to 9-7 during the day...are 0-2 on this on this six-game road trip through Oakland (0-2) and Seattle (three games).
- Brad Bergesen is 1-3 with a 5.85 ERA (18 er in 27.2 ip) in five starts in May...is 1-2 with a 2.55 ERA (7 er in 24.2 ip) in three road starts compared to 0-4 with an 8.75 ERA (23 er in 23.2 ip) in five starts at home...is 0-1 with a 4.26 ERA (6 er in 12.2 ip) in two career starts against the A's.
- Jim Johnson has a 1.20 ERA (2 er in 15.0 ip) over his past 11 appearances.
- Vladimir Guerrero (1 for 4) is on a 13-game hitting streak (21 for 57, .368), which is the longest hitting streak by an Oriole this season...has now hit safely in 16 of his past 17 games (26 for 72, .361).
- Adam Jones (1 for 4) is batting .343 (35 for 102) with 15 RBI over his past 24 games.
- Nick Markakis (0 for 4) had his 12-game hitting streak snapped...batted .360 (18 for 50) during the streak.
