



# BALTIMORE ORIOLES GAME NOTES

Baltimore Orioles (24-25) vs. Oakland Athletics (25-27)  
RH Brad Bergesen (1-5, 5.64) vs. LH Josh Outman (0-0, 1.29)

**TONIGHT'S GAME:** The Orioles and Athletics meet in game two of their three-game set and the second game of a six-game road trip...The Orioles went 5-3 on their last homestand before dropping the series opener in Oakland Friday night...The O's are in search of their 25<sup>th</sup> win of 2011, after not winning their 25<sup>th</sup> game in 2010 until July 4<sup>th</sup>...The Orioles are looking for their 10<sup>th</sup> road win after not picking up their 10<sup>th</sup> road win of 2010 until July 8<sup>th</sup>...The Orioles have won five of their last six games...The Orioles will get their first look at LH **Josh Outman** tonight, while RH **Brad Bergesen** makes his second career start against Oakland.

**TONIGHT'S STARTER:** RH **Brad Bergesen** makes his ninth start of the year and fourth road start...In his three road starts, Bergesen is 1-1 with a 2.37 ERA (19.0IP, 5ER)...The O's are 1-7 when Bergesen starts and just two of his eight starts have been Quality Starts...In his only career start against the Athletics, May 27, 2010 in Baltimore, Bergesen allowed four earned runs on four hits and three walks over seven innings...He did not factor in the decision as the A's came back for a 7-5 win.

**VS. OAKLAND:** The Athletics lead the season series, 1-0...Orioles lost the season series 3-7 in 2010 as they went 2-4 in Baltimore and 1-3 in Oakland...The Orioles trail in the all-time series 237-240, going 113-122 in Baltimore and 124-118 in Oakland...The Orioles have not won a season series with the A's since going 8-3 in 1998 (they split eight games in 2007).

**HOUSE OF HORRORS:** Since the 2008 season, the Orioles are just 1-10 in Oakland...The Birds have been outscored 56-30 in those 11 games and have scored two or fewer runs in seven of the 11 contests.

**STREAKERS:** **Nick Markakis** and **Vladimir Guerrero** have each hit in 12 straight games to tie **Brian Roberts** (April 13-26) for the longest hit streak of the year for the Birds...Markakis is 18-for-50 (.360) with a double, a homer, 10 runs scored and two RBI during his streak...Guerrero is 20-for-53 (.377) with five doubles, a homer, seven runs scored and eight RBI during his streak and his average has gone from .275 to .303 during the streak which contained a career-high seven straight multi-hit games...Guerrero has hit in 15 of his last 16 games, going 25-for-68 (.368).

**REHAB REPORT:** LH **Brian Matusz** made his third rehabilitation start last night with Triple-A Norfolk...Matusz worked five innings and allowed one earned run on four hits and a walk while striking out seven...He threw 83 pitches, 53 for strikes...Matusz has been on the 15-day disabled list since March 30 with a strained left intercostal muscle.

**HEATING UP:** **Adam Jones** (9<sup>th</sup> - .347); **Vladimir Guerrero** (10<sup>th</sup> - .341) and **Nick Markakis** (21<sup>st</sup> - .313) are all among the American League leaders in batting average in May.

**JONESIN':** In his 23 games since May 2, **Adam Jones** has batted .347 (34-98) with 14 RBI...He has multiple hits in 10 of those 23 contests...He has hit .348 (24-69) with eight extra-base hits in his last 16 games...With runners in scoring position, he is batting .366 (15-41) with two doubles, a triple, three homers and 25 RBI.

**IN A PINCH:** The Orioles lead the majors with a .545 batting average (6-for-11) and a 1.000 slugging percentage in pinch-hit situations as they have two doubles, a home run and three RBI...In 2010, the Orioles went 8-for-61 (.131) with two doubles, two home runs and seven RBI in pinch-hit situations.

**THE ERASER:** **Matt Wieters** leads all MLB catchers in caught stealing percentage (46.7 percent, 14-30) and runners thrown out (14)...Wieters is three ahead of San Francisco's **Buster Posey** (11 of 38).

**BULLPEN BULLIES:** The Orioles bullpen saw their streak of 15 consecutive scoreless innings over the last four games come to an end Friday as they allowed four earned runs in 3.2 innings...The Birds have gone to the bullpen in 47 of the 49 games this year and the bullpen has surrendered at least one earned run in 37 of those games, including 21 of the last 26 games.

**DEALING:** In his last 10 games (14.0 IP), **Jim Johnson** has allowed just two earned runs, lowering his ERA from 5.14 on May 4<sup>th</sup>, to 3.21...After allowing two home runs in his first four appearances, Johnson has allowed one in his last 18 outings.

**EATING HIS WIET-IES:** **Matt Wieters** is 19-for-36 (.528) with five doubles, three homers and 25 RBI when batting with runners in scoring position...With two outs and RISP, he is 10-for-20 (.500) with three doubles, a homer and 14 RBI...Wieters began the year 7-for-7 with RISP.

**MAKE YOUR MOVE:** The O's are in the midst of a 30-game stretch (from May 20-June 22) where they will play just three games (Tampa Bay at home June 10-12) against teams that reached the post-season in 2010...The Birds are 5-2 so far during that stretch.

**STRONG START:** In 106 games with **Buck Showalter** as manager, the Orioles have made 63 Quality Starts and the starters have a 3.56 ERA (643.0IP, 254ER).

**MR. CONSISTENCY:** **Nick Markakis** has recorded a base hit in 157 consecutive series, the longest such streak in the majors since Ichiro Suzuki hit in 160 straight series from June 2000 to June 2004...Markakis has had a hit in each series since being held hitless in a three-game series (he played in two of the games) by Tampa Bay May 23-25, 2008.

**COMEBACK KIDS:** The Orioles rallied from a four-run deficit to win Thursday, the largest deficit they've overcome this year (previously three on April 29 at Chicago).

**THE HERO:** According to Elias, **Vladimir Guerrero's** walk-off hit Thursday was his 14<sup>th</sup> game-winning hit which moves him into a tie with **Orlando Cabrera** for fourth-most among active players behind **David Ortiz** (18), **Andruw Jones** (17) and **Miguel Tejada** (15).

**PRETTY GOOD COMPANY:** **Nolan Reimold** set career highs with two homers, four hits and four RBI in Thursday's win over Kansas City...According to Elias, the only other O's to homer twice as part of a 4-for-4 or better game were **Rafael Palmeiro** (1995), **Roberto Alomar** (1997) and **Albert Belle** (1999)...Reimold's multi-homer game was the first by an Oriole since **Josh Bell** took **Cliff Lee** deep twice in Baltimore August 21, 2010.

**TOMORROW'S STARTER:** LH **Zach Britton** makes his 11<sup>th</sup> start of the year and fourth road start...In his three road starts, Britton is 2-1 with a 3.50 ERA (18.0IP, 7ER)...The O's are 7-3 when Britton starts and eight of his 10 starts have been Quality Starts...Britton has never faced the Athletics.

**QUICK HITS:** Pronounced BURG-uh-son...Had his 2009 season cut short July 30<sup>th</sup> when he was struck on his left shin by a **Billy Butler** line drive...Won his major league debut April 21, 2008, holding the White Sox to one earned run over 5.2 IP...Collected 1<sup>st</sup> MLB hit May 24, 2009 vs. WAS, a single off **Shairon Martis**...Won **Jim Palmer** Prize as Orioles' Minor League Pitcher of the Year in 2008.

**BERGESEN vs. OAKLAND:** In his only career start against the Athletics, May 27, 2010 in Baltimore, Bergesen allowed four earned runs on four hits and three walks over seven innings...He did not factor in the decision as the A's came back for a 7-5 win.

**LAST START:** Bergesen was roughed up for five runs in the top of the first inning May 19 against the Yankees....Over 3.1 innings, he allowed eight earned runs on five hits and three walks.

**AT ORIOLE PARK:** In his 31 career home starts, Bergesen is 11-11 with a 4.60 ERA (187.2IP, 96ER) and 14 Quality Starts...In 2010, Bergesen was 4-6 with a 5.10 ERA (90.0IP, 51ER)...Was 7-1 with a 2.68 ERA in 11 home starts at home in 2009, tying Rodrigo Lopez (2002) for most home wins by a rookie.

**SHUTOUT:** Bergesen shut out the Rays May 14 for his first career shutout and the first by an Orioles pitcher since **Chris Waters** blanked the Toronto Blue Jays on four hits on September 18, 2008...It was Bergesen's fourth career complete game and first since September 15, 2010 against the Blue Jays.

**HELP HIM OUT:** In Bergesen's eight starts this year, the Orioles have scored 16 runs while he was in the game (six of those came May 14 at Tampa Bay and five more came on May 3 at Kansas City) and just 26 runs total in those eight games...Bergesen had not left a start with a lead this year until May 3 at Kansas City and the first batter after he left the game homered to tie the game.

**OUT OF THE BULLPEN:** Between his first and second starts of 2011, Bergesen appeared in one game out of the bullpen (April 13 vs. New York)...He struck out two in two innings of work.

**SPRING TRAINING REPORT:** Started six games for the Birds and was 1-1 with a 5.82 ERA (17.0IP, 11ER)...His March 25<sup>th</sup> start at Minnesota ended after four pitches when he was struck on the right forearm by a **Denard Span** line drive...Allowed 25 hits and six walks in 17.0 innings.

**JUST TELL HIM IT'S AUGUST OR SEPTEMBER:** In his last 12 starts of 2010 and last 12 starts of 2009 combined, Bergesen combined to allow three or fewer runs in 21 of those 24 starts with 19 Quality Starts.

**STRONG FINISH:** Over his last 12 starts of 2010, Bergesen was 5-3 with a 2.85 ERA (82.0IP, 26ER) and left all but three of them either leading or tied...Bergesen allowed three or fewer runs in 10 of his last 12 starts and worked at least 7.0 innings in seven of those 12 starts.

**YOU COMPLETE ME:** Bergesen threw two nine-inning complete games in 2010, the only two nine-inning complete games of the year for the Birds (August 11 at CLE and September 15 vs. TOR)...Bergesen has thrown the last three nine-inning complete games for the Orioles (also June 14, 2009 vs. ATL in addition to the two in 2010).

**ROUGH SPOTS:** The opponents' 5-7 batters in the order hit a combined .326 (70-215) with 19 doubles, one triple, 14 home runs and 45 RBI against Bergesen in 2010.

**ISSUES WITH LEFTIES:** Left-handed batters hit .303 (104-343) with 32 doubles, four triples, 13 homers and 55 RBI against Bergesen in 2010...In 2009, lefties batted .263 (60-228) with 13 doubles, five homers and 24 RBI.

**THE EAST IS A BEAST:** Bergesen posted a 6.37 ERA (70.2IP, 50ER) in 13 starts against the AL East in 2010, but had a 2.55 ERA (49.1IP, 14ER) in six starts against the AL Central and 4.30 ERA (37.2IP, 18ER) in six starts against the AL West...AL East opponents are batting .313 (92-294) against Bergesen...In his career, Bergesen has a 5.52 ERA (109.1IP, 67ER) against the AL East (18 starts) but just 2.52 (82.0IP, 23ER) against the AL Central (12 starts) and 4.02 (62.2IP, 28ER) against the AL West (10 starts).

**THAT WHICH DOES NOT KILL YOU....:** Bergesen suffered through a career-long seven game losing streak over 12 starts from May 17-August 2010...He had never lost more than two consecutive decisions prior to the seven-game skid.

**TARGET PRACTICE:** Worked 6.2 scoreless innings May 6, 2010 at Minnesota for his first road win in the big leagues...Combined with **Will Ohman**, **K Uehara** and **Alfredo Simon** for the first shutout in Target Field history (only one Twin reached 3<sup>rd</sup> base in the game).

**ROOKIE SEASON:** In 2009, finished 2<sup>nd</sup> among AL rookies in ERA (3.43), 9<sup>th</sup> in batting average against (.265) and 10<sup>th</sup> in innings pitched (123.1)...Went 3-0 with a 2.23 ERA (36.1IP, 9ER) in five June starts.

**STRONG FINISH TO 2009:** Bergesen allowed three or fewer earned runs in 11 of his last 12 starts in 2009...Pitched 6.0 innings or more in each of his final 12 starts, pitching to a 2.46 ERA in that time (84.0IP, 23ER) to lower season ERA from 5.49 to 3.43...Had seven consecutive Q.S. to end the season.

**YOUTH IS SERVED:** According to *Elias*, the May 29, 2009 winning battery of **Brad Bergesen** (23) and **Matt Wieters** (23) marked the first time the Orioles have won a game in which their starting and winning pitcher and their starting catcher were both under the age of 24 since June 11, 1967, when **Bill Dillman** (22) and **Andy Etchebarren** (23) won the first game of a DH that day.

**PART OF HISTORY:** Won his major league debut on April 21, 2009 vs. CWS, becoming second O's rookie (following Uehara and before Berken, Hernandez and Matusz) to win his ML debut in 2009, the most by a team since the Chicago White Stockings had six pitchers do it in 1888.

**AWARD WINNER:** Was named to the 2008 Eastern League Southern Division All-Star team, the 2008 Eastern League post-season All-Star team and the 2007 South Atlantic League All-Star team.

## BIRD BITS & COMMUNITY NEWS

**MAKEUP DATES:** The Yankees have announced that their postponed game from April 12 against the Orioles will be played at 7:05 p.m. on Saturday, July 30 as part of a day-night doubleheader in the Bronx...The Orioles' April 22 postponed game against the Yankees at Camden Yards will be made up at 1:05 p.m. on Saturday, August 27 as part of a day-night doubleheader at Oriole Park.

**ORIOLES HALL OF FAME:** On March 19, the Orioles announced that **MIKE BORDICK** has been elected to the Orioles Hall of Fame, with induction set for pre-game on Saturday, August 13 against the Detroit Tigers...Head Athletic Trainer **RICHIE BANCELLS** was named this year's Herb Armstrong Award winner.

**THANK YOU FANS IN SARASOTA:** The Orioles announced that the club set an Ed Smith Stadium record with a total spring attendance of 115,506 (10 sellouts and an average of 7,219 per game). The previous attendance record at Ed Smith was 115,382 in 1994, when the White Sox and **Michael Jordan** spent the spring in Sarasota...This year's attendance number surpasses the 102,219 drawn in 2010, the first year at Ed Smith for the Birds.

### BIRD BATS

The O's have 13 position players on the active roster, 8 right-handers, 3 left-handed hitters and 2 switch hitters...Orioles batters were 8<sup>th</sup> in the AL with a .259 average & 11<sup>th</sup> with a .702 OPS last season...They were 12<sup>th</sup> in the league with a .661 OPS with RISP...O's DHs ranked 2<sup>nd</sup> in OPS (.865), average (.278), HR (31) and 5<sup>th</sup> in RBI (85)...Baltimore PHs batted .131 (8-61) with a .459 OPS in 2010.
